

PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S SUBVERSIVE POLITICAL ACTION

Given the declining abortion rates and a public which appears less supportive of abortion on demand, Planned Parenthood Federation of America (P.P.F.A.) has become a major player in national politics. Chuck Donovan, with long experience in sanctity-of-life issues, writes in his article on "Planned Parenthood's Political Machine" that "...through its Responsible Choices Action Network, pursues the goal of converting clinic clientele into legislative and political activists...and...the maintenance and support of legal abortion."

Planned Parenthood's "The Action Fund" is recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)(4) organization, nonprofit-contributions not tax deductible. However, these groups are free to develop separate groups for political purposes "such as voter identification, get-out-the-vote drives and Political Action Committees." In the 2000 election, Planned Parenthood's "The Action Fund" financed 500,000 recorded-message phone calls from Barbara Streisand... to female voters urging votes for Al Gore, and 500,000 e-mail messages from Whoopie Goldberg.

How does Planned Parenthood manage to obtain funds to carry out their political goals? The McCain-Feingold Law banned "soft-money" contributions but left intact their ability to solicit unlimited contributions from individuals. Donovan notes as a result of "soft money" contributions, "Planned Parenthood Votes" was number 3 of 25 Section 527 groups in gross receipts. P.P.F.A.'s gross income for 2002-2003 is reported as \$766.6 million with net profit of \$36.6 million. The major portion of income was from abortion and sale of contraceptives. Included in income are receipts from our U.S.

Government (taxpayer money) of \$262.0 million under Title X, "Family Planning", P.P.F.A. received about \$687,500. Title X of the Public Health Services Act is the major source of "Family Planning" grants which P.P.F.A. uses to launch new affiliates.

Donovan maintains since tax subsidies have increased, P.P.F.A. can't spend all the money, therefore it is channeled into six-figure salaries, stock market securities, real estate, et al. Donations amounted to \$228.1 million, a little less than taxpayer funded grants of \$254.4 million. (Every pro-lifer should be screaming at their Congressman to stop this farce!!) P.P.F.A. is a non-for-profit in name only. Donovan calculates that we, the taxpayer, contribute just over 30%. "Margaret Sanger's campaign for free love continues to cost the taxpayer a heady sum."

This is an organization which has used the <u>courts</u> to subvert the will of the majority of Americans on abortion, parental consent, Partial-Birth Abortion, unborn victims of violence and continues to insult us with its <u>choice</u> mantra. P.P.F.A.'s notion of <u>choice</u> ends in death for millions of unborn children and their so-called "Safer Sex" mentality has led to irreparable harm to our young adults. Equally important, their political tactics are a subversion of the American democratic political process.

We need to pass Unborn Victims of Violence Acts to protect innocent, unborn, wanted babies in their mother's wombs from crimes of violence intended to kill or injure them. Since the proposed federal legislation will only afford protection if the act of violence is committed as one of 68 federal crimes we must also pass separate New York State legislation to protect unborn babies assaulted during the commission of non-federal crimes in New York State. If Laci and Conner Peterson had been killed in New York only Laci's murder could be prosecuted under current New York State law!

As of March 2004 the pro-life efforts to enact Unborn Victims of Violence Legislation on a Federal and New York State level are as follows:

FEDERAL LEGISLATION Unborn Victims of Violence Act, Passes

On 2/26/04 by a solid 254-163 vote the House passed H.R. 1997 which recognizes two victims when a pregnant women and her unborn child are injured or killed by an assailant while in the commission of anyone of 68 federal crimes, e.g. the Oklahoma City or the World Trade Center bombings. The UVVA was passed by U.S. Senate as S. 1019 on March 25th and is awaiting President Bush's signature to become law. Unfortunately Senators Schumer and Clinton take the position that they are against any bill that might undermine freedom of "choice" which includes choosing to have an abortion. However, this bill is about protecting women desirous to bring their babies into this world free from any violent act against them. Why are Senators Schumer and Clinton not looking out for a woman's right to have her own baby with full protection of the law for both herself and her baby?

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION Unborn Victims of Violence Act S.403/ A.7524

This bill would make it a crime to injure or kill an unborn baby during commission of a crime of violence. Of all the pro-life bills introduced this year the "Unborn Victims of Violence Act" is probably the one with the greatest chance of becoming law this year.

Under our state's outdated Penal Law, babies in their mothers' womb are not protected from acts of violence even if that violence is intended to cause their death. Making such acts a crime would serve as a deterrent thus giving women who choose life greater protection for their pre-born babies. In the past two legislative sessions the N.Y.S. Senate has passed the "Unborn Victims of Violence Act" by a 2 to 1 Why does the leadership of the Assembly refuse to allow this bill to be considered? Those who support abortion profess that women must have the "right to choose" abortion. If they really believe in the "right to choose", then even supporters of abortion should actively encourage passage of this legislation, which simply recognizes the right of women who choose life to have the lives of their unborn babies protected.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The Human Cloning Prohibition Act of 2003, S.245, is sponsored by Senators Sam Brownback (R-Ks.) and Mary Landrieu (D-La.). This pro-life legislation is currently blocked from coming to a vote in the U.S. Senate by those who support cloning human embryos for experimentation and vigorous opposition from the Biotechnology Industry Organization which represents biotech firms and various patient and research groups.

On 02/27/03 the House passed the Weldon-Stupak bill H.R. 534 to ban all human cloning by a vote of 241-155. In 2002 a similar bill passed in the House by a vote of 265-162. In the absence of a federal ban human cloning remains legal in most states but differs greatly from state to state.

Currently five states have a ban on all forms of human cloning. Pro-cloning legislation includes the New Jersey law signed on 02/28/04 by Gov. James McGreevey and is the most extreme in the nation, allowing the creation, implantation, and gestation of a human clone, so long as it is killed either before or during birth. In the New York State Assembly, bill 6249-A, similar to the New Jersey law, has already passed.

New York State Legislation

Pro-Abortion "Emergency Contraception" bill passed in Assembly on 2/02/04. The Unintended Pregnancy Act" (S.3339/A.888) which would allow distribution of the so-called "morning-after pill" by pharmacists and nurses to females of any age without parental knowledge or physician oversight passed by an alarming 121-25.

Action: Sample Message.

Dear Senator....: Please oppose The Unintended Pregnancy Act S.3339/A.888. "Emergency Contraception" can cause heart attacks, strokes, and disabling or fatal blood clots. This potentially dangerous hormonal medication should not be available without a medical exam or physician oversight. Legislators are being told the FDA has said "Emergency Contraception" is safe, but the FDA says further study is needed.

There is inadequate research on the repeated use of "Emergency Contraception". Young girls will have ready access to mega-does of hormonal medication that could be used to cover-up instances of sexual abuse or dangerous promiscuous behavior without the involvement of a doctor or parent. Regions where "Emergency Contraception" has been introduced without prescription have not experienced a reduction in abortion rates but have experienced an increase in sexually transmitted diseases.

It is true that "Emergency Contraception" can work by delaying ovulation and preventing conception, furthermore, these pills can also work by preventing implantation of a conceived, developing embryo, thus causing the abortion of a human being.

It is important that you alert other Senators to the true nature of this dangerous legislation. Please reply.



CLONING – THE LATEST WORD
GAME



At the same time, scientists and researchers discovered that aborted children and "left-over" embryos from IVF treatments were good sources for embryonic stem cells. These are cells in the early stages of development, before they differentiate into specialized cells in the body. Stem cells are viewed as the solution for treating serious diseases and injuries such as leukemia, diabetes, sickle cell anemia, spinal cord injuries, Parkinson's Disease, etc. Since these embryos are "unwanted" or "leftovers", scientists see no harm in killing them to harvest the desired embryonic stem cells. The fact that the cure rate using embryonic stem cells is zero does not deter the scientific world. (In contrast, tens of thousands of individuals have been cured using adult stem cells. These are cells found in umbilical cord blood, placentas, amniotic fluid, fat from liposuction, nasal epithelium, adult tissues and organs and cadavers. Harvesting adult stem cells does not result in the destruction of another life.)

When stem cells from a non-related individual were transplanted into the patient, scientists were faced with the issue of rejection. Cloning was seen as the solution. The nucleus is removed from a donated egg. A body cell from the patient is fused with the empty egg. It is treated with chemicals to form an early embryo. Thus the new individual has only one

set of genetic instructions, and is actually a twin of the patient. The stem cells can then be harvested, destroying the "twin". Surveys show that most people are opposed to cloning. Therefore, scientists have tried to separate cloning into two categories, reproductive and therapeutic. Since most people are horrified at the thought of creating "twins" 10, 20, 30 or 40 years younger than themselves, scientists and politicians are supporting research and legislation involving only "therapeutic" cloning. This sounds pretty good, doesn't it? Therapeutic makes us think it's healthy and life saving. In reality, therapeutic cloning is even worse, because the newly created human being is always destroyed!

If the words make uncomfortable associations, change them! Abortion became pregnancy reduction. Pregnancy starts at implantation, not fertilization. Contraception therefore includes destruction of embryos before implantation. Cloning is labeled somatic cell nuclear transfer, creating "unfertilized blastocysts", "balls of cells", not human beings.

Proposed legislation would ban the transfer of cloned individuals into the womb. If embryos created through IVF are acceptable to transfer to the womb, how will they tell the difference? Therefore, survival is banned. As Richard Doerflinger of the USCCB stated recently, "A class of human beings will be created that it is a crime not to destroy. These human beings are treated as chattel, creating a new approach to human slavery." He stated that the attitude "we invented you, therefore we own you" will lead to genetic engineering and "designer" children. He also warned that in Delaware, proposed legislation "supports research in human cloning but bans implanting a cloned embryo in a womb for 'gestation and subsequent birth'. Implanting with the intent of aborting and harvesting of tissue would be allowed." He reported that current New Jersey law allows cloning and transfer to the womb up to birth!

Studies have shown that increased manipulation of eggs and embryos increases the risk of birth defects and abnormalities. The recent South Korean experiment retrieved 242 eggs. One survived to the point of creating a new embryonic cell line. How many lives will be created in order to be destroyed? Richard Doerflinger writes, "Human cloning's slippery slope toward complete dehumanization of human beings will not stop until the US Senate passes Senator Brownback's complete ban on human cloning. In the meantime, surely almost everyone can agree that proposals like those in New Jersey and Delaware demean the humanity of women and children alike."






