This could provide an opportunity for pro-life education to teachers and students.

In accordance with the provisions of the New York State Freedom of Information Law, please provide me with copies of all the records described below.

Records of interest are all communications between [name of school district] and Planned Parenthood Inc. This includes:

- -- Planned Parenthood Federation, Planned Parenthood of Nassau County, and Hudson Peconic Planned Parenthood
- -- All records identifiable with this request, even though reports on those records or copies of the records have been sent to other offices
- -- Communications include, but are not limited to: invoices, flyers, permission slips for field trips, invitations to school functions from school personnel to Planned Parenthood (e.g. classrooms, health fairs, PTA meetings), and invitations/announcements to the school from Planned Parenthood.

This request is limited to records produced on or after [date].

If for any reason any portion of my request is denied, please inform me of the reasons for the denial in writing and provide the name and address of the person or body to whom an appeal should be directed.

Please inform me before filling the request if there are any fees for copying the records requested.

Stop the CLONING BILL

Upon its return to Albany for a Special Session, the NYS Senate may consider legislation to promote human cloning. The Assembly already passed such legislation and it is critical that you contact your senator before 11/18. (Read 10/04 LIFE NEWS or go to www.ProLifeLl.org for more information).

Sample Letter: Dear Senator : I urge you to oppose any bill to legalize and promote embryonic stem cell research, including bills that deceptively claim to

"ban" human cloning. Embryonic stem cells are obtained by harvesting living embryos which are generally 5-7 days old. The removal of embryonic stem cells invariably results in the destruction of the embryo. There has not been even one medical benefit to humans from embryonic stem cells, but, adult stem cells have provided medical benefits in thousands of cases including diseases affecting the liver, heart and brain. Adult stem cells from the nasal cavity have been used to stimulate feeling and movement in the legs of paraplegics. Research using adult stem cells does not destroy human life, has saved lives and deserves funding.

HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT SCIENCE, POLITICS & ETHICS



The Sept./Oct. 2004 issue of Celebrate Life contains an article by Donald DeMarco, Ph.D. entitled 'Science is liable to politics'. He begins with the suggestion that most people tend to believe that scientists are beyond the influence of societal forces. "Politicians, journalists, educators, religious leaders, businessmen and sales personnel of every stripe may blow in the wind, but scientists, so we want to believe, are pillars of professional integrity." He then states that this is far from the truth, quoting from Dr. Oliver Wendell Holmes' address to the Massachusetts Medical Society in 1869, "Currents and Countercurrents in Medical Science:" "theoretically medicine ought to go on its own straightforward inductive path without regard to changes of government or to fluctuations of public opinion...the truth is that medicine, professionally founded on observation, is as sensitive to outside influences, political, religious, philosophical, imaginative, as the barometer to the changes of atmosphere."

Dr. DeMarco uses the example of psychiatrist Thomas Verney and his book, The Secret Life of the Unborn Child. Verney describes himself as an atheist and does not oppose abortion. His book was rejected by six publishing houses in Canada before Doubleday published it here in the U.S. DeMarco states that Verney "rapidly became a non-person in the scientific community, shunned by his colleagues, and was no longer invited to speak at science seminars...pro-life people were more interested in what science can reveal about the unborn child than were many of his own fellow scientists. Verney claims in his book that the scientific research of a variety of neurologists, audiologists and obstetricians provides 'incontestable physiological evidence that the fetus is a learning, sensing, feeling being...We now know that the unborn child is an aware, reacting human being." We all know how the pro-abortion movement tries to bury this information.

Dr. DeMarco questions whether we can trust scientists to be truthful about the child in the womb, the abortion/ contraceptive link to breast cancer, or the depth of the health problems related to homosexual activity. He states, "We are systematically shielded from the truth by the government and mass media, working in cooperation with politically correct scientists. Our knowledge of science is limited by the integrity of scientists. Science itself is innocent, but scientists are free to dissimulate. We think of our age as an Age of Science. But we may well ask whether it is, in practice, an Age of Politics. Science is the dominant feature of our age. Yet our cultural climate is not well suited to convey, without compromise or distortion, the scientific knowledge, especially in the area of life issues, that is available. Are we being told the truth about the cloning of human beings, the nature of stem cell research, the inherent dangers associated with in vitro fertilization and other forms of reproductive technology, and the adverse psychological effects of pornography? The enslavement of science to the ideology of the state, the legacy of Marxism, is not something we want to perpetuate in 21st century North America. Scientists may have no more integrity as a group than people of other professions. The important point, however, is that the health of our society demands integrity from people in all walks of life, from science to sponsorship to news reporting to media analysis to government involvement. How much of our health and welfare has been compromised as a result of others compromising their integrity? An Age of Truth would be the indispensable cornerstone for an Age of Health."

On Sept. 19, 2004, LifeNews.com ran an article by C. Ben Mitchell, Ph.D. entitled "Resurrecting Good Science: What's Wrong With Human Cloning." He reported on Panos Zavos' announcement of the creation of embryonic clones from two dead persons. This is the same doctor who claimed he transferred cloned embryos into a woman's uterus and created a bovine-human hybrid. Dr. Mitchell met Zavos in 1997. At that time, Zavos told Mitchell, "I don't have time to think about the ethics of what I am doing. I'll leave that to someone else. I'm too busy pushing the scientific envelope." Dr. Mitchell states, "The canons of good science include ethical review before research using human subjects is performed and moral findings after research. These principles have been developed over many years and against the backdrop of some horrific abuses of human beings in scientific research, from Nazi Germany to Tuskegee, Alabama, and beyond...Surely cloning, embryonic stem cell research, germ line genetic engineering, cybernetics, nanotechnology and the other burgeoning biotechnologies require even scrupulous ethical oversight and scientific discipline. Aristotle's 'golden means' may be a helpful guide here. We certainly need courageous science. But the extremes are to be avoided at all costs. Neither cowardice nor foolhardiness ought to characterize scientific research. 'Pushing the envelope'...can be a noble enterprise. Doing so without moral, religious, legal, and social reflection is hazardous to us all...Let's begin with that most ancient of medico-scientific injunctions: primum non nocere (first, do no harm)...As long as any human being is through his research—including human embryos-Dr. Zavos will be a dangerous glory-seeker rather than a good scientist."







QUESTION & ANSWER

Question: Do voters decide based on one issue?
