

Long Island mourns two great pro-life men!


Jerome (Jerry) Higgins



Remembering Jerry Higgins by George Frost

Jerry Higgins was the greatest pro-life warrior I personally ever knew. I will be forever grateful to him for encouraging me to attend the Right-to-Life March on the 20th anniversary of Roe v Wade in 1993 and bringing me into an activist role in the pro-life movement. In addition to chairing the Long Island Coalition for Life, Jerry protested early every Saturday morning without fail at a local abortion mill. His strength and determination would renew mine on those cold, dark, wintry mornings when I was tempted to ignore the six-thirty alarm.

John (Jack) Eschmann



In 2005, The Life Center of Long Island honored Jack Eschmann for his years of dedicated service to the pro-life movement. From 1955 to 1975 Jack was a Nassau County police officer. After he noticed he was locking up the same people for different crimes, he decided with the help of the Diocese of Rockville Centre and the St. Vincent de Paul Society, to open a halfway house in Roosevelt called Anthony House. He thought the best help for these felons was to be introduced to God. He also invited the homeless men to come live in the house and was instrumental in opening a home for women in the town.

Jack's call to physically go out on the streets of Long Island to tend to the needs of the homeless included the most vulnerable of all - those who were homeless AND pregnant.

Jerry Higgins...

One Saturday morning after a major snowstorm, I arrived at the site of the abortion mill, and there on top of a four-foot snow bank was Jerry holding his pro-life sign. He was well-prepared to stay for the duration outfitted with heavy gloves and a scarf to protect his face from the ten-degree wind chill.

Not only was Jerry a man of great determination, his superb organizational skills made the L.I.C.L. run very efficiently, which maximized the use of our limited resources in saving the unborn. Once when I was in charge of the Saturday protest because he was in Albany for a N.Y State Right-to-Life meeting, I returned only nine of ten pro-life signs. As soon as he returned home, he called wanting to know where the tenth sign was. He was meticulous in making sure each person knew their job and did what they said they would do and that included himself.

The day before Jerry's last hospitalization, he asked me to come to his house. When I arrived, there was Jerry standing in the middle of his study, his body weak from cancer, his lungs filled with pneumonia making it difficult to breathe, getting L.I.C.L. files and other materials ready for a seamless transfer of authority and information. Let us all in the pro-life movement carry on with Jerry's courage and determination. He was, to put it quite simply, the heart and soul of the L.I.C.L. May he rest in peace.

Jack Eschmann...

Many of these women are the most difficult and complicated cases of The Life Center. Pregnancies complicated by drugs and alcohol, domestic violence, mental illness, rape, young women kicked out of their homes and abandoned by their family and close friends. He would work with The Life Center in drawing out a viable plan which would give a woman a new direction and ultimately save the life of her unborn child from abortion.

Jack was an active leader in the many Nassau and Suffolk Respect Life Processions, he was a co-founder of the Long Island Coalition for Life's annual STAND UP FOR LIFE event, he coordinated pro-life fundraising events, and he also lobbied politicians so they would recognize the dignity of unborn children.

The perseverance of Jack Eschmann also represents an entire generation of pro-lifers who refused to give up the cause for Life. This generation has spent over 30 years praying outside abortion clinics, educating the public, and speaking out against laws that do not protect women and their preborn children.

Rest in peace, Jack.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The Respect for Rights of Conscience Act, S.1467/HR.1179 has had no action since 3/28/11. They remain in their respective House & Senate committees.

On 7/21/11, The Foreign Relations
Authorization Act, [HR.2583] was sent on (as amended), to the full House, by the Foreign Relations Committee.
HR.2583 still contains 'Section 412,' which bans US foreign aid from going to groups that perform or promote abortion.

ACTION ITEMS:

Tell your Senators and Representative to vote YES on S.1467/HR.1179, and to keep Section 412 in HR 2583.

'cell lines'.

The ObamaCare bill, presents many problems for pro-lifers. But taxpayer abortion funding, conscience protection and rationing of medical care have not been the focus of most of the Court challenges to the bill. The major argument made against the bill centers on the "individual mandate"- the requirement that almost everyone *must have* a government approved, or government provided, health insurance policy.

As reported in July's LN, the US Dept of Justice has increased the number of prosecutions for non-criminal actions, under the *Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances Act (FACE)*. The total is now eight, up from six in July.

The CQ asks these six questions:

- 1. Would you vote for legislation to protect innocent human life from conception to natural death?
- 2. Would you oppose (vote against) use of taxpayer money to fund abortion?
- 3. Would you vote for Parental Consent for a minor seeking an abortion?
- 4. Would you vote for legislation requiring Informed Consent for a woman seeking an abortion?
- 5. Would you vote for legislation to prevent the legalization of euthanasia and assisted suicide?
- 6. Would you vote to ban all human cloning and embryo-destructive stem cell research?

"Yes" is the pro-life response to each question. Candidates may request a CQ by calling 631-243-1435 or via e-mail to mariemawn@yahoo.com. Not all candidates reply. It is often necessary we walk up and ask their position on the Life Issues. Pass their answer on.

HEALTH & SCIENCE In Vitro Fertilization -Problems & Concerns Part I



An article by Kristan Hawkins, "Pro-Life Concerns about IVF Include Abortion, Exploitation," was published on LifeNews.com September 6, 2011. The author begins by stating that in vitro fertilization (IVF) is an issue that affects the pro-life "movement directly and has a profound impact on the way we view the dignity and value of every human life, both inside and outside the womb. The infertility industry in the U.S. has been a booming industry for decades, including the multi-billion dollar business of egg donation."

This industry has led to a mentality where human life created through IVF is considered a commodity. An IVF "lottery" was launched in Britain in July giving away thousands of pounds toward fertility treatments in top clinics. An article by Stefano Ambrogi on Reuters.com July 7, 2011 stated that critics are "calling it inappropriate and demeaning to human reproduction...Britain's fertility regulator, The Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority said using IVF as a prize was 'wrong and entirely inappropriate. It trivializes what is for many people a central part of their lives.'...Josephine Quintavalle, from the campaign group Comment on Reproductive Ethics said 'creation of human life should not be reduced to a public lottery...this demeans the whole nature of human reproduction."

A radio station in Ottawa recently started a contest to "win a baby" - the prize being 3 rounds of fertility treatments. The Daily Mail writes, "Its disturbing advert features a baby staring out at the camera holding up a sign saying: 'Win me!' although with the caveat underneath that 'Baby may not be exactly as shown'. All contestants have to do is write in 100 words or less why they want a child and a panel of judges will pick the most persuasive." (www.dailymail.co.uk, 08 Sept 2011, 'Win a baby!' Radio station

condemned for competition giving away free IVF treatments)

The New York Times carried an article on September 5, 2011, "One Sperm Donor, 150 Offspring" by Jacqueline Mroz. Cynthia Daily wanted her son to be able to "get to know some of his half siblings, ...so she searched a web-based registry for other children fathered by the same donor...Today there are 150 children, all conceived with sperm from one donor, in this group of half siblings, and more are on the way...

they all look alike... Now there is growing concern among parents, donors and medical experts about potential negative consequences of having so many children fathered by the same donors, including the possibility that genes for rare diseases could be spread more widely through the population. Some experts are even calling attention to the increased odds of accidental incest between half sisters and half brothers who often live close to one another. 'My daughter knows her donor's number for this very reason,' said the mother of a teenager conceived via sperm donation in California....'We have more rules that go into place when you buy a used car than when you buy sperm,' said Debora L. Spar, president of Barnard College and author of 'The Baby Business: How Money, Science and Politics Drive the Commerce of Conception'." Rebecca Taylor writes in LifeNews.com (September 8, 2011, "India: Women Exploited in Surrogacy Pregnancy Contracts)." Most surrogacy agreements require payments to the surrogate mother which can cost anywhere from \$30,000 to \$100,000 USD. Western couples are looking for cheaper options. Many are now turning to women from third world countries to carry their IVF embryos." Scott Carney recently wrote a book, The Red Market: On the Trail of the World's Organ Brokers, Bone Thieves, Blood Farmers, and Child Traffickers. Carney reported that surrogates at a clinic in India featured on the Oprah show were kept under lock and key for the entire pregnancy, were often forced to deliver by C-section despite the higher risks involved, and are often pressured by family members, including husbands, to become a surrogate in order to provide extra money for the family. Carney writes that Indian women are preferred because they are "easier to control." A client stated that "the way they have things set up in India is that the surrogate's sole purpose is to carry a healthy baby for someone." Carney cites Usha Smerdon, from the adoption reform group Ethica, "Surrogacy is a form of labor. But it is an exploitative one, similar to child labor and sweat shops driven by Western consumerism...I challenge the notion...that hospitals are operating above board when driven by a profit motive."
