FEDERAL LEGISLATION

Election day 2012 is only about a month away, and the Platforms of the two major parties address the following Life Issues: The GOP Platform "Support[s] a human

life amendment to the Constitution and Endorse[s] legislation to make clear that the 14th Amendment's protections apply to unborn children." It opposes "federal funding of Embryonic Stem Cell research," "using public revenues to promote or perform abortion or fund organizations which perform or advocate it and will not fund or subsidize health care which includes abortion coverage." It "oppose[s] the nonconsensual withholding or withdrawal of care or treatment, including food and water, from people with disabilities, including newborns, as well as the elderly and infirm," and both "active and passive euthanasia and assisted suicide." It urges Congress "to strengthen the Born Alive Infant Protection Act," "ban sex-selective abortions" and "protect from abortion unborn children who are capable of feeling pain." It 'salutes' State 'informed consent' laws, and pledges to respect conscience rights.

The Democrat Platform opposes "any and all efforts to weaken or undermine" a woman's access to "legal abortion, regardless of ability to pay." It supports continued funding of Planned Parenthood. It states, "Abortion is an intensely personal decision between a woman, her family, her doctor, and her clergy; there is no place for politicians or government to get in the way." It continues "health care and education help reduce the number of unintended pregnancies and thereby also reduce the need for abortions." It also states, " the President has respected the principle of religious liberty" regarding HHS contraception coverage.

Healthcare expert Betsy McCaughey says ObamaCare will shorten the lives of some elderly hospital patients. A 2011 National Bureau of Economic Research paper said each \$1,000 cut in hospital staff equals a 6 to 8% boost in heart-attack patient's death rate. As of Oct 2012, hospitals that spend the least on seniors get rewards. Those spending more will get punished. (Source: N.Y. Post 8/21/12)

HEALTH & SCIENCE Planned Parenthood: The Largest Abortion Provider in America



LifeNews.com carried an article by Matthew Clark (staff attorney for the American Center for Law and Justice) on September 5th which contained information that is vital for all of us to know. The sources for this information are reports from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Planned Parenthood's own 2010 Annual Affiliate Service Census Report.

According to Clark, "40% of all reported abortions committed in the United States occur at a Planned Parenthood clinic, making it by far the largest abortion provider in America...Planned Parenthood (PP) claims to provide 11 million 'services' in America each year. From this overly inflated number, they calculate that the 329,445 abortions they committed in their last reported year amounts to only 3% of their services. PP's 3% figure has been bought hook, line and sinker by the mainstream media as proof positive that PP isn't really about abortion. But if you take even a cursory look at PP's own data, that claim begins to unravel and quickly." Clark continued, "Planned Parenthood's latest report states that it performed '11 million services during nearly 5 million clinical visits". So, now their abortion number jumps to 6.6% of all visits to PP result in an abortion. Digging a little deeper, Planned Parenthood claims that all those 'services' it provides only go to 3 million women. So by its own admission, 11% of the women that visit a PP clinic in any given year obtain an abortion there."

Clark reports that prenatal services (for women who continue their pregnancy) account for 0.28% of all services. The 841 adoption referrals accounted for 0.0076% of all services provided by PP in the reported year. Clark states, "these services are deceptive. In 2009, Planned Parenthood reported performing 40,489 prenatal services for 7,021 prenatal clients...Assuming an average of 6 prenatal services per client, PP's current listing of 31,098 prenatal 'services' could be for just over 5,000 prenatal clients. That is 5,000 prenatal clients versus well over 300,000 abortions." The following analogy was made by Clark, "Planned Parenthood's claim that only 3% of its business is abortion is no different than if a car dealership claimed it wasn't really in the business of selling cars because the number of new car sales was only a fraction of its total services provided (financing cars, repairing cars, providing manufacture recommended maintenance for cars, cleaning car, and so forth). Of course no one would believe such an outrageous claim. Sure, a car dealership does all of those things, but its purpose is to sell cars. The abortion industry is no different. The abortion industry, led by Planned Parenthood, is about committing abortion. Sure they provide some other services, but when your only self-sustaining revenue source is one thing and you are responsible for 40% of that one thing in the entire nation, that is what you are about. Planned Parenthood is about abortion." (Emphasis added)

The *LifeNews* article continued by reporting that Planned Parenthood's total revenue from abortion services was approximately \$164,154,000 a year, which translates to 51% of its clinic income. PP's income included over \$320 million in clinic income, \$223.8 million in private donations and over \$487 million from taxpayers. Government funding is drastically increasing - doubling in the last decade. In the past, PP reported Medicaid payments as 'health center income' instead of 'government grants and contracts'. With this change in reporting, we get a better picture of how much PP depends upon government funding. Clark writes, "over 46% of its total \$1 billion total annual revenue comes from the government - from our tax dollars."

Planned Parenthood reports that "about \$70 million comes from the federal government's Title X funding, providing free birth control (including minors..... Regulations issued by the Department of Health and Human Services require the contraception distribution to be strictly confidential (i.e., no notification of the parents of minor recipients), and define a 'family' so as to include 'unemancipated minors' desiring contraceptives without their parents' finding out; according to the HHS regulations, they 'must be considered on the basis of their own resources." (Clark) Emergency contraception has been available through Title X funding since 1997. This now includes abortifacient drugs such as Plan B and Ella. Clark states that this is the "most hidden statistic of the abortion industry." PP distributed 1,461,816 'emergency contraception kits' in its last reported year - much of that was paid for through Title X funding.

Clark points out that these reports never acknowledge the injuries and even deaths resulting from abortions at their clinics. PP employees have been caught on tape helping minors hide abortions from their parents and even "encouraging dishonest reporting to hide potential statutory rape." There are several lawsuits currently working their way through the court systems alleging Planned Parenthood affiliates billed federal and state governments for services never rendered, services that were known to be unnecessary, abortion-related services that violated the law, and overbilling federal and state governments.

Amazingly, Clark reports that almost 60% of young adults are unaware that Planned Parenthood performs abortions! He concludes, "If any other non-profit that received hundreds of millions of taxpayer dollars were caught doing half the things that Planned Parenthood is caught doing, they would be run out of business... Planned Parenthood is the largest abortion provider in America, taking in nearly half a billion dollars of taxpayer money as it systematically ends the lives of nearly 330,000 babies a year. It is engaged in a war on children, a war on unborn children and a war for the hearts and minds (and tax dollars) of America's children. The billion dollar a year organization doesn't need half of its revenue from taxpayers, and it doesn't need to be in our schools, but it is. It is time for the American people to learn the disturbing truth about Planned Parenthood's abortion business, and it is time for the media to start reporting the truth instead of recklessly protecting the abortion giant."
