

### Death by Dehydration

“The United Kingdom’s Supreme Court has ruled that court orders are not necessarily needed before withdrawing hydration and nutrition from a comatose patient. If doctors and the patient’s family agree that on-going treatment is not in his best interests, it may be stopped without applying for a court order... The judgement was welcomed by Compassion in Dying, a sister organization to the assisted-dying campaign group Dignity in Dying... Dr. Peter Saunders of the Christian Medical Fellowship stated, “Once we accept that death by dehydration is in some brain-damaged people’s ‘best interests’ we are on a very slippery slope indeed. There is a clear difference between turning off a ventilator on a brain-dead patient and removing CANH (clinically assisted nutrition and hydration) from a brain-damaged patient. In the first case the patient dies from their underlying brain injury. In the second they die from dehydration and starvation. Similarly, PVS (persistent vegetative states) and MCS (minimally conscious states) differ from conditions with a ‘downward trajectory’ because they are not progressive and do not in themselves lead inevitably to death. The (UK) Supreme Court has set a dangerous precedent. Taking these decisions away from the Court of Protection removes an important layer of legislative scrutiny and accountability and effectively weakens the law. It will make it more likely that severely brain-damaged patients will be starved or dehydrated to death in their supposed ‘best interests’ and that these decisions will be more influenced by those who have ideological or financial vested interests in this course of action.”

### Conscientious Objection

“An ‘expert group’ of abortion activists has launched a strong attack on the concept and practice of conscientious objection (CO) in healthcare... A 46-page report, *Unconscionable: When Providers Deny Abortion Care*, argues that “the practice of refusing to provide legal and essential health care due to a doctor’s personal or religious beliefs is a violation of medical ethics and of patients’ right to health care.” The conclusions of the report are based on a meeting held in Montevideo, Uruguay last year which brought together 45 participants from 22 countries... To counter-attack against the growth of CO, the report recommends four avenues: *Reframe and rename*. Reframe the debate to clarify and emphasize that ‘conscientious objection’ is a misnomer that subverts the ethics, obligations, and standards of the health care profession. *Reclaim the concept of conscience*. Do not cede the term ‘conscience’ to those who prioritize individual beliefs over professional conduct and the right to access or provide health care. Shine a light on the harmful health consequences of conscience claims in the context of abortion care. Emphasize the ‘conscientious commitment’ and professional conduct of health care providers who prioritize patients’ rights. *Quantify the costs incurred by health systems due to claims of ‘conscientious objection’ to abortion*. Managing conscience claims can be costly and can create inefficiencies in the allocation of scarce health care resources. Quantifying the costs would fill a gap in our understanding of the consequences of refusal to provide abortion care due to conscience claims. Renaming is an important part of the activists’ campaign. Instead of ‘conscientious objection’, they suggest that it be called ‘refusal to provide services,’ ‘denial of services,’ or even ‘dishonorable disobedience’.”

## FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The US Supreme Court's session begins Oct. 1. As of September 5th, no major life issues or conscience rights cases are on the 2018-19 docket.

Those familiar with Washington feel that most Congressional action for the rest of 2018 will be on appropriations bills to fund the government. Sen. Paul [R-KY] tried in August to add a PP defund amendment to the Senate bill for funding the Departments of Defense, Labor, HHS and Education. The amendment failed.

Led by Rep. C. Smith [R-NJ], 102 Congress-members sent a letter to HHS Sec. Azar, asking for regulations that clearly tell consumers which ObamaCare policies cover elective abortion. Policies that do, must, by law, include a separate 'abortion surcharge', but current insurance regulations mean companies often hide that fee from consumers. Smith said a more complete fix would be for the Senate to pass his *No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act (HR.7)*, which has already been passed by the House.

The *Protect Life Rule*, which bans *Title X* family planning funds from going to facilities that do abortions, had not taken effect when HHS released its new *Title X* grants on Aug. 2. Thirteen PP's were included.

On Aug. 30, the Administration said the current *Title X* funding period will not last three years, as before, but will end in March 2019. Both pro and anti-life forces saw this as a way to cut PP's money ASAP. Those funds will then go to non-abortioning, federally qualified health facilities. (See Jul/Aug & Sep 2018 LN's, p.3)

The FDA's most recent update says that from Sept. 2000 to Dec. 2017, women taking the RU-486 abortion pill experienced 22 deaths, 97 ectopic pregnancies (2 of the women died), 411 infections and 1,041 hospitalizations.

On July 25, the FDA signed a 1-year contract with *Advanced Bioscience Resources (ABR)* to obtain freshly aborted baby parts to create mice with 'human' immune systems. The FDA says this is the *only* way to create these mice, which are used to test new drugs that only work in humans. (Abortions were done at 17-24 weeks.)

Undercover videographer David Daleiden, and two committees of Congress, allege ABR is a company that obtains aborted baby-parts by working with PP. David is back in Court, arguing that since 7 of 11 charges against him have been dropped, including all charges for illegal video recording, the Gag Order on his remaining videos should now end.

Shortly before the raid on David's home, his lawyers allege that lawyers from PP met with then California AG Kamala Harris. David's lawyers have subpoenaed every person at that meeting. A court date is set for Oct. 4 or 5.

### STATES ROUNDUP:

*Whole Women's Health (WWH)*, a Texas abortion chain, sued the State in 2016 regarding a law that aborted remains be buried or cremated. When Texas' Catholic Bishops offered to help with the burials, WWH sued the Bishops, to get their internal communication regarding abortion. Citing 'constitutional protection of religious belief', the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals has twice rejected WWH's suit versus the

Bishops. (see LN 9/2016, p3)

Indiana's law requiring an ultrasound 18 hours prior to an abortion, and offering the woman a chance to view it, is unconstitutional, according to the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals.

The 11th Circuit nixed Alabama's D & E abortion ban, noting controlling Supreme Court precedent dictates that "Alabama cannot forbid this method of abortion entirely."

The owners of an Ohio abortuary split into two 'clinics' and are now suing each other as to which is the real facility. (See [lifesitenews.com](http://lifesitenews.com), Aug. 21)

NARAL Oregon worked with *What's the Scoop Ice Cream*, to make a limited run flavor 'Rocky Roe v Wade'.

### NEWS NOTES:

The pro-abort *International Women's Health Coalition* does not want governments to allow conscience opt-outs for medical persons asked to perform abortions.

*Whatbusinessstinks.com* is a website that lists some of the actions taken by many entities, on a variety of issues, including abortion.

Millions of pro-lifers took to the streets of Argentina, as their Senate debated a law allowing abortion up to 14 weeks. On Aug. 9, the bill was defeated 38-31.

United Way chapters in 29 states sent \$2.7M to PP in 2016, reports *2nd Vote* - enough to do 2,900 abortions.

## NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

Pro-abortion Asw. Deborah Glick (D. Manhattan) has proffered bill A.11150,

which would authorize a 'study' of pro-life pregnancy centers. This bill would subject these centers to state sponsored harassment and undue financial burdens, ostensibly for the purpose of protecting 'reproductive health.' This is a back-door attempt to shut down centers that offer alternatives to abortion. So much for 'choice.' (The NYS Assembly website lists no actions on Glick's bill.)

### FDA PURCHASES ABORTED BABY PARTS



Information published by the FDA and the General Services Administration indicate that the Food and Drug Administration has signed a new contract to purchase body parts from aborted babies. A June 13 'pre-solicitation notice' for the contract stated, "The objective is to acquire tissue for humanized mice. [The contractor would] provide the human fetal tissue needed to continue the ongoing research being led by the FDA. Fresh human tissues are required for implantation into severely immune-compromised mice to create chimeric animals that have a human immune system."

The GSA's federal contract database states that Advanced Bioscience Resources (ABR), a non-profit based in the San Francisco Bay area, was awarded this \$15,900 contract, which runs through July 25, 2019. The Congressional Research Service states that "Fetal tissue used in research is obtained through elective abortions. CNS News reported that the FDA is using federal tax dollars to create a demand for human body parts that must be taken from babies who are aborted." Steven Ertelt wrote at Lifenews.com on August 7<sup>th</sup>, "Because it would not be able to create its 'humanized mice' without fresh tissue taken from aborted babies, the FDA also has an interest in the continuation of legalized abortions at a stage in fetal development when the tissue needed to create these mice can be retrieved from the aborted baby."

CNS News contacted the FDA concerning this contract. The FDA confirmed that its June 13 pre-solicitation notice for a contract to "acquire tissue for humanized mice" and the July 25<sup>th</sup> contract it signed with ABR refer to the same deal. However, the FDA declined to answer 17 other questions from CNS News. The FDA provided CNS News with a three-paragraph statement, stressing that it was committed to making certain its research followed "all legal requirements" and met "the highest ethical standards".

Ertelt reported that in addition to the "destruction of human life and the exploitation of aborted babies by using their body parts for research, the pro-life movement has long questioned the ethics of transplanting human brain cells into other species." Research at the University of Rochester involved injecting mice with glial cells from human fetuses. Glial cells...support neurons in the nervous system. The mice incorporated these glial cells into their brain and "outperformed normal mice almost fourfold in a variety of cognition tests." The researchers stressed that the mice still had mouse brains, saying "This does not provide the ani-

mals with additional capabilities that could in any way be ascribed or perceived as specifically human. Rather, the human cells are simply improving the efficiency of the mouse's own neural networks. It's still a mouse." The paper published in the Journal of Neuroscience clearly states that the glial cells came from second trimester abortions. The scientists are hoping to study the contribution of glial cells to human neurological disorders. The ends can't justify the means. Ertelt stated, "the source of the glial cells morally taints all their research. They could have used cells from ethical sources like a natural miscarriage, but they did not."

Ertelt notes that "the mixing of human brain cells with those of other species, especially those of other primates, raises serious ethical considerations."

Dr. David Prentice, Vice President and Research Director at the Charlotte Lozier Institute stated, "It is outrageous that the FDA would aid in the trafficking of aborted baby parts and fetal tissue. This not only fosters government-sponsored participation in unethical research but continues use of outdated scientific methods. Humanized mice can and have been made, for years, using ethical cell sources, including umbilical cord blood and peripheral blood stem cells. High quality, modern scientific research has no need for unethical, tainted practices and grisly sources. Our government should lead in ethics and science and should rescind any contracts for use of aborted tissue."

Tom McClusky, President of March for Life Action noted, "After an undercover investigation (David Daleiden/CMP videos) and a Congressional investigation exposed the horrors of an industry that harvests and sells baby body parts, there is no excuse for anyone, much less the taxpayer funded federal government to enter into contracts that prop up this gruesome practice. Such contracts should be immediately terminated, and the baby body parts trafficking industry shut down."

Lila Rose, Live Action Founder and President said, "The FDA's purchasing of fetal tissue from aborted babies is immoral and horrific, violating human dignity and implicating the American taxpayer in the gruesome trade of human body parts... These children deserved care and protection, but instead were violently stripped of their fundamental rights and are now being sold piecemeal. The company that the FDA is doing business with, ABR, is currently under federal investigation for colluding with Planned Parenthood to sell aborted baby body parts for profit. We call on the FDA to terminate its contract with ABR immediately and cease the experimentation on the bodies of aborted children."


