


PRIESTS FOR LIFE

FEDERAL LEGISLATION





Ignoring President George W. Bush's veto threat, the House voted on 5/24/05, to lift limits on embryonic stem cell research. The President called the bill a mistake and said he would veto it. The House approved it by a 238-194 vote, far short of the two-thirds majority that would be needed to override a veto. Nassau/Suffolk Representatives Bishop, Israel, McCarthy and Ackerman voted against the bill. Representative Peter King voted pro-life. The companion bill in the Senate is S.471.

UMBILICAL CORD PROVIDES HELP—

On 5/24/05, the House passed H.R. 2520 with a 431-1 vote. This bill enables an abundant supply of human (adult) stem cells to be collected and used for both treatment and research without endangering or killing embryos.

Please support S.658/H.R.1357 The Ban on Human Cloning. Cloning actually creates an embryo. However, the most common reason used to justify cloning is stem cell extraction which always kills the embryo from which stem cells are extracted. NEW YORK STATE **LEGISLATION**



6/23 is the last day of the 2005 NYS Legislative Session. As of this writing it appears that all the bills which would restrict abortion will die in committee. The good news is that the "Unintended Pregnancy Act" has not passed the Senate and although bill (A.6330) to allow taxpayer funding of embryonic stem cell research has passed the Assembly Health Committee there does not seem to be a strong impetus to pass such legislation in the Senate.

However, as I write this column there are still eight days left in this Session. We can only hope that any "June surprise"

will be pro-life, not anti-life legislation.


As shown in the Terri Schindler-Schiavo case a new ethic, the "quality of life" ethic is influencing medical decisions in our culture. This is very likely to be a big issue in the near future. In our state a bill, the Family Health Care Decisions Act (S.4296/A.5406) is being promoted heavily by a new coalition of groups called "The Family Décisions Coalition". The Coalition is interested in ensuring that a surrogate's decision on behalf of a patient to end treatment would be protected. However, some of the provisions of the bill would result in involuntary euthanasia-for example, this bill would allow physicians to place Do-Not-Resuscitate orders on patients without their knowledge even though the patient is fully conscious and mentally competent; this bill would allow a private hospital or individual health-care provider to override a decision for life-sustaining treatment under the guise of conscience protection, if the hospital or other provider decides that the patient's life is not worth preserving because it doesn't meet the doctor's quality of life standards; this bill does not have strong "transfer" language which would allow transfer of a patient to another provider where the patient would receive life-saving care safe from being overridden by judicial review, hospital ethics boards, or other institutional policies. Space and my lack of expertise do not permit a complete analysis of this long, complicated bill. It is clear it should be opposed in its current form. What is unclear is whether even amendments to such a bill would make it acceptable.

Following the death of Terri Schindler-Schiavo in Florida, New York legislators introduced a bill (but not voted on as of 6/9/05) to create a legal presumption in favor of assisted nutrition and hydration. This bill, S.4083-A/ A.7009-A would create the life-affirming presumption for every patient who lacks capacity to make health care decisions, and allow a narrow set of exceptions such as written instructions to the contrary or when the provision of assisted food and water is not medically possible.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT THE HISTORY OF THE OVERPOPULATION MYTH AND EUGENICS



(Editor's note: in the first three parts we saw the origins of the eugenics movement, the rise of Margaret Sanger and the insidious growth of her creation, Planned Parenthood.)

PART IV: INTERNATIONAL PLANNED PARENTHOOD

International Planned Parenthood was established in 1948 with monies from the Brush Foundation and the Osborn Family. Jalsevac states, "Planned Parenthood achieved devastating results using the legal challenges, protests, civil disobedience, strong-arm tactics, and sophisticated propaganda campaigns that Sanger and her predecessors had perfected. In 1938, Sweden became the first free nation to permit abortion and to institutionalize PP sex education and family limitation programs. Between 1949 and 1956, abortion was legalized in another 11 European nations, each at the behest of PP. In 1958, various UN agencies began to subsidize PP projects and programs throughout the developed world...One of the most necessary allies needed by PP and the eugenics movement was the US government...the main effort would come from the elite...the first of these men was J.D. Rockefeller III...he funded the creation of the Population Council in 1952...it began telling the countries of the world how to control their populations...these programs helped to drastically increase the supply of contraceptives to underdeveloped countries. Perhaps his most influential role, however was the intense behind the scenes lobbying he and his organization began in order to convince the US government to join the population control forces." He was joined by Hugh Moore, owner of the Dixie Cup Co., who engineered the "Population Bomb" media blitz. According to Jalsevac, "Moore almost single-handedly created a population panic in the US...he used his influence to...help mold the Draper Report of 1959 into the first official US government report to endorse population control in the context of foreign aid." Steven Mosher stated in the Population Research Institute Review, Jan/Feb 2003, "With Rockefeller and his colleagues also working behind the scenes to encourage federal intervention, these wealthy men were about to impose their will on the US Congress. It would in turn impose its will on the world." Jalsevac continues, "The US Foreign Assistance Act of 1961...effectively man-

dated that population control was now the basic aim of foreign aid...[Rockefeller and Moore] had led Congress to believe that the growing populations around the world presented a threat to the US national security and, therefore, aid should be given only to those countries that controlled their populations." Mosher stated, "the bill incorporated the use of all US aid programs from education and health to rural developments as methods to be used to build motivation for smaller families through modification of economic and social conditions supportive of the desire for large families." Henry Kissinger's "National Security Study Memorandum 200 stated, "Since population growth is a major determinant of increases in food demand...the allocation of scarce PL480 [food] resources should take account of what steps a country is taking in population control as well as food production...The United States Agency of International Development (USAID) was created in 1966. Its first director was Dr. Reimert Thorolf Ravenholt who believed birth control was the 'key to public safety, freedom from hunger, and development,' and wanted to sterilize at least a quarter of the world's population...he proclaimed public health programs in Africa are 'enormously harmful to African societies when the deaths prevented thereby are not balanced by prevention of a roughly equal number of births.' Dr. Ravenholt collaborated with...the International Planned Parenthood Foundation and the Population Council, giving them funds to carry out his family planning programs in overseas countries with the infrastructures these organizations already had in place...The 'Population Firm's' last and greatest allies were the World Bank and the UN...Sir Julian Huxley, the President of the UN Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) stated, 'Thus, even though it is quite true that any radical eugenic policy of controlled human breeding will be for many years politically and psychologically impossible, it will be important for UNESCO to see that the eugenic problem is examined with the greatest care, and that the public mind is informed of the issues at stake so that much is unthinkable may at least become thinkable.""

In 1967, the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA), also called the United Nations Population Fund, was established. International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) was granted full State Status at the UN in 1971 and "was recognized as an international non-governmental associate with UNICEF and the WHO."

In the final part we will see how Planned Parenthood and its ilk have sown the seeds of their ultimate demise.

Looking toward the 2005 Elections

Because entry-level positions pave the way for State and Federal office, the pro-life community must:

-- Ask every candidate his/her stand on the "Life Issues" of abortion, parental notification/consent, and stem cell research using human embryos. Speak directly to the candidate or get the information in print.

-- Pass the information to other pro-life voters.

-- Do not be fooled by recent efforts of pro-abortion candidates to appeal to pro-life voters by statements "designed to reduce abortions" and by offering alternatives to abortion while at the same time maintaining their support of abortion rights.

-- Do not allow pro-abortion candidates a photo-op with your group and watch speaking invitations.

Reminder—Are all in your household properly registered? New registrants, as well as, name, address and political party changes, must be forwarded to the Board of Elections using the basic Voter Registration Mail-In Form available at every Post Office. Mail early so that all are ready to vote if necessary in a September Primary Race as well as in the November 2005 General Election.

Encourage pro-lifers to enroll in a political party--Registrants who do not select a party are enrolled as "Blank" and lose the right to vote in a primary race where supporting a pro-life candidate may be critical. Also, a "Blank" may not sign designating petition enabling pro-life names to be placed on the ballot.

Through the 2006 elections the following major political parties will appear on the ballot in NYS: R-Republican, D-Democrat, I-Independence, C-Conservative, and, W-Working Families.

The following parties no long appear on the ballot through 2006: The Right to Life, Liberal, Marijuana Reform and Libertarian. These may seek to regain a line of the ballot through the petition process in the 2006 gubernatorial election.

The Working Families Party, a coalition of unions, community groups and activists was formed in 1998. "The goal of the Working Families Party is to more forcefully inject the issues of work-class, middle-class, and poor people—like jobs, health care, education and housing—into the public debate and hold candidates and elected officials accountable on those issues." (www.workingfamiliesparty.com). Basically, they have taken the place of the Liberal Party in NYS." (emphasis added)

Spiritually "Adopt a Baby" Program

An excellent "intercessory prayer" activity for the entire parish community, Spiritual Adoption, is a very easy prolife project.

We know there are pre-born infants in danger of abortion. Therefore, this program invites the community to commit themselves to praying every day for the nine months, praying that the mother and father of an infant receive the strength by God's Spirit to continue to choose life.

Where to start?

Begin the program with a sign-up weekend. Participants sign a pledge card promising to pray every day for a baby they spiritually adopt and for his/her parents. The pledge card suggests the Spiritually Adopted baby be given a name.

Monthly Development Report:

During each of the nine months the parish bulletin updates the child's development. For example:

3rd Month Developing Baby:

Your baby is quite active now. If his/her mother's womb had a window, you could watch your Spiritually Adopted baby squint, swallow, and move his tongue. Your baby can make a tight fist if you touch his/her palm.

Baby obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce.

Suggestions for concluding the program:

A closing Mass or Service, a Communion Breakfast, a "Baby Shower" from which the gifts, diapers, formula can be donated to a nearby crisis pregnancy center.

NOTE: Volunteers say that diapers, receiving blankets, Onesies, and bibs are the most needed items.




