Denis Dillon, former Nassau County District Attorney for 31 years died on Sunday, August 15, 2010 at his home in Rockville Centre. His tenure made him one of the longest serving district attorneys in New York State. During the time of his public service he became known not only as an outstanding prosecutor but also for his ardent right-to-life leadership. That involvement engendered the ire of the pro-abortion media and a coalition of women's groups who demanded his resignation (which did not materialize). Denis Dillon responded: "I believe that if abortion is legal, the law loses its moral authority and credibility. To put it simply: If abortion is right what can be wrong."

Denis Dillon was truly our Man for All Seasons. His support for life issues was unwavering and steadfast. At his funeral Mass, State Supreme Court Justice Arthur Diamond summed it up best when he said: "Denis was our great servant but he was God's first."

Rest in peace, Denis.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

EMBRYONIC STEM CELL DEBATE

UPDATE - On 3/9/2010 President Obama issued an Executive Order to permit Federal funding of Embryonic Stem Cell research. On

7/30, the Obama Administration approved Geron company's bid to begin the first human trial of embryonic stem cells, as a therapy for acute spinal cord injury. The FDA put a hold on the trial last year, as Geron's test animals showed increased spinal cyst f ormation. Other researchers say these concerns have still not been satisfied.

Then on 8/23, Judge Royce Lamberth issued a preliminary injunction, saying an Executive Order could not over-ride the Dickey-Wicker Amendment, the law which prohibits federal funding of research that destroys human embryos. But the ruling also made it clear Congress would be well within its power to pass a law over-riding the Dickey amendment. As of 9/15 a court battle over the funding continues.

And, sure enough, we find that pro-abort Rep. Diana DeGette [D-CO] had introduced the Stem Cell Research Advancement Act of 2009 H.R.4808. Cong. Bishop [D-NY] and Cong. Ackerman [D-NY], and others, have co-sponsored the bill. She is now urging the Democrats to pass it ASAP.

ACTION-SAMPLE MESSAGE to Senate and House Members: Urge you vote against the Stem Cell Research Advancement Act of 2009 H.R. 4808. This bill allows funding of research using embryonic stem cells thus destruction of human life.

HEALTH & SCIENCE The Overpopulation Myth

The 2008 documentary, Demographic Winter: the decline of the human family, and the 2009 sequel, Demographic Bomb: demography is destiny, make the argument that "far from having too many people, the world is running out of them - especially young people." (Celebrate Life, July/August 2010, "Exploding the myth of overpopulation," by Steve Weatherbe) The Weatherbe article reports that the United Nations continues to warn against overpopulation and promotes policies to slow the increase. At the same time, the UN acknowledges that the world's population rate is slowing and will begin to decline by 2050 or sooner. As a matter of fact, there is already a fertility decline worldwide, prompting some world leaders to establish policies to promote population growth. Russia is on the path to lose one third of its population within 40 years. The government now offers \$9,000 to mothers for having a second child. Portugal's government may charge higher pension fees to couples with fewer than 2 children. Japan, with a birthrate of 1.25 live births per woman, has a ministry dedicated to reversing the decline. The government in Shanghai, China, is "now encouraging families to have two or more children a stark departure from China's one-child policy."

Declining birthrates combined with longer life spans are leading to a smaller workforce to finance the expanding senior population. According to Weatherbe, the 2009 film predicts that in the near future, "every set of 16 Chinese grandparents will depend on the labors - and taxes of a single shared descendent." The film asks, "Who will operate the factories and farms in the Europe of the future? Who will develop the natural resources? Who will care for a graying population? A burgeoning elderly population combined with a shrinking workforce will lead to a train wreck for state pension systems." Paul Ehrlich, author of the Population Bomb, which started the overpopulation scare in the late 1960's, acknowledges that there will be fewer men in the work force, but theorizes that this will lead to a lower crime rate and will encourage seniors to work into their 80's before retiring. Ehrlich predicted starvation for millions in India and Africa in the late 20th century. He urged the United States to end aid to third-world countries he felt were already doomed by high birthrates.

The filmmakers cite several factors which contributed to the decline: rising prosperity, radical feminism, contraception, cohabitation, hedonism, environmentalism and abortion. Producer Barry McLerran stated that as a result of Ehrlich's predictions, "There was now no public-interest reason for laws against contraception, abortion or homosexuality, because overpopulation was the problem." Dr. Matthew Connelly of Columbia University points out that Ehrlich's mistake was equating children with poverty.

"They see children as more mouths to feed. What they are is more hands to help." *Demographic Winter* illustrated that the Green Revolution increased the world's food production through technology and genetics. However, the overpopulation myth continues to gain support. The British group, Optimum Population, called for cutting the population of the United Kingdom by two thirds in order to reduce global warming. McLerran states, "The obvious cause of the problem to them is people. But they will be getting rid of the obvious solution, too. It will take people to figure out how to live on earth without destroying it."

Dr. Eberstadt states in both films: "The world's population was indeed growing, but not because people were breeding like rabbits; it was because they weren't dying like flies." Better medical care and public health improvements have resulted in a larger elderly population. This will lead to the growth in population until 2050, even while fewer children are born.

Even though the US is the only developed country with a replacement level birthrate (2.13 children per woman), the fertility rate is still falling. The population will continue to grow due to higher life expectancy. However, the peak spending period for 'baby boomers' has just ended. Harry S. Dent, an economic and demographic analyst, predicted the Japanese crash of 1990 by calculating the spending peak for Japan's baby boomers. He predicted the US crash that occurred soon after the release of the film in 2008. Dent warns that prosperity is based on growing populations and growing consumption. *Population Bomb* tied the "real-estate collapse that triggered the 2008 crash to the retirement of baby boomers, many of whom are leaving their 3 and 4 bedroom homes to a generation with families too small to want them and unable to buy them."

Both films "expose the racist motives of much of the population control movement, starting with America's eugenics movement, and its less overt reliance on thirdworld immigrants, which robs those countries of their human capital." McLerran notes that "people need other reasons than economic ones to have children." Demographer Phillip Longman suggests that "several faiths share a positive attitude toward life, creation and children, and these groups have a birthrate above the magic 2.13 level...He argues that government programs offering hope, rather than spending money, have worked in the past. He credits the GI Bill for sparking the post-WWII baby boom - not by offering cash for babies, but by offering a whole generation of young men an unprecedented opportunity for higher education." McLerran acknowledges that "there are signs that native Europeans are waking up and increasing their fertility rate. Turning population decline around is difficult, because it requires turning around the popular culture. It will need a re-valuing of the family and marriage."


