In Vitro Fertilization: Open Forum on Pro-life Responses to IVF

Monday, October 28, 2024 at LI Coalition for Life meeting

In vitro fertilization can present problematic situations for pro-lifers wanting to address the ethics of IVF balanced with the desires of those who cannot have children through natural means. The LICL invites you to an open forum to understand IVF and ways to approach the topic, which has come into the forefront since the Alabama Supreme Court decision.

DID YOU KNOW?

- *IVF destroys human embryos at a higher rate than abortion. The process involves creating as many embryos as possible.
 - *IVF classifies and rates the “quality” of embryos and discards the ones that ‘don’t make the cut.’ A grading system determines how likely they are to survive – reducing them to a commodity. The lower grades are thrown away. Classifying and killing human beings based on their perceived health is a form of eugenics.
 - *There are often too many “leftover” “usable” embryos. Some are left frozen indefinitely and abandoned, some are donated to other couples, and some are given to researchers for experimentation.
 - *If several embryos are implanted, it may result in “selective reduction.” If too many embryos are implanted at once, creating a ‘dangerous’ multiple pregnancy, doctors may urge the parents to abort one or more of their preborn children. At least 1.7 million embryos have died during the IVF process and about 1.5 million are currently frozen in the US alone. Though the IVF process involves creating life, it also involves the discrimination and intentional destruction of innocent human life that was created on purpose. - How lab technicians ‘make’ babies:** Fertility drugs stimulate the ovaries to produce multiple eggs, which are then retrieved from the ovaries. The number of eggs retrieved varies greatly. The eggs are then fertilized using the male partner’s (or a donor’s) sperm sample. About 80% of the retrieved eggs become fertilized (zygotes). They are placed inside an incubator that simulates a woman’s fallopian tubes. About 30-50% of the zygotes will reach the blastocyst stage – the transferable stage. Many couples will opt for chromosomal screening (preimplantation genetic testing – PGT) at this stage. In many cases, embryos with chromosomal abnormalities are discarded (killed). Those with the ‘wrong’ gender might also be destroyed. While sex-selective and other discriminatory screening practices are illegal in other countries, thousands travel to the US each year to select embryos based on gender, physical traits, chromosomal abnormalities and other health conditions. Embryos are destroyed if they don’t “measure up” to their siblings. What is often forgotten in the process is the fact that it’s not “just a lump of cells” being analyzed and graded, but human beings whose lives rest in the hands of a team of embryologists.
- Lack of Regulation/Oversight:** The IVF industry is notoriously underregulated. There is a lack of coherent federal or state regulations, which leads to the IVF industry self-policing (or not). Standards created by the American Society of Reproductive Medicine exist, but following them is voluntary, with no professional or legal penalties for failing to do so. Accreditation is not required. IVF clinics aren’t mandated to report “mistakes.” Most lawsuits against the industry result in settlements with nondisclosure provisions, reinforcing the secrecy around the industry. The most common “mistake” is mislabeling specimens, resulting in embryos implanted in the wrong woman.
- What is done with the “leftovers?”** The most common solution is to destroy the embryos. Some unused embryos are frozen. At some point, a decision is usually made to donate (to another woman or to ‘science’) or to destroy the embryos. Some opt to have a “compassionate transfer” which involves transferring the embryo at a point in the woman’s cycle when pregnancy is not likely to occur, resulting in the death of the embryo. A new trend is to “plant” the preborn children in a garden to ‘nourish the earth.’ An Australian company promotes turning the embryo into jewelry. (Source: Renee Walton, Natural Womanhood, 7/4/24, “*Is IVF the Wild West of reproductive medicine?*”)



FEDERAL LEGISLATION

In *FDA v Alliance for Hippocratic Medicine*, SCOTUS ruled the doctors bringing suit against the FDA's relaxed rules for the *mifepristone* abortion pill "did not have standing" to bring the case in court, since they suffered no injury. Who has "standing"? The Biden Admin claimed *nobody* - not doctors, states, or even the women hurt by

the pill! SCOTUS didn't go that far, saying the doctors are free to seek relief thru regulation/legislation, via the FDA, the President or Congress. So as of now, the abortion pill can be sent through the mail, used up to 10 weeks gestation, and prescribed by a non-physician. Despite reports, SCOTUS **did not** 'OK' the drug, or the relaxed rules. Another case will likely make its way through the courts. As this case moved up thru the lower courts, the Govt. claimed pro-life doctors can't invoke conscience protection in emergencies. Yet at the SCOTUS, the Govt. said the opposite. That's why SCOTUS ruled doctors suffered no injury, stating, "The federal law fully protects doctors against being required to provide abortions or other medical treatment against their consciences."

SCOTUS sent *Moyle v US* and *Idaho v US* back to the 9th Circuit, for further consideration. The cases ask if Federal EMTALA law can force Idaho emergency rooms to perform 'emergency abortions' despite state law prohibiting it. As of now, the state law remains, except for ER cases. Justice Barrett noted the Govt. agreed that abortion is never needed to stabilize a mental health situation, and conscience protection of both individuals and organizations applies in the context of EMTALA.

In *Murthy v. Missouri*, a case alleging the Biden Administration colluded with social media to squash bad news about the Administration, SCOTUS dismissed the case for lack of standing. Justice Barrett wrote that 'plaintiffs sought relief for future harm, not past injury'. Justices Alito, Gorsuch & Thomas said the Court shirked free speech questions. In July, the FBI said it will resume regular meetings with social media, re 'Foreign Malign Influence Threats to U.S. Elections.' *Conservative Treehouse* opined that future content removal will not be based on simple 'word searches', but on AI scans for ideas and their context, along with who, or what organizations posted them.

The House passed \$883B Defense Bill **HR.8070** 217 - 199. It has provisions to stop Pentagon funding abortions for Vets and their families, and other pro-life rules. It has been in the US Senate since July 8 {Reps. D'Esposito, Garbarino, LaLota - *aye* ||| Rep. Suozzi - *no*}

Rep. Good introduced the *Life Act* (awaiting a Bill #). It prohibits federal dollars from being used for abortions. (Rep. Good lost his primary bid.)

Every GOP Senator signed a June 12 letter supporting access to IVF, to counter "Democrat scare tactics."

Monica M. Miller critiques what Presidents Biden and Trump got right and wrong re abortion in their debate, at crisismagazine.com (7/3/24).

The shortened 2024 Republican Party Platform states, "We believe that the 14th Amendment to the Constitution of the U.S. guarantees that no person can be denied life or liberty without due process and that the states are, therefore, free to pass laws protecting those rights.... We will

oppose late term abortion while supporting mothers and policies that advance prenatal care, access to birth control, and IVF." There is no mention of the Hyde Amendment, the Mexico City Policy or a call for a Human Life Amendment.

During an anti-terrorist training session at Fort Liberty (Bragg), a slide was shown regarding anti-abortion/pro-life 'terrorist' groups including National RTL & Operation Rescue, that engage in protest, life chains and demonstrations. 1994 to 2020 saw ~100 FACE act prosecutions. In 2022, under Biden, there were over 2 dozen.

A recently signed Louisiana law makes the two most common abortion drugs controlled substances and will also create the crime of "coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud" (covertly giving a woman an abortion pill). The bill becomes law October 1.

The Massachusetts Department of Health launched a \$1 million "Avoid Anti-Abortion Centers" ad blitz, accusing the centers of having "untrained staff" and providing "mis-information" and recommending seeking out a "trusted abortion provider."

JAMA Pediatrics published a study showing a higher Texas infant/neonatal mortality rate in the 2 years after *Dobbs*, when that state's strict abortion rules took effect. Pro-life Dr. Michael New explained that more babies were born due to the law, including babies with serious/fatal health issues.



NEW YORK STATE

NYS Ballot Proposition #1 (aka Equality Amendment/Equal Rights Amendment): On June 24 the NYS Court of Appeals affirmed a lower court ruling and dismissed Judge Doyle's ruling that the Equality Amendment (EA) was improperly put on the November ballot. The time to file such complaints had expired. In July, *Common Cause* said the wording of the EA was at a Grade 14 Reading level. A law Governor Hochul signed last year sets a maximum of Grade 8. Thirty-one NYS Senators wrote they are worried the word "abortion" is not in the EA. On July 30, the four Election Commissioners stuck with their staff's language, acknowledging possible future lawsuits.

The Albany Legislative Session ended June 8. A Fall Special Session is possible but is usually for financial votes.

S6616-A/A5297-A *Hospital Interference with Patient Care* - could mandate all hospitals do abortion on demand for any reason. The bill died in the Senate Health Committee and stalled on the Assembly floor.

S8682 (Martins)/A9412 (Curran) *Fertilized Ovum/Embryo Outside of Uterus not a Human Being* - died in the Health Committees of both chambers.

There was no floor vote in either chamber on the Medical Aid in Dying Act.

The Equality Amendment **will be on the ballot in NYS**, after the NYS Court of Appeals affirmed a lower court ruling, and dismissed an appeal, effectively declining to take up the case. Below is the actual wording that voters will see on the ballot. The Equal Protection Clause of the NYS Constitution prohibits the denial of rights to a person based on “race, color, creed, or religion.” In addition, NYS already has numerous laws on the books prohibiting discrimination based on ethnicity, age, disability, sex, etc. The danger of this “Equality Amendment” is that it threatens parental rights, conscience protections for social workers, educators and health care workers, and will codify late-term abortions into the NYS Constitution. **Vote NO on Proposition 1!**

Text of Proposal Number One, an Amendment

Adds Certain Protections to the State Bill of Rights

Adds anti-discrimination provisions to State Constitution. Covers ethnicity, national origin, age, disability, and sex, including sexual orientation, gender identity and pregnancy. Also covers reproductive healthcare and autonomy.

A “YES” vote puts these protections against discrimination in the New York State Constitution.

A “NO” vote leaves these protections out of the State Constitution.

When NY State says 'Do Not Discriminate' it means **Do NOT DISAGREE** with the State– under Penalty of Law!
Current law already protects against discrimination based on race, sex, age, disability, and religion. New language is unnecessary.

Section 11 of Article 1 of the NY Constitution, newly proposed changes to the Proposition are **BOLD** (deletions are in brackets; Paragraph B is all new).

A. No person shall be denied the equal protection of the laws of this state or any subdivision thereof. No person shall, because of race, color, ethnicity, national origin, age, disability, creed [or], religion, or sex, including sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, pregnancy, pregnancy outcomes, and reproductive healthcare and autonomy, be subjected to any discrimination in [his or her] their civil rights by any other person or by any firm, corporation, or institution, or by the state or any agency or subdivision of the state, pursuant to law.

B. Nothing in this section shall invalidate or prevent the adoption of any law, regulation, program, or practice that is designed to prevent or dismantle discrimination on the basis of a characteristic listed in this section, nor shall any characteristic listed in this section be interpreted to interfere with, limit, or deny the civil rights of any person based upon any other characteristic identified in this section.

➤ **NO Minimum Age** – new classes & 'rights' apply to all minors.
➤ **'Person' means YOU**, parent, guardian, clergy, counselor, teacher, business owner, non-profit volunteer.
➤ New York State will have **more authority than parents** in making medical decisions for their children.
➤ **Vague, undefined language** may erode current protections for church and organizations' beliefs that run contrary to these new rights.
➤ **Adding these specific groups can leave out other groups.** Is 'reverse discrimination' allowed by Paragraph B?
Discrimination against certain groups in order to protect other groups (e.g., new classes in Paragraph A) may be lawful.
