Assisted Suicide / Euthanasia: When a fellow human being seeks suicide, the healthcare system and the community need to offer proper care for the person's pain (physical or mental), not helping to push that person into the abyss. New York State's physician assisted suicide law has the euphemistic title 'Medical Aid in Dying;' it's actually state-sanctioned suicide. Pro-lifers lost a decade's long battle to hold back the proponents of assisted suicide and euthanasia, who are working to expand NYS's MAID law. Our challenge now is to educate the public, especially those vulnerable to the talons of the assisted suicide/euthanasia lobby, that assisted suicide is not an acceptable treatment. Infant and Maternal Mortality Rates

Pro-abortion activists claim infant and maternal mortality rates have risen since the 2022 *Dobbs* decision, stating abortion bans have caused an increase in deaths. In fact, CDC data shows the infant mortality rate down by 3.3% and the maternal mortality rate down by 19.7%. Improved maternal healthcare including extended postpartum coverage and investments in perinatal care have been cited as reasons for the improvement.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

In Jan. 2023, the Biden Administration's FDA said the mifepristone abortion pill could be obtained via mail-order. In Oct. 2025, *Louisiana v. FDA* was filed against

the 2023 rules (REMS or *Risk Evaluation & Mitigation Strategies*) on behalf of a Louisiana woman claiming her boyfriend ordered the pills from out of state and then forced her to take them against her will. In May 2025, Sen. Josh Hawley and others introduced **HR.5646/S.1631 Restoring Safeguards for Dangerous Abortion Drugs Act**, to restore pre-2023 REMS, and allow lawsuits against the pill's manufacturers. Also in 2025, HHS Sec. Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. and Comm. Dr. Martin Makary, promised a full review of the abortion pill's safety.

In Jan. 2026 President Trump's DOJ filed a Memo claiming Louisiana's legal challenge to the REMS expansions is "disruptive" and possibly "unnecessary" due to the agency's ongoing mifepristone review. The DOJ, on behalf of the FDA, asked a federal court to halt the Louisiana lawsuit. On March 11, 2026, Sen. Hawley introduced **S.4066, Safeguarding Women from Chemical Abortion Act**, to ban the use of mifepristone, outlaw distributing it to cause an abortion, and withdrawing the drug's FDA approval - because, he said, the FDA's review is still in the "data acquisition phase." The corresponding House bill is **H.R.7902**, introduced by Rep. Diana Harshbarger (no LI co-sponsors).

On March 16, 2026, Pres. Trump's DOJ sent a similar Memo to Florida and Texas, which had filed suits v. the original year 2000 FDA approval of mifepristone. A week later, the US Senate Health, Education, Labor & Pensions Committee sent letters to abortion pill manufacturers Danco Labs, GenBioPro and Evita Solutions (Evita makes the generic abortion pill approved in Oct. 2025), seeking info regarding their possible flouting of current REMS. Hawley also created a hotline to report abortion pill problems.

On March 30, 2026, Kristen Hawkins of Students for Life sent a letter to then-Attorney General Pam Bondi, asking Bondi to enforce the 1873 Comstock Act. Kristin asked, "If we are going to claim we must follow 'the rules' to fund abortion vendors, then we should also enforce the law that prohibits mailing chemical abortion pills. The Comstock Act is already federal law, and it makes it ILLEGAL to traffic dangerous abortion drugs by mail..."

Last year, HHS froze \$65M in *Title X* family planning funds, set by the Biden Administration for organizations that do abortions. Planned Parenthood, the ACLU and others sued. In Jan. 2026, with a loss likely, Pres. Trump's HHS freed the \$65M, the lawsuits were dropped, and future Planned Parenthood defunding was promised. On March 31, 2026, the White House again said Title X funds granted by the Biden Administration were legally obligated to be paid in 2026, but can't pay for abortions, and end in 2026.

Despite earlier doubts, HHS confirmed on April 2, 2026, that part of a Title X agenda of *proposed* rules is the Protect Life Rule, which states that no entity can get Title X funds if they perform or "...refer for, nor

encourage, abortion." Sen. Hawley noted that the Rule also mandated a "physical separation" between family planning and abortion services.

On April 7, 2026, Pres. Trump released his proposed FY2027 budget. Proposals include: *barring abortion providers from getting appropriated funds under Labor, Health & Human Services bill; *ending the ineffective Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program, Planned Parenthood's second biggest funding stream, but also ending the Sexual Risk Avoidance Program, which promotes abstinence and sends funding to Pregnancy Resource Centers; *extending Amendments prohibiting federal funding such as the Hyde (no direct paying for abortion - with usual 3 exceptions); Dickey-Wicker (no federally-funded embryo-destroying research); Helms (no abortion paid by foreign aid); Kemp-Kasten (no US funds to organizations or programs that coerce abortion); Siljander (no US foreign assistance funds to be used to lobby for/against abortion); Hyde-Weldon (healthcare entity conscience rights regarding abortion payment or referral.) Other proposals include: *extending ban on abortion funding for federal prisoners, Wash. DC residents, and federal employee health plans; *no federal funding for research on aborted baby parts, or for aid workers doing overseas abortions; *abortion training must be a medical student's choice, not a mandate; * a new 'Protecting Life in Foreign Assistance rule'.

The HHS Civil Rights Office is investigating thirteen blue states (including NY) accused of discriminating against entities that decline to cover abortions, citing conscience protections.



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

S.1571-a Krueger/A.928-a Steck was re-introduced. It would pay abortion travel expenses for NY military servicewomen who are based in an abortion-restricting state. Senate bill is in the Senate Finance Committee. Assembly bill is in Assembly Health Committee. (No LI cosponsors.)

On March 18, 2026, Gov. Hochul announced \$20 million in grant funding for pill abortions stating, "We are facing a time when our fundamental rights are under attack by anti-choice politicians who are determined to dismantle established reproductive freedoms...I will never back down from fighting to protect access to health care..." The funding can be used by the abortion industry for marketing, recruitment, expanding existing services, and covering abortion costs not funded through other sources.

ACTION ITEM: Ask your Congressperson to co-sponsor **H.R. 7902, Safeguarding Women from Chemical Abortion Act**.

HEALTH & SCIENCE: “Brave New World Alert” – Uterine Research

Wesley J. Smith published an article on March 30, 2026, in the *National Review* entitled, “Human Uterus Kept Functioning Outside the Body for Experiments.” He reported that a machine that is used for organ transplants kept a human uterus alive for a day. The long-term goal is to use donated uteruses for experimentation, including gestating a human embryo. Jessica Hamzelou announced the research in the *MIT Technology Review* on March 28, 2026, stating, “The team members want to keep donated human uteruses alive long enough to see a full menstrual cycle. They hope this will help them study diseases of the uterus and learn more about how embryos burrow their way into the organ’s lining at the start of a pregnancy. They also hope that future iterations of their device might one day sustain the full gestation of a human fetus. The machine is technically called PUPER, which stands for “preservation of the uterus in perfusion.” But...the team has adopted a nickname for it: “We call it ‘Mother.’”

Smith replied, “Well, that’s reductionist and instrumentalizing. Gestating a baby involves far more of the mother’s body and self than a functioning uterus. She gives her very being to her baby. Indeed, we all have millions of our mother’s cells in our own bodies. The scientific and financial drive for unlimited reproductive technologies is driving this train.” The MIT article noted that the founder and director of the foundation doing the research, Carlos Simon, “believes it’s a sticking point in IVF: Scientists have made many improvements to the technology over the years, but the failure of embryos to implant underlies plenty of unsuccessful IVF cycles...Being able to carefully study how the process works in a real, living organ might give the team a better idea of how to prevent those failures.”

Smith acknowledged that “some of the experiments would be scientifically valuable and ethical (a uterus has no intrinsic value in and of itself.” The team would like to keep “uteruses alive for about 28 days in order to study the menstrual cycle and disorders that affect the uterus, like endometriosis and fibroids.” That research could be beneficial and ethical.

However, Smith emphasized that the significant ethical problem is that the team’s primary focus is to study “how embryos implant in the uterine lining” and “to test the process in their outside-the-body uteruses.” The MIT piece stated, “They won’t be allowed to use human embryos for this – that would cross an ethical boundary. Instead, they plan to use embryo-like structures made from stem cells. The structures closely resemble human embryos but are created in the lab without sperm or eggs.”

Smith argued, “It is not at all certain that these “embryo-like” entities aren’t human organisms. Merely asserting it doesn’t make it so. Moreover, cloned human embryos are not made with sperm and eggs and are just as human as you and I are – just as Dolly was fully a sheep.” Smith then warned that the goal of the project doesn’t end there. The MIT article noted that Carlos Simon “sees a future in which a machine like “Mother” will be able to fully gestate a human, all the way from embryo to newborn.”

Smith concluded, “So, the plan ultimately is to manufacture human life solely for experimenting upon, toward the utilitarian end of making embryos and fetuses that might eventually be used for “fetal farming” – obtaining organs for transplant from the unborn, etc. – or be sustained to birth. Not only would such experiments *not* be for the benefit and welfare of the human beings thereby created, but would denigrate the intrinsic importance of mothering during pregnancy and further the end of establishing novel family structures...At the very least, such goals further the idea that unborn humans are mere resources with no rights that the born are bound to respect.”

FROM PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S RECENTLY RELEASED 2024-2025 ANNUAL REPORT

- *a record-high 434,450 pre-born children were killed in abortions in its 2024-2025 fiscal year
 - *abortions at PP increased by 8% from the previous year
 - *PP received a record-high \$832 million in taxpayer funding during this period
 - *taxpayer funding increased 5% over the previous year
 - *PP consistently receives nearly 40% of its budget from taxpayer funds
 - *PP kills more than 1,190 pre-born children every day
 - *PP commits almost 39% of all abortions in the United States
 - *PP's telehealth services increased 126% from 2024 to 2025
 - *over the last 25 years, PP has killed nearly 8 million pre-born children
 - *over the last 25 years, PP has provided only 331,000 prenatal care services (down 55% over last 10 years)
 - *over the last 25 years, PP has received \$12.3 billion in taxpayer funds
 - *preventive care visits at PP have fallen by 3.2%
 - *PP reports that cancer screenings fell by 8.6% (down more than 42% over last 10 years)
 - *for every adoption referral that PP reported in 2024, PP performed over 143 abortions

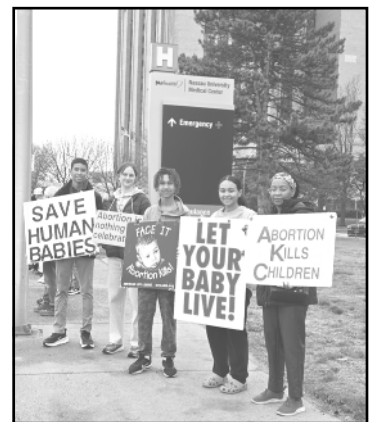
