LEGISLATIVE WATCH

FEDERAL

HOW THEY VOTED-The House adopted, 223-202, this past June an amendment offered by Rep. Tom Coburn (R-Okla.) that would prohibit the Food and Drug Administration from testing, developing or approving drugs that induce abortions. In arguing for the provision, Coburn said it is not the F.D.A.'s responsibility to test or approve drugs that "take away life".

(S.1645/HR.3682). The House Judiciary Committee is attempting to prohibit the transporting of a minor girl across a state line to obtain an abortion. The CCPA specifically applies to the 29 states that have laws requiring parental involvement in a minor's abortion decision. (New York State has no Parental/Notification laws.) Senator DeWine, a sponsor of CCPA insists that "Roe vs Wade" does not confer the right to strangers to take a another's minor child across state lines for an abortion.

VOTER GUIDES & PUBLIC VOTER

EDUCATION AT RISK-it is vital to our organization that you notify your Senator/Congressman to oppose the "Campaign Reform Bills" that would restrict citizens groups such as the National Right To Life Committee and the Christian Coalition. These groups endeavor to educate regarding the voting records and positions of specific politicians on pro-life issues.

The most dangerous bills under consideration are the Shays-Meehan Amendment, the Asa Hutchinson "freshman" Amendment, and/or any other campaign reform proposal that restricts citizen groups or political parties from speaking out on the positions of those who hold or seek public office.

FEDERAL EMPLOYEES HEALTH BENEFIT

PLAN Under the Treasury Postal Appropriations Bill Rep Nita Lowey of NY has masterminded this legislation through the Appropriations Committee. The bill would force health insurers of federal employees to cover the cost of prescription contraceptives. Pro-life groups are opposed to Rep Lowey's bill because some contraceptives can be used

to cause abortion. Lowey's bill also fails to specify when life begins and would mandate coverage of drugs that "kill human embryos one or two weeks after his or her life had begun".

CHINA - A MOST FAVORED NATION?

Imprisonment and torture of political opponents and dissidents...Persecution, imprisonment and execution of Religious... Opposition of religious freedom... Execution of prisoners to obtain body parts for organ transplants...Arms merchants to terrorist countries...Forced sterilizations and abortions - with the bodies of these babies sold or offered as health food. That's China! A most favored nation???


President Clinton's recent trip to China brings to mind all of these human rights abuses. Japan's "Kyodo News Service" reported, and "Life Activist" published a story about a female doctor who has committed hundreds of abortions, and claims to have eaten 100 fetuses in a period of six months time. She reported that the best were first-born males from young women. She said she washes them with clear water until they look transparent white, and then stews them. "Making soup of them is the best," she claims, "or they would be wasted." The Hong Kong Nutrition Association says, "In terms of nutrition, a fetus would be a good source of protein and fats and there are minerals in bone." We call this cannibalizing! We wrote about "harvesting of organs" - this is "harvesting of babies"!

According to an article in "The Wanderer" on June 10, several people testified before the U. S. House of Representatives about China's deplorable birth control policies, including their one child policy. Among those testifying were Harry Wu, a former Chinese political prisoner, and now an American citizen and Executive Director of the Laogai Research Foundation, Gao Xiao Duan, the former administrator of a population control office in the People's Republic of China, and Zhou Shui Yon, a victim of China's coercive population control program. We can attest to this policy, as we were personally involved in this crisis situation with someone.

The testimony revealed that China's Planned-Birth Office employs a network of paid informants who let officials know when China's one child policy is violated. Women cannot give birth without a "birth-allowed certificate". If this is violated, the mother is forced to have an abortion. If the mother cannot be found, a family member is put in a holding cell at P.B.O. until the mother returns. The horrible experience of Chen Li-May was related. Chen was nine months pregnant and did not have a "birth-allowed certificate". Chen was found by the government, and although she "cried, struggled, and begged to no avail. Like a pig, she was tied up on the (operating) table. When the child, a boy, came out, his limbs were moving physicians and nurses injected poison into her child's head. The child's body twitched and his cry (stopped) abruptly. Then he ceased breathing. The mother lost consciousness on the table." Mrs. Chen was issued a birth-allowed certificate retroactively. However, according to many physicians, she will never be able to become pregnant again.

Statistics from 1983 show as many as ten million abortions were performed in China, 90% of them forced. Although you favor Most Favored Nation status for China, Mr. President, economics can never override the need to demand an end to these human rights abuses.

Latest Planned Parenthood Tactic OUTRAGEOUS!

Praying Pro-Life Nurse Publicly Humiliated - Her Sanity Questioned!

This is the shocking story of Registered Nurse Judy Krelloer of Lubbock, Texas as related to Joseph Slovenec, President, American Anti-Persecution League (AAPL):

On Friday August 15, due to a change in her nursing schedule, Judy could not picket with her Pro-Life group on Tuesdays & Thursday. Since this Friday was her day off, Judy felt she could not miss the opportunity to stand for the children.

As Judy stood alone on the sidewalk, quietly praying the Rosary and holding her sign, a worker from Planned Parenthood came out to talk to her. She didn't seem hostile and asked Judy why she had come to Planned Parenthood. Judy lovingly explained to this confused and brainwashed P.P. worker why see was standing for the little babies. Judy shared the love of Christ with this woman, only later to be betrayed.

Shortly after the woman went back inside, three police cars with flashing lights swooped down and screeched to a halt. The Police first spoke to the P.P. worker Judy thought she had befriended. Then they marched towards Judy. It was obvious the P.P. woman had called the police and lied about Judy. One of the Policeman, Officer Gregg, asked Judy a series of questions: "What is your name? What day is today? Have you ever been in a mental institution?" Judy was being questioned as though she were mentally ill. When Judy asked what the charges against her were, she was told "We have reason to believe you are a danger to yourself or others." The officer then curtly stated, "You can volunteer to go for a mental evaluation, or we will have to handcuff you and take you in." In amazement Judy said, "You mean you are going to arrest me?" At that point Judy was handcuffed and taken to a local Hospital for a mental examination.

Forcibly detained in a seclusion room, she was ordered to provide samples of her urine and blood even before a physician examined her. After a lengthy wait and a brief examination, the Doctor declared "I see no further need for mental assessment", and

MIXED-UP PRIORITIES

On a recent visit to Florida, we were sitting by the beach watching as a huge "Caterpiller" tractor approached. It was equipped with a special fork device that turned over the sandy beach rather than move the sand as you would with a solid tractor blade. The man who operated the tractor shut it off and approached the spot where we were sitting. We asked what he was doing?

He told us that he was loosening the sand because a recent study of the beach showed that it was packed down too hard and would make it difficult for the sea turtles to come up on the beach and lay their eggs. His job was to soften the sand and make the beach more hospitable for the turtles. The turtles come up on the beach when the water temperature reaches 84 degrees. Houses along the beach are urged to shut their lights off so that the turtles do not become confused or scared off. Volunteers spot the turtle nests and they are marked off and protected so that no harm will come to the baby turtles. The project throughout the state costs millions of dollars.

We told the man about the 4400 unborn babies who are killed everyday by abortion and have nobody to protect them. A million and a half every year. Some 36 million since abortion was made legal in 1973. He agreed and said that the world had its priorities all mixed-up. Turtles are important but you can't equate them with human babies. He started to leave, turned and said that the only thing that would change this is when mankind has a change of heart. He then started the tractor and went back to combing the beach.

It is true that some nations with fast-growing populations are poor, but population growth is not the cause. Extreme poverty usually occurs because government policies prevent people from engaging in productive activities. In such nations rapid population growth can make life worse, but poverty is what makes population growth a problem.

High levels of population do not themselves cause poverty, as recent studies have made clear.

- Evidence that population growth hurts economic development is "weak or nonexistent", reports Allen C Kelley - Journal of Economic Literature (1988).
- "Concern about the impact of rapid population growth on resource exhaustion has often been exaggerated" - National Research Council & National Academy of Sciences (1990).




