#### FEDERAL LEGISLATION

No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act HR.3 passed in the House on May 4. GOP voted 235-0 Ayes, Democrats voted 175-16 Nays, for a total 251-175 -- well shy of the two-

thirds needed to override a Presidential veto. LI Congressional Reps who voted against this pro-life bill are: Bishop, Israel, McCarthy and Ackerman. Congressman King voted pro-life. The bill went to the Senate May 5, was read, and placed on their Legislative Calendar under "Read the First Time."

HR.3 would end the need to fight each year to renew Hyde Amendment bans on the funding of abortions by federal programs. It would cover the loop-holes by which ObamaCare could fund abortions, and would install conscience protection for health workers and providers. The PROTECT LIFE ACT S.877 - On May 4, the Protect Life Act (S.877) was introduced in the Senate. It is a companion bill to HR.3, covering Hyde, ObamaCare funds, and conscience clause.

President Obama has promised to veto HR.3, if it gets to his desk (*LifeNews.com* 5/3). LN also says (5/2) that during the writing of ObamaCare, healthcare reform Czar Nancy-Ann DeParle met with 13 pro-abortion groups.

On April 8, a last minute compromise avoided a partial government shut down. The GOP gave up on defunding Planned Parenthood via this bill. The Wall Street Journal (4/11) commented- "The Democrats were willing to 'shut' the government over keeping PP funded, despite PP being required to pay for abortions with non-government funds, and *Roe v Wade* remaining intact." But the GOP got Senate promises to vote on ObamaCare repeal & PP defunding, and a tax-funded abortion ban in Wash, DC. (LifeNews.com 4/8)

## NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

#### Reproductive Health Act S.2524/A.6112

If this bill becomes law, abortion without limits or restriction will be enshrined in New York State law by establishing it as a "fundamental right" regardless of what happens at the Supreme Court level.

China to End One-Child
Policy in 2015 Because of
Labor Shortages! (But Not Really)
Weekly Briefing, 11 April 2011, by Steven W. Mosher,

I have long wondered what it would take for the Chinese Communist Party to abandon the one-child policy that it instituted back in 1980 when I was first in China. Now we know. It certainly wasn't the bitter complaints of the Chinese people about this assault on their families and children that changed the Party's collective mind. The Party has never shied away from imposing its will on the people it controls. Indeed, it believes, despite rhetoric to the contrary, that the Chinese masses exist to serve the state, not the converse. It is a crime in China to criticize Party policy, and critics are punished, not heeded.

Nor was the Party at all concerned about the millions of children, both born and unborn, who have been sacrificed as a result of this policy. After all, eliminating people was what the population control policy was all about. Diminutive Deng Xiaoping set the tone of the policy back in 1979 when it said, "Use whatever means you must (to control China's population), just do it. With the support of the Chinese Communist Party you have nothing to fear." Party officials have been "doing it" to Chinese women ever since, to the tune of 7 to 10 million abortions a year.

Did the Party leadership finally begin to regret the massive and ongoing human rights violations that the one-child policy entailed? Hardly. It takes a pretty hardened leadership cadre to send mobile abortion squads to hunt down pregnant women, to arrest them for violating the one-child policy, and then to abort and sterilize them against their will. This has been going on for 30 years. It is highly unlikely that Hu Jintao simply woke up one morning wracked by guilt and said to himself, "This is wrong."

No, the reason that the policy may be ended has nothing to do with human considerations at all, but with cold dollars and cents calculations. You see, as a result of the elimination of 400 million productive young people from the population over the past three decades, China now has a labor shortage. For 20 years, the coastal provinces have been scouring the backwaters of China for young people to fill factory jobs in assembly plants that would otherwise go begging. The villages of China have been emptied out as a result, and are now

primarily home to the very young and increasing numbers of the very old.

China has now hit the Lewis turning point, named after Arthur Lewis, a Nobel Prize-winning economist who first defined that critical moment in a developing country's economic rise when its labor supply dries up. In my view China has already hit the Lewis turning point, given that wages, prices, and inflation are now soaring in China. Others, like Dong Tao, chief regional economist for Credit Suisse Bank in Hong Kong, say that China will hit it within two or three years. China's communist leaders now realize that they have created, by means of their Draconian one-child policy, an artificial shortage of labor by eliminating an estimated 400 million people from the population.

But they have a problem. They cannot admit that their policy was wrongheaded from the get-go without delegitimizing their rule. So they have decided to back away from the current policy slowly, by moving to a nationwide two-child policy. This will not eliminate the abuses, of course. Women will still be arrested for the crime of being pregnant, locked up until they give their consent for an abortion, and then aborted against their will. But these now will be women who are pregnant with their third child, not with their second. The state, by all accounts, does not intend to give up its control over the reproduction of the Chinese people.

And so the Chinese Communist Party will continue to violate one of the most fundamental rights of the Chinese people: the right to decide for themselves the number and spacing of their children.

#### From www.lifesitenews.com dated April 28, 2011:

China recently released the results of their first census in 10 years revealing that population growth was cut almost in half from the previous decade. Although some experts anticipated the Chinese government would be pressured to relax its population control policies of forced abortion, sterilization, imprisonment and enormous fines, President Hu Jintao announced that China would continue with its policies to "stabilize a low birth rate." The number of Chinese over the age of 59 rose 2.93% while the number under the age of 15 dropped 6.29%. This demographic shift will greatly affect the younger generations causing an "upside-down population pyramid" where one child will be caring for 2 parents and 4 grandparents. There is also a huge gender imbalance due to sex-selective abortion which may lead to social unrest as millions of young men are unable to find wives.

#### June is Abortion Awareness Month In The Black Community

The Alan Guttmacher Institute reports that black women are more than five times as likely as white women to have an abortion. On the average, 1,876 black babies are aborted every day in the U.S. According to statistics provided by the U.S. Center for Disease Control, since 1973, (when the Roe v. Wade decision decriminalized abortion), black women have had some 16 million abortions. Yet the truth is fighting to get out to the African-American community. In February 2011 a billboard was erected in SoHo in Manhattan by a Texas based group, Life Always, that showed a picture of a six year old black girl with the caption, "The most dangerous place for an African American is in the womb." Under massive protests by NYC council members and black leaders such as the Rev. Al Sharpton, it was removed after only two days. Dr. Alveda King said, "The message of this billboard is totally accurate...and it should provoke outrage in the African American communitynot because it is racist, but because of the truth it reveals; the truth that is being kept from the African American community." 
## Face the Truth - Good Friday 2011


