

## WELDON-STUPAK, H.R. 2505, ANTI-HUMAN CLONING BILL PASSES

On 7/31/01, just three days before Congress recessed for August, the House outlawed human cloning by a 265-162 vote. Happily, all five Nassau/Suffolk Congressional Members voted for this bill. At issue is a technique known as somatic cell nuclear transfer in which an adult stem cell is fused with an egg in which the DNA containing nucleus is removed resulting in a genetically identifiable copy of the adult donor. To date this technique has only been used with animals, e.g. the cloned sheep, Dolly, in Scotland. This bill would prevent any attempt to clone humans. A similar bill awaits a vote in the Senate.

# PRES. BUSH ON STEM CELL RESEARCH

On Thursday, 8/9/01, President George W. Bush, spoke on National T.V. Several of his statements follow: "I have concluded that we should allow federal funds to be used for research on these existing stem cell lines, where a life-and-death decision has already been made.

"This allows us to explore the promise and potential of stem cell research without crossing a fundamental moral line by providing taxpayer funding that would sanction or encourage further destruction of human embryos that have at least the potential for life."

Bush also announced support for funding of research involving cells derived from placentas, umbilical cords, adults and animals, which he said "do not involve the same moral dilemma".

President Bush said that he "believes human life is a sacred gift from our creator. I worry about a culture that devalues life, and believe as your president I have an important obligation to foster and encourage respect for life in America and throughout the world."

MANHATTAN: HEARING FOR HEALTH BILL. City Council Speaker Peter F. Vallone, who is running for mayor, has scheduled an Aug. 21 hearing for a bill that would provide a 10-foot buffer around women within 50 feet of clinics where abortions are performed. A draft of the Access to Reproductive Health Services bill would prohibit "passing a leaflet or handbill to, displaying a sign to, or engaging in oral protest, education, or counseling with" clinic workers or women visitors. (N.Y. Times METRO on 8/3/01) N.Y.C. residents are urged to call their Council Member immediately to ask the status of this bill and to register protest.

## "NOT EVERYTHING THAT CAN BE DONE, SHOULD BE DONE"

A recent call concerned 8 frozen embryos that remained following a relative's fertility treatments, and our position on the preferable use of adult stem cells (ASC), rather than the unethical use of embryonic stem cells (ESC) which can only be obtained by destroying a living human embryo. The title of this article and our arguments are based on the testimony of the world-renowned geneticist, Dr. Jerome Lejeune, in the court case concerning ownership of "Seven Frozen Embryos". His testimony in that case illustrates his life-affirming research principles as opposed to those of pro-abortion researchers—which is to try anything regardless of the cost in lives and morality involved.

Celebrities and the media seem to have made embryonic stem cell research (ESCR) their current anti-life cause to champion. Christopher Reeve has been on TV and radio presenting ESCR as the only answer to many of life's ills. Yet his foundation, the Christopher Reeve Paralysis Foundation (CRPF), has not had one success with ESC according to a press release from the foundation disclosed on the website of the organization Do No Harm: The Coalition of Americans for Research Ethics - "In August 2000 research funded by the NIH itself and the CRPF found that adult human bone marrow stem cells can create a virtually limitless supply' of nerve cells...According to the published research results, the ASC 'grow rapidly in culture precluding the need for immortalization, and differentiate into neurons exclusively with use of a simple protocol'... The NIH/CRPF research demonstrates. that adult bone marrow stem cells can form nerve cells, eliminating the need to isolate such cells from the patient's brain: "The marrow cells are readily accessible, overcoming the risks of obtaining neural stem cells from the brain, and provide a renewable population. Autologous transplantation overcomes the ethical and immunological concerns associated with the use of fetal tissue." (Journal of Neuroscience Research)

We understand why celebrities come out in support of research to cure diseases or damaged tissues, especially when they suffer themselves, but shouldn't they give all the facts? Whyis someone like Officer Steven McDonald, who is also wheelchair-bound and suffers greatly, not given the same opportunity to state his philosophy, that he does not want a cure at the expense of another's life? In fairness, both voices should be heard! When will celebrities come out to champion all life? An NBC show concerned the injustice of aborting fetal sheep to use their skins for jackets, etc. When will there be a show concerning the injustices to fetal humans such as chemical and stress testing, the various abortion methods, and organ harvesting? Have they ever shown the skin of a baby after a saline abortion? Have they protested the selling and consumption of human fetuses in China?

A 6/22/01 NY Post article, "Slanting the Science, Why some medical miracles don't get reported," states, "Should the government fund medical research that relies on the use of stem cells extracted from human embryos? This difficult moral decision would be a lot easier if the media weren't failing to tell the public the whole story... Unfortunately, journalists and editors haven't reported this news fully or fairly. The Statistical Assessment Service (STATS), a non-partisan research organization devoted to the accurate use of scientific research in public-policy debates, has documented how journalists have fallen down on the job on this issue. In its recent report, "Stemming the

News Flow?" STATS decried a "striking" selectivity in coverage: The media often play up embryonic stem cell breakthroughs while giving short shrift to equivalent (or even more promising) adult stem cell successes...scientists researched the ability of embryonic and adult mouse pancreatic stem cells to regenerate the body's ability to make insulin. Both types of cells boosted insulin production in diabetic mice. The embryonic success made a big splash with prominent coverage in all major media outlets. Yet the same media organs were strangely silent about the research involving adult cells. Stranger still, the adult cell experiment was far more successful—it raised insulin levels much more. Indeed, those diabetic mice lived, while the mice treated with embryonic cells all died. Why did the media celebrate the less successful experiment and ignore the more successful one? Another barely reported story is that alternative source stem cells are already healing human illnesses. In Los Angeles, the transplantation of stem cells harvested from umbilical cord blood has saved the lives of three young boys born with defective immune systems...The experimental procedure worked. Two years post surgery, their doctors at UCLA Medical center pronounced the boys cured." The 7/31/01 issue of Nursing Spectrum reports that in November 1999 North Shore University Hospital became the second Placental Cord Blood collection site for the New York Blood Center. The title of their new booklet is "You can be a hero: After your baby's birth you may help save someone's life". More than 860 units of acceptable cord blood stem cells have been collected, "converting what was once biomedical waste into a life saving treatment modality". In France, three children born with a genetic defect that caused an immunodeficiency were treated with stem cells removed from their own bone marrow. Their cure was one of the first new successful uses of adult stem cell gene therapy.

Science Daily Magazine reports: "Washington, DC—Reprogrammed adult neural stem cells can potentially generate a cornucopia of cell types—giving rise to cells in heart, liver, muscle, intestine and other tissues... Until recently, researchers thought that the more specialized adult stem cells, found in areas of the body like the skin, nervous system, and blood and lymph systems, could only give rise to their own kind. Now, scientists are accumulating evidence...that adult stem cells may be capable of reprogramming themselves...investigators led by Dr. Fred H. Gage of the Salk Institute in LaJolla, CA found that they could extract functioning stem cells from autopsied brain tissue...as much as 20 hours after a person's death."

At <a href="http://stemcellresearch.org">http://stemcellresearch.org</a> is a list: "Current Clinical Use of Adult Stem Cells to Help Human Patients". There is NO list of clinical use of embryonic stem cells that have helped human patients, as ESC have never helped a human patient.

Randall Terry writes, "We are not arguing over a 'blob of frozen cells'! We are struggling for the lives of human beings; we are drawing a line in the sand of absolute right vs. wrong, and the scientific reality that life begins at conception. America cannot afford to lose to death on the 'unwanted and discarded' premise, furthering the Nazi medical ethical code of 'research'...Couples are adopting these frozen embryos. The embryo is implanted into the adoptive mother's womb, then carrying the child to term. On July 17, two children adopted and born in this manner were brought with their parents to testify before Congress...The promoters of embryonic stem cell research are in fact the ethical heirs of Nazi medical practices and rhetoric, i.e. those that are unwanted or discarded can be used for experimentation for the benefit of others."

# REPRODUCTIVE CHOICE CAMPAIGN (RCC)

The mission of the Long Island Coalition for Life (LICL) is to advance respect for life. We have done this for 28 years in many ways. Yet, thousands of babies continue to die every day in America by surgical abortion, including hundreds every week in Nassau and Suffolk Counties. Why does this carnage continue? There are many possible explanations. The LICL believes that one of the reasons is that people do not know what abortion actually does to a pre-born baby in the womb. The LICL knows that the mainstream media fail to tell the public the truth about the advanced development of a baby when most abortions are performed.

The LICL recognizes that the public needs to see the truth, learn the truth, and face abortion for the tragic reality that it is. Education is key to helping people see the truth. With education we can change hearts and minds against the "choice" to kill pre-born babies. The graphic reality of abortion is not nice, it is difficult to look at, it is upsetting to face—and so it should be. Pictures of abortion are disgusting because abortion is disgusting. Yet, hiding the truth only helps those who advocate abortion as a constitutional right for any reason throughout the nine months of pregnancy. The time is long overdue to make an explicit statement as to what "pro-choice" really means.

This month the LICL will be sponsoring a campaign to reach the public with the truth of abortion. Our campaign will be one of non-violent direct action. We will show the people what they support when they turn their backs on defenseless pre-born babies in the womb. It will not be a comfortable campaign, but the membership of the LICL believes it is a necessary one. We hope you will concur. We hope you will grasp the integrity and importance of this campaign. We hope you will support our efforts against the Culture of Death.

To help you better grasp the meaning of this face-the-truth initiative we are providing below excerpts taken from the press release of the Center for Bio-ethical Reform and statements by Gregg Cunningham, its executive director. Please take time to read this. It will help you understand the LICL's enthusiasm for this project and it will assist you in answering questions or arguments from family, friends, and coworkers when these graphic images hit the road.

The Purpose of the RCC is to make abortion impossible to ignore or trivialize. Public opinion surveys reveal that a large majority of Americans now oppose "pregnancy termination" in the second and third trimesters of pregnancy—especially if performed by "partial-birth" abortion. A smaller but still substantial majority support a right of abortion if it is committed in the first trimester of pregnancy. This fact is problematic from a pro-life perspective because The Centers for Disease Control report that some 90% of abortions are committed in the first three months of pregnancy.

These same surveys also disclose that public support for early abortion derives from the inaccurate perception that the first trimester baby is a mere "blob of tissue." In contrast, most Americans see the mid- and late-term fetus as a real "baby" whose level of gestational development entitles it to rights of personhood. It is also clear that few Americans believe a suction abortion to be the moral equivalent of a "partial-birth" abortion." We, therefore, conclude that it is vital to convince the public that the first trimester baby is as fully entitled to rights of personhood as a more mature fetus and that even an early abortion is as indefensible an act of violence as any "partial-birth" abortion. Extensive focus group research has proven conclusively that our pictures are the most effective means by which to achieve that goal. Further, RCC is a tactic which is consistent with prior mainstream campaigns of social reform, such as the civil rights movement, which used graphic pictures to successfully achieve their ends.

In an interview, responding to criticism that the pictures are disturbing to children, Cunningham asked adults to evaluate the reason behind any such disturbance. "Our very point is that these pictures are disturbing because abortion is an act of violence. It does kill a baby." He noted that many in the pro-abortion-rights movement believe the procedure is merely a morally inconsequential way to solve an unintended pregnancy. "Even a 3-year-old can look at a picture of a first trimester baby, recognize that it is a baby and that something terrible had happened to it."

It should be noted that we believe it important to protect children from exposure to disturbing photos, whether those photos depict aborted babies or any other shocking subject. That is why we go out of our way to choose routes which minimize the time we must spend near residential neighborhoods. We will not knowingly drive past elementary schools, playgrounds, daycare centers, etc.

There is, however, no operating location in which we can guarantee that no child will ever see these painful images. The same risks to children exist every time the TV is turned on. Sickening images are likely to appear, even during early prime time. The same is true with disgusting photos on the covers of magazines openly displayed at the checkout stands of supermarkets. Billboards are also increasingly likely to exhibit images inappropriate for young children.

Our photos save unborn children and disturb born children everywhere they are displayed. The question which must be answered by our critics is simple: Do they care more about the feelings of kids than the lives of fetuses? If so, they are not pro-life, they are "pro-feelings." We respectfully refuse to allow people who are not pro-life to cover up the truth about abortion. Those days are gone and we will not go back.

We understand that this project will not make us popular, even with many groups which call themselves "pro-life." We are losing the abortion battle precisely because so many "pro-life" organizations mistakenly believe they must be "liked" to be effective. But CBR is not trying to win a popularity contest. We are trying to effect social reform. Social reformers are never liked. We care less what people think of us than what they think of abortion. We are willing to have them hate us if that is the price which must be paid to have them ultimately hate abortion.

If the pictures are real (which they are) abortion advocates' position on abortion becomes indefensible, and they know that. If something's so horrifying we can't stand to look at it, perhaps it should be unlawful—perhaps we shouldn't be doing it.



of the Pacific Northwest; it tried to prevent the Little League from using a piece of pastureland as a ballpark in Humboldt County in northern California. The Sierra Club published Paul Ehrlich's famous, yet completely erroneous, doomsday forecast The Population Bomb. Since we didn't run out of natural resources, and in fact have large reserves of petroleum, coal, etc., yet to be tapped; the environmental doomsayers have now shifted their attack. They no longer warn of the imminent exhaustion of energy because of too many people. They now say people use too much energy and are causing Global Warming. 



# COMING SOON TO A HIGHWAY NEAR YOU

On June 25, 2001, the Los Angeles-based Center for Bio-Ethical Reform (CBR) launched its antiabortion, Reproductive Choice Campaign (RCC). The project involves the operation of a fleet of large, boxbody trucks on whose sides are displayed billboard-size color photos depicting aborted human embryos and early fetuses.
