


## New York State Department Of Health Abortion Statistics




## Pepsi Co Boycott Ends!

A boycott of Pepsi Co products, led by several pro-life groups, began in May 2011(*Life News*, July 2011, Pg.4, Health & Science) when it was revealed that Pepsi Co engaged Senomyx, a biotech company which develops flavor enhancers, unfortunately using human embryonic kidney cells taken from an electively aborted baby to produce human taste receptors. It was reported in *LifeSiteNews.com*, April 30, 2012 that the **protest and boycott by thousands of concerned consumers has been successful.** Pepsi Co's VP of Global Public Policy, Paul Boykas states, "Senomyx will not use HEK cells or any other tissues or cell lines derived from human embryos or fetuses for research performed on behalf of Pepsi Co." ## FEDERAL LEGISLATION

By the time you read this or shortly after, we will have the U.S. Supreme Court's ObamaCare decision. All, some or none of the law might be overturned. We could still have the rationing panels, while not being

forced to buy insurance. The ruling could affect ObamaCare only, or over half of what the Feds tell the states, individuals, and organizations they *shall* and *shall not* do. Some GOP House members want to repeal and replace ObamaCare completely, while others have prepared bills to "keep the popular parts" of it, depending on the Supreme Court's ruling.

The LICL opposes those parts of ObamaCare that are anti-life. The recent HHS mandate forcing coverage for Contraceptives/Sterilizations/Abortifacients was issued as part of ObamaCare. On 5/21, a group of forty three Catholic institutions & dioceses' filed the largest ever 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment religious freedom lawsuit against the HHS. Two of the three 'major' evening newscasts ignored it.

HHS has hired a Democrat connected PR firm to spend \$20M to promote the Mandate. They say Section 4004 of ObamaCare requires an "education and outreach campaign regarding preventive benefits".....

John Edwards' trial ended in a mistrial. Legal groups on both sides of the aisle had warned that a guilty verdict would expand the definition of "campaign contribution" Thus, Voter Guides & Candidate Questionnaires might then be seen as violations of a group's 501(c)3 tax status.

The Prenatal Nondiscrimination Act of 2012 [HR. 3541] to ban Abortions based on Sex or Race, failed to get a 2/3 House majority vote, as required for "fast track" passage. The House may try to pass it again. Cong. Peter King was sole pro-life vote among the House members from Nassau/Suffolk.

HR.803/S2103, the pro-life DC Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act], moved one more committee step. And, pro-abort Rep. Dold (R-IL.) has introduced the Protecting Women's Access to Health Care Act, [HR.5650] to make sure Title X funding is not ended for abortion providers. It was sent to committee. ACTION ALERT-SAMPLE MESSAGE: Tell your Senators & Representative- vote YES on HR.3803/S.2103, the DC Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act.

Will New Genetic Testing Lead to More Abortions?



The June 2012 issue of Science Translational Medicine contains a report on a project by researchers at the University of Washington who were able to sequence the entire genome of an unborn baby using fetal and maternal DNA extracted from the mother's blood at 18-weeks gestation and paternal DNA from a swab of saliva from the father. According to the report, the reconstructed prenatal genome was 98% accurate when compared with post-natal results in two separate pregnancies. The lead scientist, Dr. Jay Shendure, associate professor of genome sciences at the University of Washington stated, "This work opens up the possibility that we will be able to scan the whole genome of the fetus for more than 3,000 single-gene disorders through a single, non-invasive test." This test could potentially screen for such conditions as epilepsy. schizophrenia, and some types of autism. "A limited number of genetic disorders can be identified through current prenatal testing. Trisomy 21, Down Syndrome, is one of the more common disorders that can currently be identified through prenatal testing. Several studies have found that the abortion rate in the US for babies prenatally diagnosed with Down Syndrome is over 90%. According to the International Down Syndrome Coalition for Life about 50% of all Down Syndrome babies worldwide are aborted. The organization reported an 11% decrease in babies born with Down Syndrome between 1989 and 2006 when there should have been an estimated 42% increase." (LifeSiteNews.com, 8 June 2012, Christine Dhanagom)

The Telegraph reported on June 6th, "Fitting pieces of the genetic jigsaw together, scientists in the US were able to reconstruct the entire genetic code of an unborn baby boy. They were then able to see what spontaneous genetic mutations had arisen. Such natural mutations - called 'de novo' mutations - are responsible for the majority of genetic defects. By checking their prediction of the baby's genetic code with actual DNA taken after birth, the team from the University of Washington, Seattle, found they were able to identify 39 of 44 such mutations in the child...The team also tested their approach on a woman who was earlier in her pregnancy than 18 weeks, and found it still worked...Jacob Kitzman, who worked on the project. added: "The improved resolution is like going from being able to see that two books are stuck together to being able to notice one word misspelled on a page."...The scientists said the test would be a considerable improvement on current techniques, which involve inserting a probe into the womb to take fluid from the fetal sac or placental samples. This can be dangerous for both the mother and child." In addition to identifying Down Syndrome, the current prenatal tests identify cystic fibrosis, muscular dystrophy and spina bifada. The Washington researchers warned,

"The less tangible implication of incorporating this level of information into pre-natal decision making raises many ethical questions that must be considered carefully within the scientific community and on a societal level."

Roger Highfield wrote in The Telegraph on June 7th, "We do, however, need to tread carefully. Although scientists unveiled the draft of the human genetic code more than a decade ago, the underlying genetic causes of most developmental disorders haven't been found yet. And when that information is available, it has to be used wisely. The debate about the latest advance will reopen many debates that are familiar in reproductive science. When can abortion be justified? What do we mean by 'normal', and how far from genetic norms - whatever they are - does the DNA of an unborn child have to stray before a pregnancy can be terminated? Can it be right to abort a fetus at risk of a disease that will only strike in middle age or old age? One of the pioneers of the field, Dr. Dennis Lo, has said it would not be ethical to screen for [diseases] like Alzheimer's or cardiovascular illnesses. But once the technical issues have been ironed out in the next few vears, that could become routine."

Lord Winston, a British fertility expert, stated "The biggest ethical issue might be that we are going to cause a great deal of worry unnecessarily to a great deal of women...I am a bit skeptical that it is going to be of value."

Poverty, disease, pain, disability, unintended pregnancy: all issues we have to deal with in this life. The right way acknowledges that man's problems are just that: of man. Humans are the owner and the problems belong to us. They are ours to solve. The right way to deal with these issues sees that every human life is valuable and that to address our problems we start there: intrinsic value of human life. The progressive way is to equate the problem with the person, then get rid of the person and call it good...Degrading and discarding life does nothing to remedy the underlying problem. Unless ALL human beings have moral worth and deserve dignity and respect, what would be the point of trying to solve our problems anyway?"

Monica Rafie and Tracy Winsor, founding partners of Be Not Afraid Ministry, state, "If it is our goal to discover the best way to create a society that embraces (genetic and other) differences, can we even begin such an endeavor when we accept the idea that the unborn baby is so other, so different from us that they are not worthy of protection?"



## Gallup: Percentage of Pro-Abortion Americans Drops to Record Low

A new Gallup survey finds the percentage of Americans who identify themselves as supporting legalized abortion has dropped to a record low. The 41% of Americans who now identify themselves as "pro-choice" is down from 47% last July.

On the other hand, 51 percent of Americans call themselves pro-life. The percentage of Americans identifying themselves as pro-life has trended higher since 1995, when the partial-birth abortion debate began in earnest and ultrasound technology made it so pictures of unborn children were the first baby pictures most parents saw.

The polling firm also found just 20 percent of Americans believe all abortions should be legal. Results for this Gallup poll are based on phone interviews conducted May 3-6, 2012 with a random sample of 1,024 adults, aged 18 and older, living in all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia.
