

Planned Parenthood Targets Spanish Community

Planned Parenthood of Nassau County has a new Spanishlanguage marketing campaign focusing on the Latino community in Glen Cove and the surrounding area "... to inform...about the services the health center offers and to draw them in." Newsday 1/20/08. This peer outreach program gives a \$300 stipend to women who attend the PP three-day training. These women then visit laundromats, grocery stores, etc. distributing the PP information.

PP is working overtime to present it's friendly face even re-naming the Glen Cove center "La Casa Amarilla en la Cuesta (The Yellow House on the Hill)".

Why does pro-life object: Once a pre-teen/teen is drawn in to PP, he/she is likely to be misguided by PP's "safer sex" mantra rather than hear a strong abstinence message. Thus PP sets these youngster up so that they become future PP customers to get (and need) STD testing, to buy birth control, and to buy abortions. PP distributes the chemical abortion pill RU-486 at many of its sites.

ACTION: Pro-life Vigil outside Glen Cove Planned Parenthood: On Saturday, March 8, 2008 from 9:00 AM to 10:30 AM, pro-lifers will gather at the PP office at 110 School Street in Glen Cove to stand up for the defenseless preborn being aborted by PP, an organization spreading misguided and often dangerous information on sexuality and abortion. All pro-life people are asked to join this peaceful witness on the sidewalk in front of Planned Parenthood. Your participation helps save babies' lives and spare others from the tragedy of abortion. NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

In the 2/08 issue of *Life News* we issued a **CALL TO ACTION against**

RHAPP, Gov. Spitzer's radical abortion-on-demand bill, titled the "Reproductive Health and Privacy Protection Act." Alicia Colon, in the *New York Sun*, 2/1/08, said that the consequence of this proposed legislation to make a woman's right to choose a civil right "would be devastating to our freedom of religion".

HEALTH & SCIENCE Threats to Prolifers in the Medical Community



Several years ago, the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) attempted to mandate abortion training as a requirement for graduation. This would have forced all medical students to participate in abortion training. Luckily this attempt failed. The ACGME instituted a "moral" clause in their accreditation procedures to allow for exceptions for students and institutions on moral or religious grounds.

This past November, the Committee on Ethics for the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG), released ACOG Committee Opinion No. 385. Mark Crutcher of Life Dynamics Inc. wrote in a letter dated February 2008, "That opinion states that OB/GYNs ought not be allowed to refuse to perform abortions as a matter of conscience...six of the committee's recommendations are:

- The doctor must give his/her patients prior notice of any personal moral issues with abortion or contraceptives.
- 2. In the process of conveying this information they should not argue or advocate their position.
- 3. They must disclose all options to patients...including abortion.
- 4. They have a "duty" to refer patients to a doctor willing to provide these services if the patient requests it.
- 5. In an "emergency" in which a referral is not possible, or might negatively affect the patient's physical or mental health, the providers have an "obligation" to commit the abortion...regardless of the provider's personal moral objections.
- 6. Providers with moral or religious objections should practice in close proximity to individuals who do not share that provider's view."

Crutcher is in the process of contacting 75,000 OB/GYNs, family practitioners and OB/GYN medical students to inform them of these recommendations and to suggest actions they can take to prevent the ACOG from forcing them to perform abortions.

Colin Mason of the Population Research Institute reported in early February on the latest strategy of the pro-abortion movement. Misoprostol is the active ingredient in a prescription drug used in the treatment of gastric ulcers. It has also been used to treat women who are hemorrhaging from a spontaneous miscarriage or following childbirth. However, it is also used with the chemical abortion pill – RU486. Mason states, "The drug (misoprostol) has been seized upon by abortion-pushing NGO's who see misoprostol as their ultimate 'final solution'. Indeed, this small pill requires no medical training to use, it is easily stored at ambient temperatures

and it is available over-the-counter in many developing countries."

Mason directs the reader to the website www.misoprostolabortion.com. The website states that its goal is "to provide information [about misoprostol] to pregnant women who want to end their pregnancies, women who live in countries with restrictive abortion laws, countries where abortion is illegal, or for women who for some reason or the other do not have access to legal abortion services." Essentially the website supports what Mason calls a "one-pill, one-day homemade abortion. A woman who takes the drug generally begins hemorrhaging, after which she need merely go to a local medical clinic and claim that she is miscarrying. From the point of view of the doctor who examines her, the woman is spontaneously miscarrying. There is no evidence that she has aborted herself. Nor is the doctor aware that, by removing the now-dead baby, he is completing an elective abortion."

The Population Research Institute urges all prolifers to contact the FDA, 5600 Fishers Lane, Rockville MD 20857 (Phone 1-888-INFO-FDA) to demand that groups encouraging the off-label use of misoprostol be subject to regulatory action. In the 1990's, population control activist Steven Mumford was promoting the use of the antimalarial drug quinacrine hydrochloride to sterilize Third World women. PRI "blew the whistle" on him. The FDA ordered Mumford to "cease and desist, and to destroy his stockpile of quinacrine."

In NYS, Eliot Spitzer's Reproductive Health & Privacy Protection Act could compel all hospitals, including Catholic hospitals, to allow abortion in their facilities.

What is the motivation behind these moves? Crutcher writes, "their primary reason for doing so is... to reverse the dramatic shortage of abortion providers... Since 1992 over two thirds of the abortion clinics in the US have closed... fewer and fewer doctors are willing to bloody their hands from the gruesome practice of killing babies." Crutcher continues with statements from abortionists themselves who state that those who perform abortions are "incompetent", "not very good doctors... they cannot earn a living any other way", "people who moonlight at the clinics are grade-B doctors". The New York Times magazine stated on January 18, 1998, "Roe v Wade did not erase a medical history in which 'abortionist' was an insult worse than 'quack'."

We must do all we can to prevent this pro-abortion drive to force doctors to perform abortions directly or indirectly through forced referrals or unknowingly completing an elective abortion.
