'SUPREME' ABSURDITY

Dating back to the landmark 1973 Roe v Wade ruling, the U.S. Supreme Court has never recognized a fetus as a person entitled to any constitutional protection. Yet, on May 26, 1998, this same judicial body ruled that women who use crack or other illegal drugs while pregnant can be prosecuted for **child** (emphasis added) endangerment.

The justices, without comment, turned away arguments by two women imprisoned in South Carolina that

state child protection laws should not be used to punish pregnant women.

South Carolina makes it a crime to "refuse or neglect to provide the proper care and attention" so that a child "is likely to be endangered". The state's highest court has ruled that a viable fetus—one able to live outside the uterus—is a child (emphasis added) under that law and has upheld prosecution of pregnant women.

Despite the Supreme Court's 1973 ruling, the nation's courts routinely treat the viable fetus as a person when someone else has killed or injured a woman's fetus. The South Carolina court called it "absurd" to consider a fetus a person under homicide laws but not under child-abuse laws. Source: DAILY NEWS - 5/27/98

Editor's note: We agree - but isn't it a greater absurdity that while state courts across the country regularly recognize the viable preborn as a person when they are killed or injured by <u>another</u> person, the Supreme Court's ruling in <u>Roe</u> allows a mother and her abortionist to kill her late-term, viable baby by partial-birth abortion with complete impunity?

LEGISLATIVE WATCH

Federal

Together with the House of Representatives, the Senate on 4/28/98 approved a bill to curb the Clinton Administration's crusade to legalize abortion in foreign countries. The bill, formerly known as "The Mexico City Bill" and authored by Chis Smith (R-NJ), would prohibit funding of such organizations as International Planned Parenthood, which seek to repeal pro-life laws in the majority of less developed nations, including those in Latin America and Africa.

This bill, H.R. 1757, would cut off US funding of the United Nations Population Fund due to the agency's participation in China's population-control program which relies heavily on compulsory abortion.

Legistlators voting in favor: Senator D'Amato, Congressmen Forbes (R-1st CD), Lazio (R-2nd CD), and King (R-3rd CD). Those voting against this pro-life bill: Senator Moynihan, Congressmen McCarthy (D-4th CD) and Ackerman (D-5th CD).

RICO and the NOW vs. Scheidler Lawsuit:

It is vital that our Congressmen be contacted by phone, letter, etc. regarding our opposition to the use of RICO (Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Ogranization Act) against pro-life activists. The author of RICO, G. Robert Blakey, stated that the law should not be applied to protestors. Recently, however, members of the Pro-Life Action League Joe Scheidler, Andrew Scholberg, and Timothy Murphy were ruled against by a Federal jury which awarded \$86,000 in damages in favor of abortion clinics. RICO was invoked, and the monetary damages tripled to \$258,000 against the pro-lifers. Pro-life Congressman Henry Hyde, chairman of the House Judiciary Committee, is committed to holding hearings to reform RICO so that it does not victimize pro-life protestors. Please contact your Senators and Congressional Representative immediately to state your opposition to the use of RICO against pro-lifers.

Good news from Wisconsin! As reported in the NY Times on 5/6/98, doctors in Wisconsin stopped performing abortions when Judge John Shabaz of the Federal District Court refused to issue a temporary restraining order against the state's newly enacted "Partial-Birth Abortion Ban". The wording, broad enough to cover the most common procedures, prohibits any abortion in which a doctor "partially vaginally delivers a living child, causes the death of the partially delivered child with the intent to kill the child and then completes the delivery of the child. New York State



On 6/2/98, The LICL made its last lobbying trip to Albany for the 1998 Legislative Session. Stalwart pro-lifer Thomas Barraga informed the lobbyists that the bill to ban Partial-Birth abortion in New York was dead until the 1999 session. However, due to pro-life efforts, Assemblyman Silver did withdraw his own defective bill to ban Partial-Birth abortion. Pro-lifers recognized his bill as a smokescreen which in reality would not prevent any abortions. Unfortunately, during the last 25 years, Silver and his pro-abortion predecessors have prevented all effective pro-life legislation from reaching the floor by wielding an iron fist over majority party assemblymembers. However, a pro-life presence in Albany is sending the message that this will not be tolerated. Such trips to Albany are vital to the success of the pro-life movement in our state. We pray that in the ensuing years more of our newsletter readers will participate.

Although New York State has not passes a bill to ban Partial-Birth abortion, 26 other states have banned this horrendous procedure. Additionally, the House of Representatives, on 10/8/97, by a vote of 296 to 132, passed a bill to ban Partial-Birth abortion. This is 10 votes more than is required to override President Clinton's veto of the pro-life bill. The U.S. Senate voted 64-36 in favor of the ban, but was 3 votes shy of overriding the veto.

"M & M" ABORTIONS

The abortion pill combinations of mifepristone and misoprostol, and methotrexate and misoprostol are being promoted as the best way to assure a woman "privacy" in aborting her child. Mifepristone (RU486) is given in pill form, followed two days later by misoprostol, in pill form, injection or vaginal suppository. Mifepristone starves the baby to death by preventing uptake of the female hormone progesterone, which is vital in the early stages of pregnancy. Misoprostol, an ulcer medication, causes the uterus to contract and expel the dead baby along with the uterine contents. The abortion occurs within a week.

Antiprogesterones such as mifepristone cause severe, and at times, prolonged bleeding in some women. About 0.1% of women need a transfusion. Other side effects include diarrhea, nausea, cramping, and incomplete abortion. Long term effects have not been studied, but some experts predict dire consequences, since RU486 is chemically similar to DES. Several women have died following administration of RU486. Misoprostol, a prostaglandin, can be potentially dangerous to women with asthma, hypotension, hypertension, cardiovascular, renal or hepatic disease, anemia, jaundice, diabetes, epilepsy, or a compromised (scarred) uterus. Side effects include induced bone proliferation, vomiting, nausea, diarrhea, increased blood pressure, prostaglandin hyperthermia, headache, flushing, anxiety, chills, leg cramps, and breast tenderness.

Methotrexate is an extremely powerful drug used in chemotherapy to attack fast-growing cancer cells. It is given through intramuscular injection, followed five to eight days later by insertion of misoprostol as a vaginal suppository. The baby's death and expulsion can take up to a month. Women may return after two weeks for a second dose of misoprostol. Methotrexate attacks the actively proliferating fetal cells. The entry for methotrexate in The Physician's Desk Reference covers six pages. It opens with a black-bordered box which reads: "Methotrexate should be used only by physicians whose knowledge and experience includes the use of antimetabolite therapy ... Because of the possibility of serious toxic reactions the patient should be informed by the physician of the risks involved, and should be under a physician's constant supervision." The list of toxic potentials for methotrexate include: liver damage, kidney destruction, heart muscle compromise, pulmonary failure, gastrointestinal pathology, and bone marrow suppression. It has also been reported to cause loss of speech function, strokes, and convulsions. Methotrexate, like most cancer drugs, has the ability to induce cancer in the non-cancerous patient, even in as little as one or two doses. It is one of the most dangerous and potentially fatal drugs in this text, and it has been approved by the FDA only for the treatment of cancer. The dangers of this drug are so massive that they are outweighed only by the benefit of abating or curing cancer. A complication common to both methods is the psychological trauma of seeing one's child dead. The likelihood of aborting the child at home, in the car, or at work is far greater using methotrexate because the method takes much longer.

These chemicals allow a woman to abort her child at home. However, it still requires several visits to the doctor/clinic to verify that the abortion is complete. Some women must still undergo a surgical abortion when the pills "fail". The child always dies, no matter what type of abortion is employed. Pro-abortion Dr. Suzanne Poppema stated, "There's a perception that you take it (the pills or injections), and then you have your period - period. In fact, the drug induces a miscarriage so potentially involved that, once informed, three of four women decide to have a traditional surgical abortion instead."

Besides killing the child in every case, these pills can severely injure, and possibly kill the mother as well. When will women see through the "convenience" appeal of the pro-abortion movement?


PRISONER OF CONSCIENCE

The two tiny girls were found in shallow graves weeks apart and in different towns. But in death they became sisters joined in a bigger family of other babies who were found lifeless, discarded.

Faith Hope was found buried beside a Freeport home on May 18 - Holly Hope's badly decomposed body was uncovered 3 days later by cemetery workers while digging a grave at Holy Rood Cemetery in Westbury.


They join baby Matthew Hope, found in a recycling plant in Bay Park on March 20 and Baby Johnathan Hope, found discarded near an Albertson office building a few days later.

The four were buried side by side in cemetery plots at Holy Rood cemetery bought by Timothy Jaccard,

President of the Ambulance Medical Technician Association of The Nassau County Police Department who took legal custody of the babies and gave them names.

In a funeral Mass for babies Faith and Holly held at Our Holy Redeemer Church in Freeport, Pastor Richard Figliozzi told the large assembly of mourners that life is a precious gift, adding "May baby Faith and baby Holly rest in peace."

Members of the Freeport Police Dept. color guard saluted the caskets as they were placed inside the hearse for the trip to Holy Rood Cemetery. Vincent Barbato, 81, of Baldwin said he came to accompany the little babies on their long journey. "I'm



here because human life is precious," He said. "God Bless You", said a crying woman to Jaccard.




