FEDERAL LEGISLATION

As of Dec. 9, the Presidential race is not settled. The Electoral College meets Dec. 14, and the Congress needs to accept the results in early January. Led by Mayor Giuliani, lawyers for Pres. Trump are alleging a wide range of Election irregularities. Among them are:

On Jan. 3, 2019, House Democrats introduced **HR.1**, (which passed the House, but not the Senate), to ‘expand voter registration and access’, etc. In 2020, about 300 lawsuits were filed by the Democrats to loosen safeguards on voting in several states. The US Constitution says that state legislatures decide how Presidential Electors are chosen. But if legislatures didn’t act as Democrats wanted, further suits often got the courts or executive branch officials to (unconstitutionally) change the election laws, sometimes weeks before ‘Election Day’. (SCOTUS, on Dec 8, declined to review such changes in Pennsylvania, but the Court could still review a similar case filed by Texas.) The result is that mailed votes, arriving unsigned after Election Day, could be counted, but ‘in person’ voters must show up on time, and sign in, (an ‘equal protection violation’?) Hundreds of pages of sworn affidavits flag violations in the collection and counting of ballots and the rules for observation of the process. Some contested states are currently holding hearings into these charges.

There are also questions regarding the electronic voting systems that were used. In 2016, we were told “Russia could not have changed lots of votes - the machines aren’t hooked up to the Internet.” Many of the 2020 machines were connected to the Internet. Some pundits say the election was a *coup d’etat*, while others cite recent staff and policy changes that AG Barr and Pres. Trump made, as prep for election problems. If former VP Biden is President, and the House (barely) in Democrat hands, the Senate is the only firewall to stop radical anti-life policies, pending results in Georgia’s Senate run-offs. Hopefully, the current Nine Justice Supreme Court, including Justices Kavanaugh and Barrett, will provide pro-life opinions.

Policy changes to expect if former VP Biden is President: Abortion ‘enshrined’ in Federal law, i.e. taxpayer funded, and restored abortion funds for PP, UN-FPA, Title X, and foreign aid organizations. The ‘Mexico City’, Hyde & Helms Amendments will be gone. Easy access will be provided for RU-486. Ability of conscientious objection will be restricted. Before the inauguration, Pres. Trump may finalize new rules for nine federal departments (Education, DOJ, HHS, Labor, etc.) allowing for more federal funds to religious organizations.

Former VP Biden staff picks of concern: - Neera Tanden (OMB) had a big role in writing the HHS abortifacient/sterilization/ contraceptive mandate. Sen. Kamala Harris (possible VP) grilled a judge nominee about his K of C membership. Xavier Becerra (HHS), prosecuted David Daleiden, and *NIFLA v. Becerra*. Randi

Weingarten (Dept. of Ed) may force more government mandates on private, religious and home schools.

AOC and other Democrats have spoken openly about listing every person who worked in the Trump Administration and ensuring they can never find meaningful work again.

Defying expectations, the GOP gained US House seats, including at least 17 new prolife female Reps. Reps. Zeldin, Garbarino, Suozzi, Rice, Meeks, Meng and AOC were local House winners. **Note:** The numbers on all bills expired at the end of 2020. However, they can be reintroduced with a different bill number.

Supreme Court: Justice Gorsuch nixed *Jacobson v Massachusetts* [1905], in rejecting NY’s COVID rules on houses of worship. Pro-abortion articles called *Jacobson* “the legal root of abortion.” It is the first use of the concept of “bodily integrity.” However, oral arguments for *Roe & Doe* didn’t cite *Jacobson*. SCOTUS may hear challenges to Mississippi’s 15-week abortion ban, and a Pittsburgh ‘bubble zone’ law.

Colorado & Louisiana had abortion restrictions on their ballots. Colorado rejected, but Louisiana’s passed. In late November, the 5th Circuit Court overturned the lower court, saying Texas and Louisiana can defund PP.



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

Carl Campanile of the *New York Post* reported on 11/30/20 that the Democrats have claimed a super or veto-proof majority in the NYS Senate. Campanile stated, “Democrats now completely dominate New York State government... The huge majorities will make it easier for Cuomo and Democrats to pass policies they agree on.”

Bills of concern to the LICL include: the Unborn Victims of Violence Act, the Born-Alive Abortion Survivor’s Act, Physician-Assisted Suicide bills, the Public University Emergency Contraception Act, and legislation which would require all SUNY and CUNY campuses to stock and provide abortion pills. Corona Virus Vaccines



The American Association of Pro-Life Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the American College of Pediatricians, The Christian Medical and Dental Associations, and the Catholic Medical Association released a statement in early December stating the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines did not use cells from aborted babies in their production phases. However, the statement did acknowledge that abortion-derived fetal cells were used in the animal-phase testing for the vaccines. The groups noted that there are ethical alternatives to aborted fetal cells, such as umbilical cord tissue and adult stem cells. Over the past few years, many viral vaccines have been produced without using aborted fetal cell lines. The statement continued, “These and other ethical approaches provide encouragement for the future, where no vaccine will violate the dignity of human life in their production.” The groups asked pharmaceutical companies to commit to “assurances of safety, efficacy and uncompromised ethical development [of vaccines]. It is profoundly important to recognize the vaccines may have been developed with the use of abortion-derived fetal cell lines. This awareness is necessary from the perspective of both the health care professional and the patient, and every participant in this process deserves to know the source of the vaccine used to allow them to follow their moral conscience.”

The Charlotte Lozier Institute (CLI) recently issued a new chart listing the eight leading COVID vaccines and indicating whether they were produced or tested using aborted fetal cell lines. Most of those on the list did not use cell lines derived from abortions in production. Several, however, used aborted fetal cell lines in laboratory testing. Vaccines using cells from aborted babies pose moral problems for many individuals. CLI said in a statement, “Unfortunately, some vaccine developers have unnecessarily put American families in a difficult position by choosing to use controversial human fetal cell lines in production or testing, or by a lack of transparency. Many developers already opt to use animal cell lines, non-fetal human cells, yeast, or chicken eggs instead. We urge all developers to avail themselves of these options going forward. Doing so will reduce vaccine hesitancy for those who oppose the use of fetal cell lines, thereby increasing the public health impact of the vaccine.”

CLI evaluated vaccines produced by Pfizer/BioNTech, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson, Novavax, Sanofi/GSK, Inovio and Merck. AstraZeneca and Johnson & Johnson use aborted fetal cell lines in development, production, and lab testing. Pfizer/BioNTech, Moderna, Novavax and Inovio use aborted fetal cell lines in some of their testing, but not in development or production. CLI could not determine if Sanofi/GSK and Merck used aborted fetal cell lines in lab testing. However, they do not use aborted fetal cell lines in development or production of the vaccine.

CLI stated, “It remains to be seen which vaccines will be approved for emergency use and how soon they will be available to patients. CLI will continue to provide the public with access to timely and accurate information so that individuals and families can weigh all factors – including secular science and religious traditions – and make vaccine decisions in line with their conscience.” Dr. David Prentice, Vice President of CLI, explained that if aborted fetal cell lines are used in production, the cells are “directly involved in the making of the final product, the vaccine that is injected in our arms. It is an essential element for the final vaccine...Although the connection is distant both in time and space, since the abortion occurred decades ago and the cells have been grown in the lab ever since, that connection to abortion remains and is of concern to many Americans.” Lab testing using aborted fetal cell lines is “potentially less morally problematic,” according to Prentice, since it is “another step removed. When an abortion-derived cell line is used in laboratory testing, that is not done within the production line. It’s a confirmatory test done on the final vaccine, to validate what the scientists believe they’ve produced. So this is another step removed, and there was nothing touching the abortion-derived cell line that ended up in the final vaccine product, or in our arms. For some, it doesn’t completely remove the concern. It is important to note that there are testing methods that can be done with cells not derived from abortion.” (Source: Mary Margaret Olohan, Lifenews.com, 12/3/20)

Micaiah Bilger noted on Lifenews.com (12/4/20) that pharmaceutical companies are starting to listen to the prolife call to create ethical vaccines. Bilger wrote that Sanofi-Pasteur announced in September that they plan “to produce a new, ethically developed polio vaccine. The project will replace an older vaccine that was developed with cells from an aborted baby...Sanofi-Pasteur is one of the largest vaccine production companies in the world. Ethical alternatives to cells from aborted babies are available, including pluripotent stem cells and tissue from placentas, umbilical cords and amniotic fluid. In 2018, the Trump administration created a \$20 million grant to invest in these ethical research alternatives.”


