Why 10 feet apart?



Abortion Causes Massive Mental Health Problems

Abortion destroys the psychological health of teenage girls. This is the finding of a large new study that has statistics on this point so dramatic that even pro-lifers may have trouble believing them. The pro-abortion lead author of the study, Prof. David Fergusson of Christchurch School of Medicine & Health Sciences in Christchurch, New Zealand, told Australia's ABC News, in summary, that abortion causes mental health problems, not the other way around, and women's backgrounds had nothing to do with it.

In this study, published in the latest issue of the Journal of Child Psychology and Psychiatry, Fergusson and his two collaborators found that girls 15 to 18 who had not gotten pregnant had a 31.2% chance of experiencing major depression. Those who became pregnant but did not have an abortion had a 35.7% chance. But those who had an abortion had an astonishing 78.6% chance.

CONGRATULATIONS SOUTH \$

DAKOTA for passing a total ban on all abortions. The one exception is when the life of the mother is threatened. In signing the abortion ban, Governor Mike Rounds said, "A true test of a civilization is how well people treat the most vulnerable and the most helpless persons in their society."

HIGH COURT EXONERATES PRO-LIFER

After almost 20 years of legal harassment by the National Association of Women (N.O.W.), pro-life activist Joe Scheidler won. The U.S. Supreme Court by a 8-0 vote on 2/28/06 found Mr. Scheidler not guilty of Federal Extortion and Racketeering laws. The Court ruled that it found no proof the pro-life protestors intended to obtain property from abortion rights activists.

THE CHILD CUSTODY PROTECTION ACT

passed in the house on 4/27/05, as H.R. 1357, by a 270-157 vote. The bill, S. 403, awaits Senate action.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



BIOTECHNOLOGY RESEARCH

Gov. Pataki has announced a proposal to leverage hundreds of millions of dollars for a biotechnology research program. He has not said that his program would include funding of embryonic stem cell research (ESCR). The statement of Health Commissioner Novello that the Pataki Administration's goal for funding biomedical research is aimed at noncontroversial umbilical cord stem cells is certainly very encouraging, HOWEVER, intense pressure on the Governor from biotechnology companies and institutions to fund ESCR continues relentlessly. The Assembly, for the first time ever, has included funding for cloning and ESCR in its version of the 2006-2007 Budget. Please urge the State Senate to reject this proposal to use

your tax dollars to finance experimentation on living human embryos. Urge them instead to fund ethical and successful adult stem cell research. It is urgent that you continue to call and write the Governor and your Senators. Please also use the enclosed petition to gather signatures to support the pro-life position and return the petitions to us as soon as possible. "EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION"

The Assembly passed A.9906 by a vote of 102-28. This bill, which would allow "emergency contraception" to be dispensed without a doctor's visit or prescription, is somewhat revised from the bill Gov. Pataki vetoed 8/05, but was not amended to address his major concern; the lack of any age restriction in the bill. Please encourage the Governor to remain firm in his belief that an age restriction is necessary.

Sample Message to your Senator: Dear Please oppose any legislation such as A.9906. These high dose birth control pills sometimes act as an abortifacient. The FDA has not approved "over the counter" sale of this so-called "emergency contraception" pill.

Sample Message to the Gov. Pataki:

Thank you for your veto of the "Unintended Pregnancy Act" last year. Please use your position to prevent such legislation from becoming law in the future.

Please thank the Assembly Members from Nassau/ Suffolk who voted against A.9906: Bara, Fitzpatrick, Raia and Saladino. Newly elected Members Boyle (8th A.D.) and McKevitt (17th A.D.) were not eligible to vote and Alfano was excused.

THE DOLORES ANDRESKI MEMORIAL MICHAEL FUND WALKATHON 2006

The International Foundation for Genetic Research is popularly known as The Michael Fund. This foundation opened it's doors in 1978, with world-renowned geneticist, Dr. Jerome Lejeune, as Medical Director and Randy Engel as Executive Director. The Michael Fund is the prolife alternative to the National Foundation/March of Dimes that was

in a decade long battle with the pro-life movement because of their funding of live fetal research that was inhumane and their search and destroy policy (amniocentesis) as the "cure" for birth defects.

A number of the March of Dimes (MOD) grantees have used aborted babies as a source of spare parts or fetal blood obtained by "openheart puncture of healthy ten week aborted fetuses. During the 1970's & 1980's it was MOD's private foundation monies that permitted these researchers...to bypass the government ban prohibiting the use of federal funds for such non-therapeutic, lethal experimentation on live human fetuses."

In 1979, the Long Island Coalition for Life looked for a way to fund this new, pro-life foundation. The annual (since 1980) walkathon was the result. The walkathon's name was changed to honor the passing of one of God's most precious servants-Dolores Andreski. She dedicated her life to uphold the sanctity of all human life from conception through death. We ask you all to please consider joining us for our 27th walkathon between the opening ceremonies at noon until 3 pm. The path is 2 miles long and may be repeated as many times as you choose and have informed your sponsors. Contributions from those unable to participate in the walkathon are gratefully accepted. Your participation acknowledges that we are all members of the human family in which every human life is sacred and worthy of respect and support.

Studies have demonstrated that mental retardation, particularly that associated with chromosomal anomalies, often is amenable to treatment. The Michael Fund's Dr. Paddy Baggot's research has focused in on the time span in fetal development when retardation has not been observed and on early prenatal intervention treatment for these preborn children affected by chromosomal disorders.

Dr. Marie Peters Ney, Director of Medical Research, has worked with the International Center for Metabolic Testing on nutritional and chemical supplementation for children with Down Syndrome. She notes, "preliminary studies have documented a number of improvements in the health of children with Down Syndrome.... This study needs to be continued so that it be possible to evaluate neurological development."

Your contributions to the Michael Fund will help us fund life-giving research, genetic causes and treatments of Down Syndrome and related chromosomal disorders, genetic information agencies, support systems, physician referrals for specific birth anomalies,

adoption of handicapped children, and dietary management of children with chromosomal disorders. Log onto www.michaelfund.org for further information or newsletters that we have used as sources for our information.

Much has been done. Much remains to be accomplished. Help us honor Dolores and her years of tireless service to uphold the rights of the handicapped, born and preborn, and their families. 



Life News, 2/06, reported Felicia Bautista won an out-of-court settlement against an Oregon abortion facility. Dr. Joel Brind called to correct our error stating this was an in court settlement. Adapted from the Breast Cancer Prevention Institute newsletter of 8/05: For the second time since 2003, in the US, a medical malpractice lawsuit against an abortion clinic by a patient for failure to warn her about the abortion-breast cancer link (ABC link) has been brought to a successful concussion in favor of the plaintiff. The case of Felicia Bautista, 15-years old at the time of her abortion, was settled by a court. The All Women's Health Services clinic, Portland, Oregon, accepted a judgment of liability for violating the patient's rights. Felicia was awarded an undisclosed amount.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Question:

If Roe v Wade is reversed, then what?

Answer: Roe v. Wade is one of the two Supreme Court decisions which legalized abortion throughout all nine months of pregnancy in the U.S., in 1973. There is considerable talk that the Supreme Court could possibly reverse these decisions.
