

Bill 1: to create a pro-abortion panel to investigate Pregnancy Help Centers - 2020
 Bill 2: to create a pro-abortion panel to investigate Pregnancy Help centers - 2022
 Bill 3: Shields abortionists from professional misconduct charges for serving women from states banning abortion

Synthetic Embryos for Organ Harvesting



The journal *Cell* published an article (8/1/22) stating that Israeli researchers created the world’s first “synthetic embryos” using mouse stem cells which were nurtured in an ‘artificial womb’ and grown for 8½ days (equivalent to about 3 weeks in a human pregnancy). Jacob Hanna of the Weizmann Institute of Science said, “We view the embryo as the best 3D bio printer. It’s the best entity to make organs and proper tissue.” Bernard Siegel of the World Stem Cell Summit said, “This experiment has huge implications. One wonders what mammal could be next in line.”

Scientists from the University of Cambridge posted a report on SciTechDaily.com (8/27/22) and announced that they “have created model embryos from mouse stem cells that form a beating heart, and the foundations of all the other organs of the body. It represents a new avenue for recreating the first stages of life. The team... developed the embryo model without eggs or sperm. Instead, they used stem cells – the body’s master cells, which can develop into almost any cell type in the body... The stem cells self-organized into structures that progressed through the successive developmental stages... They also had the yolk sac where the embryo develops and gets nutrients from in its first weeks. Unlike other synthetic embryos, the Cambridge-developed models reached the point where the entire brain... began to develop. This is a further point in

development than has been achieved in any other stem cell-derived model... According to the team, their results could help researchers understand why some embryos fail while others go on to develop into a healthy pregnancy. In addition, the results could be used to guide the repair and development of synthetic human organs for transplantation... The study... was reported on 8/25/22 in the journal *Nature*.”

Michael Cook of Bioedge.com stated at Lifenews.com (8/16/22), “Obviously the next mammal is homo sapiens.” The goal of Hanna’s start-up company, Renewal Bio, “is to make humanity younger and healthier by leveraging the power of the new stem cell technology” to treat conditions such as “infertility, genetic diseases, and longevity.” Cook noted that Hanna “believes there will be a huge market for products derived from synthetic human embryos... Dr Hanna and his colleagues want to strip-mine human embryos which have been custom-made for their clients.” The creation of the placenta and the yolk sac “suggests that perhaps a baby could reach full term in an artificial womb with no need for a mother at all.” Hanna insists that he’s not trying to make Human beings. He stated, “To call a 40-day embryo a mini-me is just not true.” Cook argued, “Whether or not it is human is not for [Hanna] to decide. Even though the embryo has not been conceived naturally, it might grow into a human being if it were transferred into a womb.” Currently, researchers are insistent that ‘synthetic embryos’ are not embryos – only some “cellular architecture” and development occur. Cook concluded, “If they are not human initially, might they become human later on, as the field advances? With so many unknowns, the need for regulation of the new technology is urgent.”

- 1) HR.3755/S.1975 Women’s Health Protection Act - 2021, ban most every abortion regulation
- 2) HR.3755 House passed this bill on 9/24/21 (Vote 1) Senate vote (2/28/22) on House’s bill failed
- 3) HR.8296/S.4132 Women's Health Protection Act - 2022 [Passed House. No Senate vote as of Sept. 5]
- 4) HR.8373/S.4557/S.4612 'Right to Contraception Act', includes abortifacients; has conscience rights problems
- 5) HR.239/S.4700 'Equal Access to Contraceptives for Vets Act', same problems as HR.8373

UNICEF

Fall is the traditional fund-raising season for UNICEF. As we have reported in previous years, UNICEF intervened with Nicaragua’s national assembly to keep abortion legal, and it worked to liberalize abortion in the Dominican Republic, Peru, the Philippines and other countries. UNICEF Canada pushed for assisted suicide and euthanasia for children. In addition, UNICEF partners with the world’s largest abortion providers and advocates to hold conferences which promote abortion. UNICEF’s draft strategic plan currently under consideration includes the promotion of “sexual and reproductive health and rights,” – a term widely recognized to include abortion.


