A pro-life victory:

Unborn Victims of Violence Act,

often referred to as "Laci and Conner's Law", passed Congress and was signed into law by President Bush on April 1, 2004 establishing a separate legal status for the unborn child.

The above bill, while a tremendous victory in that the unborn baby is recognized as a second victim, is limited to

protecting the baby only during the commission of one of 68 federal crimes. Unless a state law has been enacted—as in California with the Peterson case—wanted, unborn babies are not protected from acts of violence which are not considered federal crimes.

Bush signs legislation to protect the unborn

President Bush on Thursday signed legislation that expands the rights of the unborn. The Unborn Victims of Violence Act makes it unlawful to harm a fetus while committing a federal crime, such as a terrorist attack or drugrelated shooting, against the pregnant woman. Several states have similar laws in cases where a fetus is injured during a crime.

Abortion-rights proponents say the bill is the first recognition in federal law of an embryo or fetus as a person separate from the woman. Opponents of abortion want more sweeping protections.

Bush's ceremonial signing of the law in the White House East Room should help shore up support among abortion opponents. He opposes abortion except in cases of rape or incest or when pregnancy endangers a woman's life.

Sen. John Kerry, D- Mass., the likely Democratic presidential nominee, voted against the bill and supports abortion rights.

INTERNATIONAL PLANNED PARENTHOOD FEDERATION'S COMPULSORY ABORTION AGENDA

The Mexico City Policy adopted by President Reagan prohibited the use of U.S. Tax Dollars by organizations that provide for abortion or that lobbied for or promoted abortion policies. The Clinton Administration revoked this policy in the early '90's and U.S. Tax dollars were again utilized to promote abortion policies overseas.

Recently President Bush reinstated the Mexico City Policy and his major critics are Planned Parenthood Federation of America and the International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) who had been the major recipients of the Clinton authorized ". . .\$385 million to promote abortion, perform sterilizations and ship contraceptives to countries around the world." (S.W. Morse, President, Population Research Institute, "Declining Fertility—Too Few Children" INSIGHT, Jan., 2000)

The IPPF has not only promoted legalized abortion abroad, but has been heavily involved in population control. Alan Guttmacher, former Medical Director of IPPF stated, "Each country will have to decide its own form of coercion and determine when and how it shall be employed. At present the means are compulsory sterilization and compulsory abortion. Perhaps someday a way of enforcing compulsory birth control will be feasible." There should not be any confusion regarding the intent of IPPF—for we already see the manifestation of this policy in China—one child per family, abort all others.

The issue here is how much control do developing nations have over special policies imposed by external organizations that are in direct opposition to their cultural mores. For years U.S. aid was "funneled through the U.N. Fund For Population Activity (UNFPA) and NGOs such as the IPPF... The 'surplus population' of the Third World must not

suspect that it is being deliberately 'reduced'". (ibidem)

However, in 2001 this funding came to an end when "Congress zeroed out UNFPA's annual \$25 million subsidy because of that agency's ill-considered policy." (ibidem) However, the IPPF was able to replace these funds with increased grants from foundations such as:

Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation \$ 3,023,000 Wm. and Flora Hewlett Foundation \$ 2,550,000 Rockefeller Foundation \$ 352,000 and others for a 2002 total of \$35,175,000

IPPF also received restricted and unrestricted government grants from countries such as:

and others for a total of \$60,271,000

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

BAN ON PARTIAL BIRTH ABORTION CHALLENGED IN THREE STATES

Following the passing of the ban on Partial Birth Abortion (PBA) in the U.S. Senate on 3/13/03 by 64-33 and in the U.S. House on 6/04/03 by 282-139, the N.Y. Civil Liberties Union and the American Civil Liberties Union went in Federal Courts in San Francisco, Ca., Omaha, Neb., and, New York declaring the ban on PBA unconstitutional because the bill does not contain the health of the mother exception.

Medical experts had testified before Congress and before the bill's passage. "There are absolutely no obstetrical situations encountered in this country which require a partially delivered fetus to be destroyed to preserve the life or health of the mother" stated Dr. Pamela Smith, Director of Medical Education in the Dept of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Mount Sinai Hospital. Former Surgeon General C. Everett Koop backs up Dr. Smith. His testimony, along with 300 other physician specialists, by stating: "Partial Birth Abortion is never medically necessary to protect a mother's health of her future fertility.

PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE SENATOR JOHN KERRY'S ABORTION STAND

Massachusetts Senator John Kerry not only supports Partial Birth Abortion but has stated that if elected "As President I will only appoint Supreme Court Justices who will uphold a woman's right to choose". According to National Abortion Rights Action League (NARAL)-Pro-Choice America Senator Kerry has a 100 % pro-abortion record and according to National Right to Life a 0% pro-life voting record.

BLACK AMERICANS FOR LIFE PLAN ADS

Black Americans for Life are planning an educational media campaign to help the public and the African-American community in particular to understand the damage abortion is doing to black families and communities nationwide.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



REPRODUCTIVE CLONING PROHIBITION ACT-A.6249.A. THIS IS AN ANTI-LIFE BILL.

The N.Y.S. Assembly is poised once again to pass a bill that would allow human cloning for the purpose of conducting medical experiments on human embryos. This morally offensive bill, deceptively called The Reproductive Cloning Prohibition Act would not prohibit cloning but would actually statutorily allow human cloning ask long as the unborn child is killed before birth.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT

THE DOLORES ANDRESKI MEMORIAL MICHAEL FUND WALKATHON 2004

The International Foundation for Genetic Research is popularly known as The Michael Fund. This foundation opened it's doors in 1978, with world-renowned geneticist, Dr. Jerome Lejeune, as Medical Director and Randy Engel as Executive Director. The Michael Fund is the pro-life alternative to the National Foundation/March of Dimes that was in a decade long battle with the pro-life movement because of their funding of live fetal research that was inhumane and their search and destroy policy (amniocentesis) as the "cure" for birth defects.

A number of the March of Dimes (MOD) grantees have used aborted babies as a source of spare parts or fetal blood obtained by "openheart puncture of healthy ten week aborted fetuses. During the 1970's & 1980's it was MOD's private foundation monies that permitted these researchers...to bypass the government ban prohibiting the use of federal funds for such non-therapeutic, lethal experimentation on live human fetuses."

In 1979, the Long Island Coalition for Life looked for a way to fund this new, pro-life foundation. The annual (since 1980) walkathon was the result. This year the walkathon's name has been changed to honor the passing of one of God's most precious servants-Dolores Andreski. She dedicated her life to uphold the sanctity of all human life from conception through death. We ask you all to please consider joining us for our 25th walkathon between the opening ceremonies at noon until 3 pm. The path is 2 miles long and may be repeated as many times as you choose and have informed your sponsors. Contributions from those unable to participate in the walkathon are gratefully accepted. Your participation acknowledges that we are all members of the human family in which every human life is sacred and worthy of respect and support.

Studies have demonstrated that mental retardation, particularly that associated with chromosomal anomalies, often is amenable to treatment. The Michael Fund's Dr. Paddy Baggot's research has focused in on the time span in fetal development when retardation has not been observed and on early prenatal intervention treatment for these preborn children affected by chromosomal disorders.

Dr. Marie Peeters Ney, Director of Medical Research, has worked with the International Center for Metabolic Testing on nutritional and chemical supplementation for children with Down Syndrome. She notes, "preliminary studies have documented a number of improvements in the health of children with Down Syndrome.... This study needs to be continued so that it be possible to evaluate neurological development."

Your contributions to the Michael Fund will help us fund life-giving research, genetic causes and treatments of Down Syndrome and related chromosomal disorders, genetic information agencies, support systems, physician referrals for specific birth anomalies, adoption of handicapped children, and dietary management of children with chromosomal disorders. Much has been done. Much remains to be accomplished. Help us honor Dolores and her years of tireless service to uphold the rights of the handicapped, born and preborn, and their families. Hold close in your heart and in your actions her lifelong mottoes of, "Birth defects, not the human beings handicapped by them, are undesireable" and "All for the honor and glory of God".
