Mobile Billboard Truck on Long Island Shows Abortion Victim Photos

The Long Island Coalition for Life, in partnership with Created Equal (createdequal.org), sponsored a mobile billboard truck that showed photos and videos of preborn victims of abortion. The truck traversed Nassau & Suffolk counties on July 4th and 5th. Some of the videos of the aborted babies included text such as 'This is not healthcare,' 'She will never see her mother,' and 'This is her only baby picture.' The photos, which included 1st, 2nd, and 3rd trimester abortion, are difficult to look at. They ought to be!



Within the pro-life movement, there are supporters and detractors of the use of aborted victim imagery, particularly in public. The LICL recognizes that there are some situations where such imagery ought to be avoided. However, this mobile billboard truck is an important tool to show the public what abortion really is – killing children. The hope is that this reality will work on the conscience of pro-lifers to become more involved in the movement and for abortion advocates to rethink their position. It's our duty to educate, so, ultimately, those who reject the message of the imagery, at least they cannot say,

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

On June 26, SCOTUS, in *Medina v PP* South Atlantic, ruled 6-3 that South Carolina could deem Planned Parenthood unfit to receive *any* Medicaid funds. This,

even though the Hyde Amendments already ban the direct Medicaid funding of abortion, with the exceptions for rape, incest and life of the mother. Justices Jackson, Kagan, and Sotomayor dissented.

HR.1 (The Big Beautiful Bill), passed the House, and was sent to the Senate with a Planned Parenthood Medicaid defund in Section 44126 of the bill. The defund period was reduced from ten years to one year. Senate Democrats claimed the defund violated the "Byrd" rule - bills can pass with 51 votes — 'reconciliation' - rather than needing 60 votes to pass. However, the Senate Parliamentarian allowed the language of the defund, and HR.1 passed, 51 – 49. The bill was signed by the President on July 4.

Some pro-life groups hailed the 'redirection of Medicaid funds.' Others warned HR.1 has a huge "health of the mother" loophole, rendering the defund useless. As DOGE is also looking to cut funding, PP facilities across the US are closing. Eleven closures were announced in July. 39 have closed so far in 2025. Steven Mosher of Population Research Institute noted that PP's Houston Prevention Park clinic was once their largest facility in the Western Hemisphere and operated as a 'mega-center for abortions. This is the center that was exposed in an undercover video for harvesting intact fetal cadavers. Texas has successfully stripped PP of Medicaid funding. Facing continuing legal, political and financial pressure, Planned Parenthood Gulf Coast announced the permanent closure of Prevention Park. American Life League noted that 21 of the 39 closed facilities offered contraceptives only, leading to speculation that "facility closures could be prioritized by clinics that provide contraceptives only, as opposed to those that offer abortion pills and surgical abortions."

PP sued the Trump Administration claiming the **HR.1** defund, without naming PP, targeted them alone, and is thus an unconstitutional "Bill of Attainder"- a law aimed at one individual or group. U.S. District Judge Indira Talwani issued a preliminary injunction July 21 blocking the provision in the One Big Beautiful Bill that would have halted Medicaid funding for one year to certain providers, including PP. Critics, including members of Congress argue that the judge overstepped her authority by effectively nullifying a duly passed act of Congress. Talwani also refused to pause her ruling while it undergoes appeal. A July 29 Washington Post editorial stated, "Allocating public money is Congress's core competency... [Talwani's refusal to stay her ruling] strains to label Congress's exercise of its spending discretion unconstitutional...If forward-looking budgetary measures can be scrutinized as bills of attainder, Congress's fiscal function will be

incapacitated." The *Post* predicted the injunction will likely be reversed on appeal.

However, the reality is that even though PP may end up closing 200 locations, US abortions have increased over the past few years, likely due to two thirds of all abortions now being done via the abortion pill. The Daily Caller (June 19) found it easy to order the pills in as little as 5 minutes, "without a doctor adequately verifying key eligibility requirements". The American Association of Pro-Life OBGYN's adds, "women typically have no interaction with any medical professional" while ordering pills. RFK Jr. has ordered HHS to fully review abortion pill safety.

The *Washington Post* reported on August 3 that the Administration has backed down on mandating IVF coverage on the Obamacare exchanges, as the President can't make it an 'essential health benefit' under the Affordable Care Act without Congress passing a bill to that effect.

The Trump Admin is proposing a return to the pre-Biden ban on abortions in VA Hospitals. There is a 30-day Public Comment period, ending on Sept. 3. To submit, go to - https://www.federalregister.gov/documents/2025/08/04/2025 -14687/reproductive-health-services and click on the green "Submit A Public Comment" box, on the right side, center.

The IRS ended the 1954 Johnson Amendment and now equates pastoral instructions to their congregation to a 'family discussion'. Pastors can now endorse or condemn a candidate for public office, when communicating with their flock, without violating their tax-exempt status.



NEW YORK STATE

As of Aug. 6, the Medical Aid in Dying bill has not been officially delivered to Gov. Hochul's desk. Since the NYS legislature

has adjourned for the year, when the bill arrives, Hochul will have 30 days to act, or the bill is automatically vetoed.

New York's SHIELD law protects doctors who mail abortion pills to women in states with abortion bans. Gov. Hochul also signed a law earlier this year that lets those doctors leave their name off the Rx bottle.

Louisiana opened a second investigation into NY doctor Margaret Carpenter over accusations she mailed abortion pills into the state. Louisiana indicted her earlier this year for allegedly prescribing abortion pills via telehealth to a Louisiana resident.

A New York county clerk again refused to certify a civil judgment issued by Texas' Attorney General against Carpenter, who is accused of sending abortion pills into Texas as well.

Terrifying Revelations Regarding Organ Transplants

In late July, the Health and Human Services Administration released the results of an investigation of 351 cases where organ donation was authorized but not completed. 73 patients approved for organ removal showed neurological signs "incompatible with organ donation". 28 patients may not have been dead when the organ transplant began, "raising serious ethical and legal questions." The investigation revealed "poor neurologic assessments, lack of coordination with medical teams, questionable consent practices, and miscalculations of causes of death, particularly in overdose cases." The HHS investigation noted a "systemic disregard for the sanctity of life in the organ transplant system." HHS announced a "major initiative" to revamp and reform the organ donation system so that it does not allow for the "disregard for sanctity of life."

The federally funded Organ Procurement Organization (OPO) under investigation serves Kentucky, West Virginia and parts of Ohio. HHS' Health Resource and Services Administration (HRSA) reopened a case that the Biden Administration had closed. The case involved "potentially preventable harm to a neurologically injured patient." This then led them to examine the 351 cases. HRSA has mandated both "system-level changes to safeguard potential organ donors nationally" and "strict corrective actions for the OPO" specifically. In addition, the House of Representatives held a subcommittee hearing on July 22 on "organ donation safety lapses and how procurement and transplant organizations intend to improve the system, to regain the trust of donors and their families."

Brian Rosenthal and Julie Tate published an article in the *NY Times* on 7/20/25 entitled *Patients at Risk*. The authors related how surgeons in Alabama cut open a woman's body to retrieve organs and found the patient was still alive. Another woman in New Mexico underwent days of preparation for donation even as she slowly began to regain consciousness. In West Virginia, doctors were shocked when coordinators asked a paralyzed man coming off sedatives in an operating room for consent to remove his organs. Rosenthal and Tate found that most donated organs come from patients who are brain-dead, but a new procedure has tripled in the past few years. This procedure is called "donation after circulatory death." More medical judgment calls are needed and often lead to hasty decisions. Some organ procurement organizations are aggressively pushing circulatory death, and some hospitals are allowing the organ procurement organizations to influence decisions. Rosenthal and Tate reported that 55 medical workers in 19 states told them that they had witnessed at least one disturbing case of donation after circulatory death. Several said they had seen coordinators persuading clinicians to administer drugs to hasten death in potential donors.

Bioethicist Wesley J. Smith stated at Humanize Today (10/17/22), "Alas, some transplant surgeons have been blurring these crucial moral boundaries by restarting donors' hearts after a planned cardiac arrest (when life-sustaining treatment is withdrawn) and clamping off blood flow to the brain to cause brain death so that beating hearts can be harvested...This is a terrible mistake. If a patient is resuscitated after cardiac arrest, the person isn't dead! Cutting off blood flow to the brain to cause brain death thereafter seems awfully close to reviving the patient and then killing him. This isn't only immoral and arguably illegal as a violation of the Dead Donor Rule – but it also represents another in a long series of violations that have bred so much public distrust in institutions." Smith posted an article on EvolutionNews.org (8/5/25) entitled "Killing for Organs – Who Could Possibly Object?" He stated, "Good motives sometimes lead to terrible places. Such is the case with the understandable desire to increase the organ supply, which for years has tempted bioethicists to stretch the ethics of transplant medicine beyond the breaking point." On 7/30/25, three doctors associated with Northwell Health in NY (Sandeep Jauhar, Snehal Patel, and Deane Smith) penned an opinion piece in the New York Times entitled "Donor Organs are too rare. We need a new definition of death." They stated, "The solution, we believe, is to broaden the definition of brain death to include irreversibly comatose patients on life support. Using this definition, these patients would be legally dead regardless of whether a machine restored the beating of their heart...we would have more organs available for transplantation...The brain functions that matter most to life are those such as consciousness, memory, intention and desire. Once those higher brain functions are irreversibly gone, is it not fair to say that a person (as opposed to a body) has ceased to exist?"

Wesley J. Smith responded, "Redefining as dead someone who is actually living would subjectivize the value of human life. We are either all equal while alive, or we are not. And if we are not, kiss universal human rights goodbye and say hello to increased oppression and exploitation of those deemed by those with power to be expendable or less than human." The Northwell doctors wrote, "it remains possible (and common) to responsibly determine whether someone is irreversibly comatose, and in such cases a judgment of brain death is merited, as the law should be revised to reflect." W.J. Smith said, "But even if patients were in an irreversible coma, they would not *be* dead. Therefore, the proposal to redefine death is in fact a push to lie about the killing of living human beings for their organs. And if all that matters is consent, why limit the donors to the comatose? Why not kill anyone who really wants to die by organ harvesting, which has been repeatedly proposed by bioethicists. Studies have shown that some people thought to be comatose are actually aware. Given the mistakes we see being made now in the organ donor system, imagine the damage that would be done to public trust in transplant medicine if the seemingly or actually unconscious were dehumanized into so many organ farms. We must not yield to the utilitarian temptation in health care. Pretending that a patient is dead does not make him deceased...In the end, if potential donors are scared away from giving the gift of life, those who would ultimately suffer the most would be organ recipients."

PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S FALSE CLAIMS REGARDING DEFUNDING

*Women have "no feasible alternative" to PP. FACT: Affordable community-based health clinics outnumber PP 15:1. *Unintended pregnancies to rise due to decreased access to contraceptives. FACT: Contraceptive services at PP are down 38%. *PP is a significant provider of primary care. FACT: PP doesn't do mammograms; breast exams are down 61% and pap tests are down 54%.

*Abortions make up only 4% of PP's services. FACT: In 2022-23, women seeking pregnancy-related help were sold an abortion 97% of the time. They received prenatal

services, miscarriage care, or adoption referrals 3% of the time. *Defunding will cause more sexually transmitted infections (STIs) to go undiagnosed and untreated. A NY Times article exposed a pattern of negligence at PP, including an affiliate operating 23 facilities across several states that failed to log and follow up on STI test results, leading to patients who wrongly thought they tested negative when they never heard back.
