PLANNED PARENTHOOD ORGANIZATION TARGETS TEENS

After the September 11 tragedy, Planned Parenthood (P.P.) offered "free...reproductive health services" (read abortion) to survivors of one of the most horrific events in American history—an unconscionable attempt to market its own agenda at a time of great human suffering. Now targeting another vulnerable segment of our population, P. P. of Hudson Peconic is embarked on a massive marketing campaign to attract more teen customers to their emergency contraception and abortion services.

Planned Parenthood's Sexuality Education Update website reported on their evaluation of a questionnaire/survey distributed to those teen students attending their Suffolk County Teen "Health" Conference in April 2001. The survey asked these questions:

- 1. Have you ever heard about Planned Parenthood?
- 2. Which of these services do you think P.P. provides?
- a) Birth Control b) Abortion c) Health care for pregnant women d) STD testing and treatment e) HIV testing and counseling f) Medical services for men g) Sex education.
- 3. Can teens of any age go to Planned Parenthood without their parents permission?
- 4. Can teens receive low cost or free services at Planned Parenthood?
- 5. Do you know where there is a Planned Parenthood near you?
- 6. If yes, where is the nearest Planned Parenthood located?
- 7. Does Planned Parenthood have a teen website?
- 8. If yes, do you know the web address?

They collected 416 surveys out of about 600 distributed. The survey revealed the following: "34% of the students had no knowledge of P.P...50% knew about the agency, but were not familiar with all...services. Only 17% had demonstrated knowledge of (P.P.) and services." (As noted here in the past, many teens relish the chance to take a "field trip" away from school, to a first class hotel, breakfast, lunch and early dismissal on a Friday!). Equally important, the survey noted that

information disseminated at the Teen "Health" Conference was not shared with the general school population upon their return from the conference.

Planned Parenthood of Hudson Peconic now plans to redouble its efforts to make sure "every teen leaves knowing about the wonderful work we do at Planned Parenthood.". The past practice was to bury P.P.'s name inside the materials in order to "assuage concerns of school principals" about P. P.'s sponsorship. They now plan to display the P.P. of Hudson Peconic name and logo more prominently on all Conference materials.

The following school districts have sent students to the Teen "Health" Conference in the past. Parents and relatives with teens in these schools should ask their Superintendents, and Principals why they continue to expose students to an organization which has viciously fought against parental notification or consent for their minor children seeking contraceptives, treatment for STD's or abortion, even where the law contained a judicial by-pass?

Given the rising number of cases of STD's, P.P.'s failed oxymoronic "safer sex" mentality, School administrators who send students to these "Health" Conferences should be prosecuted for endangering the morals and welfare of minors. Its time to reclaim our parental rights from an organization with an immoral agenda and a vested financial interest in the sale of contraceptives and abortion to our teens.

Take note of P.P.'s latest assault on parental responsibility. Their web site offers this advice to teens concerning their parents' sex education: "Your job now is to start paying attention—take the useful smart stuff you've learned from your folks and kick that crap to the curb.". (from Life Decisions International, Winter 2000, pg. 3). P.P. still claims to facilitate parent-child communications, along with confidentiality!

NEW YORK STATE

Pro-lifers are shocked by recent assaults on life and freedom of religion.

---N.Y.S. Attorney General Spitzer began a taxsubsidized campaign against pro-life crisis pregnancy centers. The N.Y. Post, 2/04/02, described this as a "fishing expedition" and reported that 24 centers have been served with subpoenas.

---The Assembly passed the "Women's Health and Wellness" bill. A. 2006, which would require group health plans to cover abortifacient prescriptions and devices which destroy, rather than prevent life. Assemblymen Thomas Barraga and Robert Wertz voted against the bill-please thank them. This bill does not contain a "conscience clause".

--On 2/5, the Senate passed a different "Women's Health and Wellness" bill, S.6265, which would require all commercial health plans to cover the cost of artificial contraceptives. This bill has a very narrow "conscience clause" which would not cover hundreds of religious organizations and institutions such as schools, hospitals and charitable agencies.

Action: It is uncertain whether the Assembly and Senate will decide to accept the same version of this legislation and thus pass a "Women's Health and Wellness" bill before you receive this issue of LIFE NEWS, To determine your course of action, please immediately call the Bill Status Hotline at 800-455-7545. If either bill has not passed contact your Senator and Assembly Member to ask them to oppose this legislation. If passed, contact Governor Pataki asking that he veto the bill.

THE RIGHT TO PRIVACY – A DEATH GRANT: EUTHANASIA PART II (U.S.A.)

"The 'rights' formulated under the umbrella 'right to privacy' include contraception, abortion, direct and indirect infant icide, various homosexual activities, pornography and euthanasia." (Facts of Life, Brian Clowes, Ph.D.) We would like to add embryonic stem cell research, live fetal experimentation and cloning to the list. The "right to privacy" came out of the Gri swold v Conn. decision by Justice Douglas that concerned contraception and his reading into the "emanations" of the 14th Amendment. Don't waste your time dissecting the Amendment to better understand his conclusion! This "right" and the Justice's conclusion that "the fetus had not yet reached 'the capability of meaningful life', that he or she was not a 'person in the whole sense", formed the basis of the abortion decision. (Abortion Questions & Answers, Dr. & Mrs. J. C. Willke) "Most of the 'foot-in-the-door' early euthanasia bills (living will, death with dignity) introduced so far, justify post-born extermination when the patient is no longer capable of 'meaningful' life." (Willke) Who makes the decision whether someone else's life is meaningful?

Having experienced the horror of the German medical crimes, the World Medical Association in 1948 "adopted the Declaration of Geneva, which reaffirmed the profession's pledge: "I will maintain the utmost respect for human life, from the time of conception; even under threat, I will not use my medical knowledge contrary to the laws of humanity." For more than two decades, that statement would go generally unchallenged." (Medical Nightmares: German Doctors/American Doctors, Charles J. Sykes) As treatment costs increased, contempt for chronically ill and non-rehabilitable patients developed; "in the 1960's, two renowned physician/researchers were discovered injecting live cancer cells into elderly patients at the Jewish Hospital and Medical Center in Brooklyn, without getting their consent...in 1971, doctors at Johns Hopkins Hospital permitted a baby born with Downs Syndrome to starve to death...when revealed, were loudly denounced throughout the medical world... Throughout the 1950's and 1960's, there were scattered pockets of support for liberalized euthanasia laws, calls for more aggre ssive sterilization programs and much more broadly based movements for legalized abortion." (Sykes)

The "right to privacy" was the introduction to and stimulant for the "right to die" and the "death with dignity" movement. "Fundamentally, the 'right to die' is not a right—it is the forfeiture of all possible rights...will eventually become for many people the duty to die...former Colorado Governor Richard Lamm asserted on 27 March 1984: 'We've got a duty to die and get out of the way with all of our machines and artificial hearts and everything else like that and let other society, our kids, build a reasonable life." (Clowes)

When ordinary humane care such as oxygen, food and water (nutrition and hydration) are considered medical treatment and can be removed without a patient's express consent, that person then dies of suffocation, starvation, or dehydration, not from their illness. This is called passive euthanasia, also referred to as negative or indirect euthanasia. It is an "action withheld for the purpose of causing or hastening death... another example... is withholding food and water from a person in a so-called 'persistent vegetative state' (PVS), or from someone whose health is not improving rapidly enough in the opinion of the at-

tending health care workers." (Clowes) There are several pages dedicated to highly publicized euthanasia cases in the U.S. in Clowes' book, *The Facts of Life*. These people could have lived a long time if given food and water, but were instead deliberately starved to death, precisely because they were not dying quickly enough. Some of the cases included are Karen Ann Quinlan, Paul Brophy, Elizabeth Bouvia, Nancy Ellen Jobes, and Nancy Cruzan.

Even the infamous Jack Kevorkian, Dr. Death, in an effort to encourage support for his assisted suicide practice, spoke about the cruelty of death from starvation, taking from 2 days to 2 weeks for a patient die: "allowing someone to starve to death and to die of thirst, the way we do now, is barbaric. Our Supreme Court has validated barbarism. The Nazis did that in concentration camps... It took her (Nancy Cruzan) a week to die. Try it! You think that just because you're in a coma you don't suffer?" (Clowes)

The only ethical time to remove oxygen, nutrition and hydration is when death is "imminent". If that time designation means momentarily, we can all accept it. But, wouldn't even that time prognosis be flexible according to individual medical personnel's judgment? We have no reason to put a patient into this possibly painful situation. A patient can be given total parenteral nutrition (TPN), administered via naso-gastric tube, several other tubing options or simply by IV. No guessing games or later decision recriminations.

Be aware and knowledgeable about health care and proxy legislation. Here in New York, at the present time, the Health Care Decisions Act, if passed, would not only enable the withholding of medicines and humane care, but could force the patient from the institution if the patient or the family would not agree to comply. Further, this legislation specifically states that no one can be held responsible for decisions made. We must become legislatively a state!

Let us briefly discuss "Living Wills", which should be called "Kill Me Instructions". The Euthanasia Society, which has changed its name twice, and is now called The Society for Concern for Dying, started these so called "living wills". Euthanasia activists consider "living wills" the first step toward active, involuntary euthanasia. Guess who was a member of this Society's Board? None other than the former head of Planned Parenthood, Dr. Alan Guttmacher.

Dr. & Mrs. Willke explain why we should oppose legally bin ding living wills: "... Informed consent just cannot be given in a generic fashion for an unknown problem at a future time... A conscious patient can always refuse treatment. Many patients change their minds. With a signed document that is legally binding, it may be too late. What does 'terminally ill', or 'artificial means', or 'heroic measures', or 'meaningful' or 'reasonable expectation' mean? These definitions change with time and are different in each case."

Space does not allow us to continue. Thankfully, only one state, Oregon, has legalized assisted suicide. We close with "A Plea To Lawmakers" from Dr. & Mrs. Willke's book, Why Can't We Love Them Both?: "In the event that you do take the tragic step of legalizing euthanasia, please do not have a doctor do it. Rather hire a professional executioner. For over 2,000 years pe ople have trusted their doctors to 'Do no harm'. This trust has been seriously undermined by legal abortion. Please do not complete the destruction of this trust and confidence." Have our medical professionals become desensitized to killing through their acceptance of or participation in abortion? Will we ever know how many patients have been euthanized? Who will be next?

QUESTION: What accounts for the declining number of abortions and diminished public support in such a strong pro-abortion environment?

ANSWER: Two words: pro-life commitment. There should be no doubt that the vigilance, commitment, patience and prayer of peaceful pro-life advocates is paying off.

Decades of volunteers offering shelter, compassion and concrete assistance to women with unplanned pregnancies, as well as to those who've experienced the pain and emptiness abortion brings.

Decades of lobbyists, lawyers and demonstrators taking incremental "baby steps" toward a world which cherishes unborn human life and offers protection to both mothers and children.

Decades of educating about human development in the womb, marching on Washington, testifying at hearings, praying rosaries, distributing flyers and wearing red roses in a bold public statement of countercultural commitment.

Decades of bearing witness to the truth.
