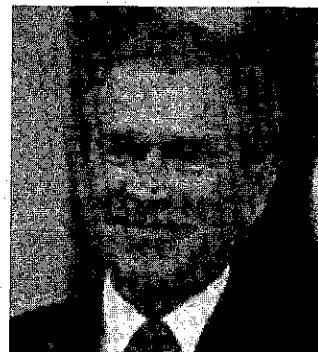

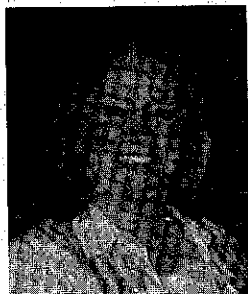

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

PRESIDENT CASTS VETO—Pres.

George W. Bush cast the first veto of his tenure when on 7/19/06 he vetoed funding of embryonic stem cell research (See Pg. 1.) The track record for success in using human embryos to treat any human disease is zero.



CHILD CUSTODY BILL TO CONFERENCE—

On 7/25/06, the Senate passed, 65-34, the Child Custody Protection Act. The House version of the bill had passed previously. The bill would establish as a federal crime the action of transporting a minor across state lines for an abortion. Pres. Bush said he will sign the legislation when differences in the two bills are resolved.

U.S. SUPREME COURT TO TAKE UP TWO PARTIAL-BIRTH ABORTION BAN CASES

beginning Fall 2006.

ACTION NEEDED:

In upcoming FDA hearings on Plan B, the controversial morning-after emergency contraceptive, Barr Laboratories Inc. is expected to seek approval of non-prescription sales of Plan B to persons 18 years and older.

Sample messages:

Over-the-counter availability will encourage the routine use of Plan B. Since this medication contains megadoses of the chemicals used in birth-control pills the health risks are enormous. No medical supervision would be provided the woman. There is no protection for the minors forced into relationships, and, parental involvement is non-existent.

--Urge President Bush to intervene.

--Urge the FDA to refuse approval of the non-prescription sale of Plan B to those 18 and up.

PATAKI VETOES 9/11 CUSTOM PLATE; TRIES

TO BLAME 'CHOOSE LIFE' LAWSUIT—

On 7/28/06 the Rochester Democrat and Chronicle, Albany Times Union and The Journal News reported Gov. Pataki vetoed 15 custom plates including the "9/11/01 Remembrance Plate", "Cure Childhood Cancer", the "Westchester Way", the "Kiwaniis International" plate, etc.

According to the Albany Times Union, Pataki attempted to blame his custom plate vetoes on "a pro-adoption organization, The Children First Foundation in Eastchester, [who] is suing the state in federal court over an effort to get official 'Choose Life' plates showing the 'Choose Life' logo and wording FUND-ADOPTION.ORG which will support NYS Adoption and Safe Haven efforts."

In August 2004 the DMV placed a moratorium on new custom plates in a transparent attempt to block the approval of the New York "Choose Life" place. Alliance Defense Fund filed a federal lawsuit against the Governor, the Attorney General and the DMV. A trial date is pending.

"Every citizen, lawmaker, newspaper.....organization should be outraged as I am over this unprecedented attack upon the civil rights of so many important causes and organizations including our own," said Dr. Elizabeth Rex, Pres. BEAUTY AT ANY COST?



The latest trend among wealthy women around the world appears to be an 'anti-aging' stem cell treatment. The article "A Barbaric Kind of Beauty", by Andrea Thompson, appeared in the Daily Mail (UK) on August 7, 2006. She states, "My investigation threw up a worrying new trade across the globe in unregulated stem cell treatments costing anywhere between £150 and £20,000."

The Institute for Regenerative Medicine on Barbados is located in one of the most up-scale hotels on the island, the Villa Nova. The clinic opened last year. U.S. investors, Ukrainian researchers and the Caribbean tourist industry are working hand-in-hand. They have "avoided the strict ethical barriers to such treatment enforced in Europe and America". The clinic has a waiting list of 1,000. Tissue is obtained from aborted 6 to 12 week old fetuses. Jenny, a consultant at the clinic stated, "We inject the cells taken from the liver tissue of human fetuses directly into the vein in the back of your hand...The results are incredible. You'll feel and look different after a month because these cells help the body to regenerate itself. The effects last for approximately a year before it needs to be 'topped up.'" The chief executive of the Institute, Barnett Suskind states, "It is the most natural form of healing there is - in ten years, everyone will be doing this. You think better, sleep better and look better."

Dr. Stephen Minger, director of stem cell biology at King's College, London argues, "But what this clinic is doing raises serious issues. For a start, it is not regulated by any medical board and there is no documented evidence or controlled clinical trials to back up their claims. More worryingly, there is no proof that the tissue is obtained by truly elective abortions rather than financially induced ones. Research shows that they openly import fetuses from poverty-stricken provinces in Ukraine and Russia, preying on the financially desperate to treat vain Western women."

In Moscow, there are more than 50 clinics - the Cellulite Clinic is just one - that "use loopholes in the law to administer injections." Anti-aging injections in the thighs, buttocks and stomach can cost from £10,000 to £15,000 for a six-part series. "Nearby Ukraine is home to Emcell, the world's largest clinic that has openly experimented in stem-cell therapy for the past 15 years and administers hundreds of anti-ageing therapies a year." Cow, pig and human fetal stem cells are injected. Dr. Elena Bochkaryova stated, "I have had patients who leave my clinic after a course

of injections looking and feeling 10 years younger." Russia and the Ukraine have the highest abortion rate in the world. Andrea Thompson writes, "Evidence gathered by the Moscow police department has shown a growing black market in aborted fetuses, which are smuggled into Russia from the Ukraine and Georgia. Here poverty-stricken young women are paid 200 US dollars to carry babies up to the optimum eight to twelve week period - thought to be best for harvesting stem cells. They are then sold on to cosmetic clinics." Dr. Minger states, "The cavalier attitude of Russian cosmetic surgeons is grotesque. The origin of the cells is ethically immoral. Furthermore, they don't bother to test for compatibility between the cells injected and the patient who receives them. Medical risks from complications can include infection, tumors and rejection of foreign tissue."

The Medra Clinic in the Dominican Republic is run by psychiatrist William Rader from Malibu. Fetal stem cell injections start at £15,000. The fetuses reportedly come from the former Soviet republic of Georgia. Consultations are done at his LA office. Patients then travel to the La Romana resort. Medra's website states that the fetal stem cell "detects and then attempts to repair any damage or deficit discovered in the body as well as releasing growth factors, which stimulate the body's own repair mechanisms." Rader declares "Stem cell therapy is the future. It's just unfortunate that there is so much opposition to it in the West." Dr Minger replies, "Because Rader is acting outside America, his work falls outside US regulations on stem cell therapy. Patients risk at best wasting a lot of money on a treatment that is not proven in clinical trials and at worst one that is putting their health at serious risk."

The Nabi Medspa in Manhattan offers facials made from cells "harvested from the embryonic fluid of pregnant cows". The spa claims that skin that has been damaged by 'environmental factors' can be restored with these treatments. A consultant at the spa stated that "the cows are not hurt in any way during the process." Amazingly, society is more concerned with the ethical treatment of cows than it is with the ethical treatment of human life at its earliest stages. How long do you think it will be before spas in the US will be permitted to offer these same treatments - without concern for ethics or sound medical practices?
