

LEGISLATIVE WATCH

FEDERAL



CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM-On 8/6/98, the House of Representatives passed the Shays-Meehan Campaign Finance Reform Bill. What this bill would do is restrict the rights of citizens groups such as the National Right To Life Committee(NRLC) and affiliated groups, like ours, to criticize or commend the voting records or positions on issues of persons who hold or seek federal office. The NRLC said that Shays-Meehan, "would place sweeping and unprecented restrictions on the right of citizens groups to disseminate communications to the public....." We thank Congressman Peter King for his opposition to Shays-Meehan. We express our total disappointment at the other Nassau/Suffolk Representatives Michael Forbes, Rick Lazio, Carolyn McCarthy and Gary Ackerman for supporting this bill that would deny citizens their first amendment right of free speech. Please be sure to call or write their offices to express your sentiments.

The Shays-Meehan Bill now goes before the Senate where it is known as the McCain-Feingold Bill. It is hoped that Senator Mitch McConnell will disrupt its passage there with another filibuster as he has done in the past.

Please be sure to write or call Senators D'Amato and Moynihan to vote against McCain-Feingold.

CHILD CUSTODY PROTECTION ACT

(CCPA)We reported in the September issue that this Act had passed in the Senate. Unfortunately, it had passed in Committee but was left to be voted on after the Senate summer recess. The act would prohibit the transporting of children across state line, from states that have parental involvement legislation, for the purpose of obtaining abortions. Ask you representatives to support CCPA.

BAN ON PARTIAL BIRTH ABORTIONS(PBA)

The ban on PBA is due to be voted on very soon. Continue to encourage both Senators D'Amate and Moynihan to repeat their previous votes in support of the ban on partial birth abortion. Pray hard for all these pro-life bills but most especially for PBA.

LETHAL DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION ACT S2151/HR4006. This act would prevent the use of

federally controlled drugs (Drug Enforcement Administration) from being used by physicians for assisted suicide. Other provisions in the bill will reduce current legal deterrents to appropriate pain relief. Ask representatives to support this Act.

HOUSE AGRICULTURAL SPENDING BILL HR.4101 This bill includes language prohibiting the Food and Drug Administration from approving abortion inducing drugs such as the prostaglandin RU-486 a hormone that expells the baby in the womb violently. In addition, HR.4101 prohibits the funding of overseas family planning groups that lobby for abortion. Request support of HR.4101.

House Labor HHS (Health and Human Services) HR.4276 This bill requires that parents be notified when their children seek contraceptives from any federally subsidized family planning agency. Please ask for support of HR.4276.

NOTE: Act immediately, Congress will recess on 10/9.

MORNING AFTER PILLS On 9/2 the U.S. gave permission to advertise and sell contraceptives pills as "morning after" pills. Immediate criticism came from the U.S. Bishops spokeswoman Helen Alvare stating, "According to the experts we've consulted, it acts commonly as an abortifacient — a abortion-causing drug". Dr. John Willke, Director of Life Issues Institute agreed with Ms. Alvare.

CHINA - MOST FAVORED NATION?

Our August article reported on forced sterilization's and abortions in China, among many other human rights abuses. We have since received the following information:

Gary L. Bauer, President, Family Research Council, said on July 21, "On a report card, the Chinese government gets an F in human rights violations. It is evident China has not earned an unconditional renewal of Most Favored Nation. It is clear that torture, arbitrary arrests and detention, execution without trial, repression of ethnic minorities and religious believers, along with forced abortion and sterilization, remain common practices."

During the week of August 15, two thousand scientists gathered in Beijing for the 18th International Congress of Genetics. They diverted from discussions of cloning and cancer genes to take a serious look at China's Maternal Infant Health Care Law of 1994, originally known as the Eugenics Law, as to whether it

originally intended to condone forced sterilization.

The 1994 law's main purpose is to guarantee prenatal and pediatric health care to poor women and children. The law also contains two controversial articles, 10 and 16, dealing with genetic counseling. Couples undergoing their required premarital physical examination are to be informed of any genetic problems. Successive regulations require doctors detecting a problem to "take steps to prevent childbearing" through sterilization or long-term contraception.

Article 10 says, "The two may be married only if both agree to take long-term contraceptive measures or to take a ligation operation for sterility." With this law and China's Planned Birth Office's "birth allowed certificate" (explained in our August article), which enforces their one child policy, they are strangulating family life. There are no statistics available as to how many people have been sterilized or forbidden to marry under these laws.

In 1988, Gansu province in northwest China passed a law requiring compulsory sterilization of people with an IQ lower than 49. Since that time other provinces have adopted the policy. This sounds like the Nazi racial "purification" campaign with extermination of those selectively deemed unfit.

Dr. Griffiths, Canadian secretary general of the International Genetics Federation said he was heartened that the Chinese government was endorsing informed consent, but added, "It all depends what they mean by informed consent. That may mean the doctor tells you what to do and you do it." Incidentally, according to Elizabeth Rosenthal's N.Y. Times International column, "Canada required sterilization of some mentally retarded people as recently as the 1960's."

When reading about China's Eugenics Law, we immediately related it to a New York State Law, the Prenatal Care and Assistance Program (PCAP), which was passed and has helped mothers and babies in need. This law is perpetually attacked by the pro-abortion lobby to include abortion funding. How anyone can logically conclude that abortion should be considered standard prenatal care is just preposterous to us! Stay alert! Strictly monitor the wording of your health care laws and any amendments to them. This is true

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE: On 9/18/98 the U.S. Senate failed by a vote of 64-36 to override Pres. Clinton's veto of a ban on the Partial-Birth Abortion procedure. Both NY Senators Moynihan and D'Amato voted with pro-life to ban the procedure.

On 10/8/97, the House of Representatives voted 296 to 132 to ban Partial-Birth Abortion. Long Island Representatives voting pro-life were Forbes, Lazio and King. Voting pro-abortion (to allow the procedure to continue to be used) were McCarthy and Ackerman. The vote means Clinton's veto will stand, at least until a new Congress convenes in January of 1999.




