THE FEDERAL BILL:

FOCA:

The FREEDOM OF CHOICE ACT, NOW PENDING IN CONGRESS, IS DESIGNED TO SUPERSEDE ALL STATE LAWS.

FOCA would:

- 1. Declare a "fundamental right" to abortion in our land. It would elevate that right to a level equal to such rights as free speech and the right to vote, and permit absolutely no interference with that right.
- 2. Require states to allow the brutal partial-birth and other late-term abortion procedures.
- 3. Require tax funding of abortion on demand.
- 4. Parental consent and informed consent would be outlawed.

THE NEW YORK STATE BILL: RHAPP:

The REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND PRIVACY ACT, ALMOST IDENTICAL TO FOCA, GUARANTEES AN UNRESTRICTED RIGHT TO ABORTION IN N. Y. STATE. RHAPP IS EXPECTED TO BE REINTRODUCED IN 2009.

RHAPP would:

- 1. Declare abortion a "fundamental right," that is, guarantee any women in N.Y. State an abortion, for any reason, at any time during her nine months of pregnancy.
- 2. Possibly invalidate the "conscience clause" protecting doctors and medical personnel.
- 3. Force all hospitals to allow abortions.
- 4. Deny parental involvement and a woman's right to informed consent.

Now is the time to acknowledge the seriousness of the above assaults on human life, to contact our legislators immediately, to bring this concern to pro-family/pro-life advocates and each day, to pray for a change of heart in all who support the above legislation. A recent New York State report showed that many Long Island charities receive a small fraction of donations raised through telemarketing while the majority of the money raised goes to the professional soliciting firms. Long Island charities receive approximately 16.8 cents of every dollar.

The Better Business Bureau recommends that charities receive at least 65 cents of every dollar raised. The state report, "Pennies for Charity" covered 55 Long Island charities. Of those 55, only two received more than that amount: The Long Island Coalition for Life and the Long Island Coalition for Life Educational Trust Fund.

HEALTH & SCIENCE Sound Choice Pharmaceutical Institute



The December 19, 2008 issue of the Spirit & Life Newsletter published a recommendation of the nonprofit, pro-life research company, Sound Choice Pharmaceutical Institute (SCPI), by Reverend Thomas J. Euteneuer, President of Human Life International. The President and founder of SCPI is Theresa Deisher, Ph.D. She is an expert in adult stem cell therapies and regenerative medicine. She has 23 patents issued in her name through organizations including Amgen, Zymo Genetics, Repligen and Immunex. Her discoveries in the fields of cardiovascular biology and stem cell research include the initial discovery and identification of adult heart stem cells. Dr. Marissa LaMadrid, physicist, is responsible for building the platforms of education, research and technology integration for SCPI. She has held fellowships in the Physics and Applied Physics Departments at Caltech, and in the Physiology, Biophysics and Genome Science Departments at the University of Washington. Her research has resulted in "developing novel methods and instrumentation for studying muscle contraction and cardiac disease at the single molecule level, creating new algorithms for sensitive genomic data analysis and finding novel stem cell binding receptors."

SCPI was founded "to promote public awareness about the widespread use of electively aborted fetal material in drug discovery, development and commercialization...SCPI realizes the need to address issues that are polarizing our nation: the safety of vaccinations, the true promise of stem cell research, and the conscience rights of healthcare professionals. SCPI, with a cadre of dedicated professionals, realizes that many healthcare decisions are being made without adequate and substantive research. Pharmaceutical companies do not fully disclose the final components in their products. Some look to profits over safety and moral integrity. SCPI reviews, researches and disseminates the context and content of vaccines and other biologic medicines to enable physicians, pharmacists, parents and grandparents to be 'informed consumers'. We investigate the biologic and physiologic consequences of human DNA and cellular contaminants in our medicine. We all have the right to know." (www.soundchoice.org)

According to SCPI, the government recommends a vaccination schedule overly influenced by the pharmaceutical companies. Government websites

"promote our current vaccination schedule and dismiss parents' safety concerns. Surprisingly, however, the US government recently conceded that vaccines can be linked to autism...By the time a child enters school they have received an average of 36 vaccinations – a number of them during the first 12 months of life. Several of these contain aborted fetal DNA and cellular contaminants, a fact that has many parents, scientists and medical professionals concerned. They are concerned about the short-term safety, the ethical aspects and the unknown lifelong health consequences; so concerned that parents are increasingly opting out of the recommended vaccination schedules. Their concerns may have merit; unfortunately we don't have the quality and quantity of research needed to draw firm conclusions. Before children received so many vaccinations and before vaccines contained aborted fetal DNA, only 1 child out of 10,000 was diagnosed with autism, now 1 child out of 150 is diagnosed. Is there a link? We need to find out. Research is the answer."

SCPI provides a "Pro-Life Produced" stamp on the medicine so that physicians, pharmacists and patients can be confident that the drug does not contain human DNA or cellular contaminants. They also have a "Pro-Life Compatible" stamp to indicate that the drug was not tainted during discovery, development or commercialization by the use of electively aborted, embryonic or any other unethically obtained fetal material.

Merck & Co. recently announced that it has stopped sales of its monovalent vaccines for measles, mumps and rubella and will now focus on its combination vaccine MMR II. Merck's separate dose for rubella, Meruvax, uses aborted fetal cell lines and taints the entire MMR II vaccine. The separate doses of Attenuvax (measles) and Mumpsvax (mumps) use chick embryo. Without these separate doses for measles and mumps, there will be no moral alternative for parents.

The Associated Press reported on January 6, 2009 that Merck & Co. has asked federal regulators to approve use in males (boys) of the vaccine Gardasil used against the sexually transmitted HPV (human papillomavirus). There have been numerous reports for the past several years of serious adverse reactions in girls from this vaccine, including genital warts, anaphylactic shock, foaming at the mouth, grand mal convulsions, coma and death. The aluminum-containing base of this vaccine has been linked to neurological and arthritic conditions for decades. (The AP reported that Gardasil sales began to slow in the second half of 2008. Could cash-flow problems be behind the request to extend the Gardasil vaccine to boys?)

March of Dimes Defective on Defects

The March of Dimes (MOD) has released the "Global Report on Birth Defects"- a detailed report of many birth defects and their frequency in the U.S. and in other countries. It suggests that with proper prenatal and after birth "treatment," 70% of the defects and deaths could be avoided. Accordingly, they list some "health initiatives and prevention programs" including some very laudable, such as nutrition programs, folic acid supplements, intra-uterine surgery, and more.

The MOD, however, also includes in this list genetic testing, pre-natal diagnosis of Down syndrome, and infant screening for rare metabolic disorders. So, as it has for the last three or four decades, the MOD continues to subtly suggest abortion as "treatment" for genetic defects. METHODS OF ABORTION PERFORMED IN THE UNITED STATES:

3,288 children are killed by abortion daily in the U.S. (Source: American Life League 7/08). The amount of babies killed since abortion was made legal in 1973 is nearly 50 million (Source: National Right to Life 1/08).

Reports of a slight decrease in abortion must never be used to minimize the reality. Do the descriptions upset us? They should. Equally upsetting is proposed federal and N. Y. State legislation (see Pages 1 and 3) designed to guarantee a right to abortion and to punish those who refuse to participate. Abortion will continue until many, many more Americans speak out in opposition.

Micro-Abortions – caused by contraceptive drugs and devices used before or during the first weeks of pregnancy

RU-486 – used up to the second month is a combination of drugs. The first deprives the baby of food, fluid and oxygen. The second drug stimulates the uterus to contract and the baby is expelled. This procedure can take over a week.

Suction-Aspiration — used through the third month by inserting a powerful suction tube with a knife-like edge into the uterus. Suction tears the baby's body into pieces.

Dilation and Curettage (D and C) — used through the third month. A loop-shaped steel knife is used to cut and scrape the baby and the placenta out into a basin.

Dilation and Evacuation (D and E) — used after the third month. A pliers-like instrument is used to pull the baby by a limb into a position where the skull is crushed and the baby pulled out.

Prostaglandin Abortion – a hormone used in mid and late term pregnancies to induce labor. The baby usually dies from the trauma but if it is determined the child will be born alive a drug is inserted in the heart to ensure a dead baby.

Dilation and Extraction (D and X) – also called Partial Birth Abortion. Used from the 4th through 9th month. In 2003 President Bush signed the ban against this procedure but only in 2007 did the ban go into effect when the Supreme Court upheld the ban. The abortionist inserts forceps, grasps one of the child's legs, positions the live baby in a breech position and pulls the baby out except for the head. Scissors are jammed into the skull to make space for a suction catheter to suction out the brain. The skull collapses and the dead baby is pulled through the cervix.

The SCPI website states, "Over the past decade the use of aborted fetal material has slowly, almost imperceptibly, seeped into and become routine at many stages of drug discovery, development and commercialization, to the point where aborted fetal material is now being used to discover new food additives and flavor enhancers. Within the next decade it may no longer be possible to get new FDA approved medicines that are not tainted by the use of embryonic, aborted fetal or some other morally illicit material. It is a choice of the scientific community to turn to embryonic and aborted fetal material, not a necessity. SCPI knows that there is a solution to this moral quagmire, and that the technology to do this exists, waiting to be used.

SCPI realizes the need to promote morally grounded scientific development by supporting and encouraging the creation of other like-minded biotechnology and pharmaceutical companies. 





