Planned Parenthood: This is "Family Planning"?

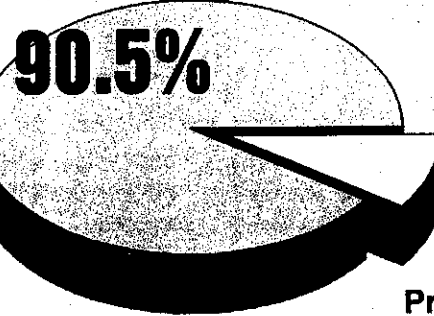
*For millions of women, Planned Parenthood is supposed to be, in the words of President Gloria Feldt, "the name they trust."
But what is Planned Parenthood's real agenda?*

Planned Parenthood is the nation's leading abortion performer and promoter.

In 1997, Planned Parenthood affiliated clinics performed 165,174 abortions,² about 12 percent of the estimated U.S. total,³ and referred out another 47,550 women for abortions.² A comparison of Planned Parenthood's services in the areas of abortion and prenatal care shows that whatever PPFA says about being "pro-choice" rather than "pro-abortion," Planned Parenthood's plans typically don't involve parenthood (see chart "Priorities").² Total annual abortions in the U.S. have declined over the past several years,³ yet the nation's largest abortion provider is performing more abortions than it has ever recorded before.^{2, 4-10}

LEGISLATIVE WATCH

FEDERAL LEGISLATION



On 6/8/99 the House, by a vote of 217-214, passed H.R. 1906 prohibiting the Food and Drug Administration from testing or distributing any drug for "chemical abortion", i.e. RU-486. (See How Congressional Members Voted #1.)

On 6/8/99 the House, by a vote of 225-203, passed H.R. 1401 prohibiting client paid abortions on U.S. military facilities except in cases involving the life of the mother or reported rape. (See How Congressional Members Voted #2.)

On 6/30/99 the House, by a vote of 270-159, passed H.R. 1218, the Child Custody Protection Act. This makes it a federal offense for anyone other than parents to transport a minor over a state line to obtain an abortion from a state having has parental involvement laws. (See How Congressional Members Voted #3.)

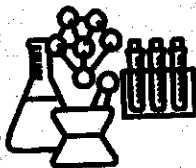

BABIES ARE MADE IN HEAVEN??



To write about the more than 100 assisted reproductive techniques would require authoring a book. The best known procedures are drug therapy, micro-surgery, artificial insemination and In Vitro fertilization. A few others include: Low Tubal Ovum Transport, Gamete and Zygote Intra-Fallopian Transfer, Assisted Semination and Sperm Intra-Fallopian Transfer. A list of these procedures is available upon request.

Perhaps you can see the complexity of this subject! It becomes even more complex when we take into consideration the **biologically proven fact that life begins at conception (fertilization), and the destruction of this tiny embryo (concepti), whether implanted or not, is killing a developing human person and establishing an even greater disrespect for life.** This fact, the psychological effect on the prospective parent or parents, and the pregnancy reduction involved is the focus of this article.

In Vitro Fertilization begins with administering drugs to the prospective mother to induce ovulation and increase the amount of eggs available for harvesting (superovulation), as the chances of one egg surviving this procedure are slight. The eggs are fertilized in a nutrient-filled Petri dish with the semen (sperm) that was collected. If the eggs are fertilized, after 3 or 4 days, the 3 -6 selected embryos are inserted into the woman's uterus. The leftover embryos that appear defective are discarded and the remainder are frozen for future use. **30 - 50% of frozen embryos die in the thawing process.** The success rate of pregnancy, despite the use of multiple eggs, is only about 10 - 15%. The Jones Institute for Reproductive Medicine in Virginia testified before Congress that out of 5,000 eggs fertilized, 230 children were born alive. **That makes the embryo death rate in fertility treatment 95%.** It is reported that some doctors fertilize extra eggs to sell for research experimentation or to other women or couples.

Pregnancy reduction, selective abortion including gender selection, fetal reduction, or enhanced survival of multifetal pregnancies (ESMP) are the proposed answers to the multifetal pregnancies resulting from the transfer of several embryos into the woman's uterus at the beginning of the procedure. **Doctors suggest eliminating (killing) some of the fetuses to safeguard the mother's health and help the remaining fetuses to survive.** The most common

method now used for pregnancy reduction is described in the New England Journal of Medicine: "Using ultrasound to locate each fetus, **the doctors would insert a needle into the chest cavity of the most accessible fetus and place the needle tip directly into the heart of the baby. Potassium chloride was then injected into the heart and the heart was viewed on the ultrasound screen until it stopped beating.**" What heartbreak this must burden these anxious parents with. What horror when the remaining fetuses don't survive!

We discussed this procedure with a doctor. He said, "When you circumvent a natural process you open yourself to other problems." The doctor described a patient who is unmarried, a mentally and physically handicapped girl, with no parents or available help, who has now had her second embryo implant. She actually showed the doctor the catalog she selected the embryo from. He said she will be totally incapable to take care of this baby if it does survive to birth. The fertility doctor obviously took none of these problems into consideration.

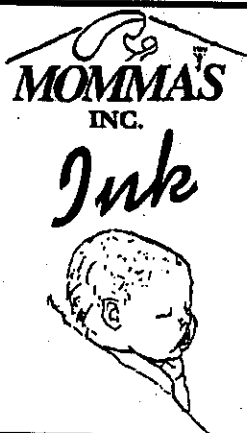
We had an information table at a local fair. A dad who was pushing his baby in a stroller asked if we would call him and his wife murderers, as they had 8 implants before their first successful pregnancy. Unsuccessful implants can leave the parents with a guilt complex, as we witnessed. How much more must fetal reduction trouble the conscience? There is also concern that the use of hormones to stimulate egg development, etc., especially for repeated treatments, could cause other medical problems, including the possibility of cancer.

Watch for legislation being sponsored in your state, as it has been here in NY, that would require all commercial health insurance plans to cover the costs of infertility treatments. Remember, these treatments are available for single as well as married persons, homosexual and heterosexual persons, as well as using the sperm or eggs from a deceased spouse. Could this infertility legislation then also include mandating human cloning?

A sign in an IVF Center reads: "They say babies are made in heaven, but we know better." **We are reminded so often now of the advice of the world famous geneticist, Dr. Jerome Lejeune, that not all that can be done, should be done!**

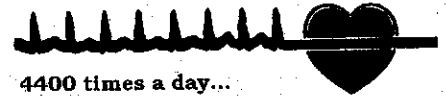

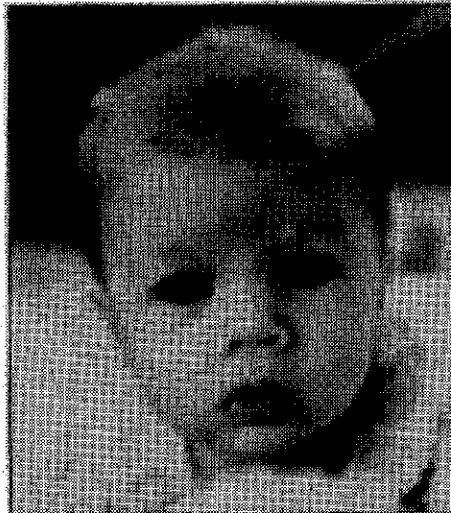
