FEDERAL LEGISLATION

HEALTH CARE REFORM-The President and Congressional leaders will use 'Reconciliation' to try passing a (slightly modified) Senate Health Care Bill. Thus only

51, not 60 votes, can end a Senate filibuster. Contrary to assurances by Speaker Pelosi and HHS Sec. Sebelius, the Senate Bill would...

- Directly appropriate money (\$7B) to Community Health Centers (aka FQHCs). As this bypasses the annual HHS budget, it is not protected by *Hyde*.
- Allow abortion to be defined as 'preventive care'.
- Require at least one Health Plan to cover abortion
- Fund abortions via "affordability credits"
- Place *temporary* limits on other abortion funding.
- Lack full conscience protection.

ACTION - SAMPLE MESSAGE: If bill has not been finalized, contact your representatives again.

Oppose any bill that does not specifically prohibit funding of abortion, euthanasia and life-destructive technologies. "Medical procedure," "preventive care," "women's health" & "clinical practices" are euphemisms that must be clearly defined. "Conscience protection" for insurers, purchasers, plan sponsors, and health care workers, facilities, medical schools and pharmacies must be included.

FY 2011 FEDERAL BUDGET PROPOSAL

Contains massive abortion funding. Pays for abortions in D.C., as did last year's budget. Proposes allowing the Legal Services Corp to receive indirect funding for abortion cases. Funds UNFPA, with no strictures against abortion. Proposes \$327 million for Title X spending, and at least \$648 million for international family planning. The Abortion/Breast Cancer Link — Part II of II



Concluded from the March issue of Life News

Karen Malec observes, "Although the NCI, the nation's [USA] largest funder of cancer research and others have worked feverishly to suppress the ABC link by publishing fraudulent research and even leaning on scientists whose studies have shown risk increases among women who have abortions, honest research occasionally escapes the NCI's purview."

In October, 2007, the *Journal of American Physicians and Surgeons* published a study entitled, "The Breast Cancer Epidemic". It found that among 7 risk factors, abortion is "the best predictor of breast cancer". Author Patrick Carroll noted that countries with higher abortion rates (England and Wales) could expect an increase in breast cancer incidence while countries with lower abortion rates (Northern Ireland and the Irish Republic) could expect a smaller increase. Baklinski reported on LifeNews.com (3 Oct 2007) that there is a social gradient for breast cancer that is not present in other cancers. "Upper class and upwardly mobile women have more breast cancer than lower class women. Carroll suggests that the known preference for abortion in this class may explain the phenomenon. Women pursuing higher educations and professional careers often delay marriage and childbearing. Abortions before the birth of a first child are highly carcinogenic. Carroll used national data from nations believed to have 'nearly complete abortion counts.' Therefore, his study is not affected by recall bias."

Karen Malec responded on these findings, "It's time for scientists to admit publicly what they already acknowledge privately among themselves – that abortion raises breast cancer risk – and to stop conducting flawed research to protect the medical establishment from massive medical malpractice lawsuits."

In October 2005, the Chinese state media reported a sharp increase in the number of breast cancer cases over the preceding 10 years. They found that about 40% more women were dying of breast cancer, and that it was striking women at a much earlier age. The government linked the increase to stress and greater consumption of fatty foods. *LifeSiteNews* commented on 13 Oct 2005, "A much easier explanation, however, is the communist country's obsession with limiting its population with abortion. The Coalition on Abortion/Breast Cancer points out that an identical increase in breast cancer in US women was found between the mid-1980's and 1998; "the increase took place entirely within the Roe v Wade generation – the group of women who were under age 40 in 1973 when abortion was legalized." Karen Malec noted, "The Chinese government, like the American government, isn't telling women why they're getting more breast cancers. Here's a little clue for the Chinese and US governments. Nations that prohibit abortion (like Ireland and Poland) have significantly lower breast cancer rates... When research is conducted outside the control of the US National Cancer Institute and other western governmental agencies or organizations tethered to abortion ideology and politics, the truth emerges that abortion raises risk of breast cancer."

Good News: On 1/13/2010 the New Hampshire House defeated, by a vote of 242 to 113, a measure that would have legalized assisted suicide. Rep. Nancy Elliott stated: "It's not the function of government to encourage suicide in the young or the old. It's a prescription for elder abuse."

On a Sad Note: The Montana Supreme Court decision of 12/31/2009 opened the door to legalizing assisted suicide in that state. The court decision can be reversed by the legislature. An **ASSISTED SUICIDE SEMINAR to be held in Seattle, Washington, on June 5, 2010** intends to update participants on current statutes and discuss future directions for challenging these assisted suicide statutes.

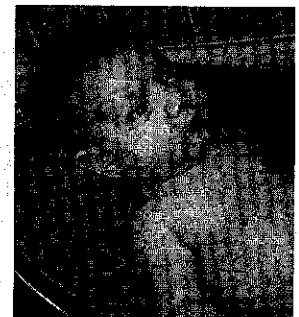

Pro-Life witness at an abortion site may save both the mother (from possible physical and emotional harm) and her child (his/her life will end). 1/26/2010 LifeNews.com reported: A New York woman has apparently died as a result of a failed abortion done at the A-1 Women's Care abortion center located in Jackson Heights, NY. Reports indicate emergency officials responded to an emergency call at the abortion site [on 1/25/2010]. WPIX-TV indicates a woman in her 30s was reportedly undergoing heavy bleeding and was rushed to Elmhurst Hospital where she was later pronounced dead. 1010 WINS radio indicated the abortion practitioner severed an artery during the abortion procedure.
