"Years ago, while giving an anesthetic for a ruptured tubal pregnancy (at two months), I was handed what I believed to be the smallest human being ever seen. The embryo sac was intact and transparent. Within the sac was a tiny (one-third inch) human male swimming extremely vigorously in the amniotic fluid, while attached to the wall by the umbilical cord. This tiny human was perfectly developed with long, tapering fingers, feet and toes. It was almost transparent as regards the skin, and the delicate arteries and veins were prominent to the ends of the fingers. The baby was extremely alive and did not look at all like the photos and drawings of 'embryos' which I have seen. When the sac was opened, the tiny human immediately lost its life and took on the appearance of what is accepted as the appearance of an embryo at ~ Paul E. A Back to School Pro-life Checklist

Students are often inundated in the classroom with the anti-life, "pro-choice" philosophy and rhetoric. It may be blatant or subtle. It is urgent that parents be aware of what their children are being taught, particularly in healthrelated issues that may affect their outlook on pro-life issues.

Parents should also be aware of the fact that for the past several years, Planned Parenthood in Suffolk County has solicited schools in September to recruit Teen Advisors for their spring Teen Health Conference.

Below is a checklist of ways parents and students, as well as taxpayers without children in the school, can play a vital role in increasing the pro-life message in schools, and also keep Planned Parenthood out of our schools.

1—Does your school district have a Community Summit Night? Local pro-life groups and Pregnancy Care Centers (PCC's) should have tables or representation.

2—Does the High School or Junior High School have a Human Relations Day or Health Awareness Day that includes speakers? The L.I. Coalition for Life, a PCC, or a pro-life group may be able to provide speakers.

3—Find out if Planned Parenthood developed or is involved in the school's health curriculum. Are there guest speakers from Planned Parenthood? If so, are pro-life speakers given equal time?

4—Does your school district have a functioning AIDS curriculum Health Advisory Committee? This is mandated by NYS and must include community members.

5—Are 'Pro-choice" speakers invited into any of your child's classes (e.g. science, global studies, political science, child development); If so, ask that pro-life speakers be invited also.

Many school administrators are unaware of the legal precedents which allow students to use Respect Life topics in essays, debates and science fair projects, as well as assignments in public speaking, communications classes, art or music.

Photos taken at such events are often used in campaign literature and the public may be fooled into believing you have endorsed the candidate.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT END OF LIFE "CHOICES"

The Associated Press recently announced that the Hemlock Society changed its name to End-of-Life Choices, "a more direct and more accurate description of who we are and of the issues we support", according to Phil Spiers, a representative of the group. But just whose "choices" are they referring to? In 2001, the Cambridge Quarterly of Healthcare Ethics covered a California conference of doctors, judges, clergy and community members. They met to discuss "futility" policies in California hospitals. Schneiderman and Alexander Morgan Capron, the authors, argued for the right of doctors and hospitals to refuse lifesustaining care. They stated that doctors would "get better legal results when they refuse to provide nonbeneficial treatment and then defend their decisions as consistent with professional standards than when they seek advance permission to withhold care."

Jenny Nolan of the National Right to Life Committee (NRLC) stated "The issue is not requiring doctors and nurses to provide physiologically futile treatment: treatment that, in reasonable medical judgment, cannot preserve a patient's life...what makes the California policies so alarming is that they cover a much broader range of circumstances than physiological futility. Indeed, their point is to draw a line between patients who should and should not live, based largely on intellectual capacity, though all of them can live. ... The root of the contention was that the health care providers did not deem the quality of that life to be worth living... A medical degree does not convey a right superior to that of a patient or family to decide whether someone who can live should be allowed to do so."

The California policies are not isolated incidents. In 1996, a medical journal article reported that hospitals in Houston were engaging in policies that permitted life-saving treatment to be denied, in direct opposition to the demands of patients and families. If the hospital ethics committee supported death, there was no appeals process for the patient. Then-Governor George W. Bush vetoed a bill that would have provided legal protection for these policies. New legislation was developed and signed into law in 1999. It required that lifesaving treatment must be provided for a reasonable amount of time, in order to allow the patient and/or family to transfer the patient to a facility that will continue the desired treatment. (We would question why a patient would have to go to such extraordinary measures to defend his right to life.) NRLC stated "laws and policies that deny medically effective treatment desired by the patient or family on the basis of a health care facility's negative view of the patient's 'quality of life' discriminate against people with disabilities and therefore violate the Americans with Disabilities Act and other federal law."

Euthanasia is derived from a Greek word that means "good death". American Life League states on its website, "It is our observation that those who espouse "euthanasia" in reality favor an imposed death – not a good death." As we are all aware, the "right to choose" has long been promoted in the pro-abortion movement. Unfortunately, we now have to deal with "choice" in dying as well. But exactly what "choices" are being promoted? Suppose a friend was told that he had a 25% chance of surviving the next year, was in excruciating pain, had lost all hope and wanted to die. What would you do if he asked you to help relieve his pain by helping him to die—to kill him? This is now legal in Oregon, but is also happening throughout the country. Supporters of this movement are working to make assisted suicide a constitutional right, just as abortion promoters worked for Roe v Wade thirty years ago.

This emotional issue tears at our hearts. No one wants to prolong the pain and suffering of a loved one. But what "choices" are morally acceptable for the patient and his or her family and friends? American Life League states that euthanasia is an "action or an omission which of itself or by intention causes death, in order that suffering may in this way be eliminated. No one should ever be deprived of basic care, including food and water, suitable bedding, an optimal thermal environment, a patent airway, exits for stool and urine, and available effective treatments and therapies. A hospital exists to diagnose and treat ill patients. While not every illness can be cured, every patient must be cared for. The object is always to provide the best available medical care to the whole person, physically, mentally and spiritually. To purposefully expedite death by omission violates a fundamental principle of medicine — 'First, do no harm.' Recognizing that not every illness can be cured, but that every patient must be cared for, a hospital cooperates with other facilities and services, as well as the patient's family, to deliver the best care possible to the patient."

American Life League states, "human life, in all its stages and in all circumstances, must be defended and protected...All of us will die. Dying is a part of life. Therefore, we are not required to accept every medical treatment suggested or available. You should not be forced to undergo treatment that is completely ineffective or gravely burdensome for you. We must repeatedly remind ourselves, though, that our lives are not our own. They have absolute, inherent sanctity and quality...We have an obligation to do our best to live the entire life span given to us...when judging the worth of a particular medical treatment-its effect on the patient and his/her medical condition- we must be careful never to judge the "worth" of ours or anyone else's life...Death is not necessarily something to be feared and avoided at all costs. It is vital, however, that those who respect the sanctity of human life remain vigilant to the constant and insidious attacks of the culture of death."


