Pro-life reservations with IVF funding include:

*IVF most often results in the creation, freezing, discarding, and systematic destruction of embryos

*greater numbers of embryos are implanted to increase the likelihood of at least one embryo surviving implantation; however, if 'too many' survive implantation, then 'fetal reduction' (abortion) is recommended

*Pre-Implantation Diagnosis is often used to pick and choose embryos based on health, physical characteristics, and gender

*Leads to the mentality to manufacture the best 'product' most efficiently, and to 'throw away' the ones that fail 'quality control'


