It is not comfortable and it may not be convenient, but we need you now more than ever! Between 2010 and 2014, there were 231 new pro-life laws enacted at the state level. Let's keep the momentum going!

Sunday, Jan. 18 from 1:30-3:00 p.m. YOUR presence is needed in East Meadow at FACE THE TRUTH in front of Nassau University Medical Center, 2201 Hempstead Tpke. (Rt. 24), in East Meadow. Why? FACE THE TRUTH is our local March for Life. It is a reminder of the 1973 Roe V Wade Supreme Court decision which opened the flood gates of legal abortion in our nation. Sponsored by Long Island Coalition for Life, this event is an opportunity for all to stand in the public arena protesting the killing of babies. It is an especially important opportunity for those who cannot be in Washington on January 22nd. Abortions are routine in many offices and hospitals (including Nassau University Medical Center) across Nassau and Suffolk leaving sadness and a disregard for human life in their wake. Stand at FACE THE TRUTH for 90 minutes or even for 30 minutes. (Rain or shine.) Hold a sign, text or graphics, your choice, and peacefully and silently display the pro-life message to thousands traveling that busy road.

Thurs. Jan. 29 - 5:30 p.m. A silent pro-life presence on the sidewalk in front of the Planned Parenthood abortion facility at 540 Fulton Ave. (Rt. 24), Hempstead. Inside that evening the Planned Parenthood staff, after offering wine and cheese, will show the comedy movie "Obvious Child" (featuring the normalcy of abortion). The motivation for this and other events by Planned Parenthood throughout the nation is to celebrate the 42nd anniversary of Roe v. Wade. Your sign will show attendees the true face of Planned Parenthood. Signs provided. Rain or shine.

Sat. Feb. 14, 9:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m. LOVE THEM BOTH. Let's celebrate the spirit of Valentine's Day to say: "Unborn babies need love, too." A peaceful vigil will be held on the sidewalk at the Huntington Station office of Stony Brook Women's Health, 33 Walt Whitman Rd. (just N of Jericho Tpke., Rt. 25). Rain or shine. Signs provided.

Tues. Feb.24 - a "Special Election" will be held to fill Sen. Michael Venditto's vacant 12 District Nassau County legislative seat. The 12th District includes the Massapequas and parts of Farmingdale.
