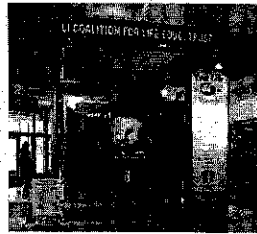

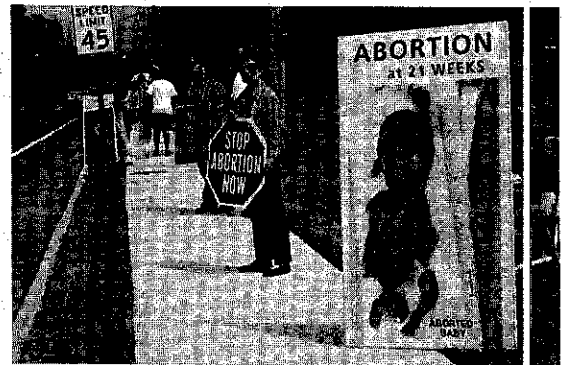

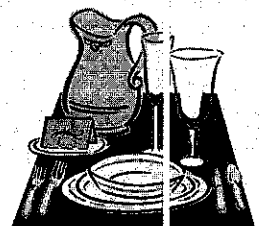

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act. On 6/18, the House passed the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act*, HR.1797. It would limit abortions, nation-wide, to the first 20 weeks after

fertilization. By then (5th month of pregnancy) the unborn child is believed capable of feeling pain. As of 8/5 the bill sits in a Senate Committee.

HHS Mandate - the final version of the HHS contraceptive/sterilization/abortifacient mandate was released 6/28. The date the mandate begins was moved back to 1/1/2014. Pro-Life leaders say the mandate still lacks conscience protection, and exempts only houses of worship, not other ministries.

Days later, the Administration said the ObamaCare Employer Mandate (employers with 50 full timers must provide health insurance) was being delayed until 1/1/2015. **This DOES NOT change the HHS mandate's date.** Some members of the House said the new 2015 date was an unauthorized change to the law. So they passed HR.2667, to make the change 'authorized by Congress'. A Federal Appeals Court ruled a Mennonite Company must obey HHS Mandate. They will appeal to 3rd Circuit. The 10th Circuit says Hobby Lobby won't be fined while litigating the mandate. The Court used *Citizen's United* as precedent. (If Corporations have free speech, they also have religious freedom). And despite the media calling it a loss, Liberty U says the 4th Circuit's ruling (on 7/11/13) has confirmed its "standing," and cleared the way for its anti-ObamaCare suit to go to Supreme Court.

Former head of the Democrat National Committee, Howard Dean, says the *Independent Payment Advisory Board* is a "health-care rationing body." It will not save money, and should be repealed. (*Wall Street Journal* 7/29/13) ObamaCare also places a \$2500 cap on money that can be put, pre-tax, into flexible savings accounts. Parents of Down syndrome children make heavy use of FSAs. The Thomas More society says the IRS is still targeting pro-life groups. [*lifeneews.com*- 8/1]

The House has passed HR.2009, to block the IRS from enforcing ObamaCare. Some members of Congress vow not to pass any "Continuing Resolution" (substitute budget) until ObamaCare is defunded. Congress returns in September. The LICL opposes the anti-life parts of ObamaCare.

CNS News says (8/1/13) CVS, RiteAid, & Walgreens now sell *Plan B* (morning after pill) "Over the Counter".

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

The NYS Legislative session will resume in January 2014. No anti-life bills became law during this past session.

Update: Women's Equality Act (WEA).

6/20/13 - **The NYS Assembly** passed the full ten-point version of the WEA by a vote of 98-47.

N/S Members voting for WEA (a pro-abortion vote):

Englebright, Hennessey, Hooper, Lavine, Ramos, Schimel, Solages, Sweeney, Thiele, and Weisenberg.

N/S Members voting against WEA (a pro-life vote):

Curran, Fitzpatrick, Garbarino, Graf, Lupinacci, McDonough, McKeivitt, Montesano, Ra, Raia, and Saladino.

Note: the 2nd AD seat formerly held by Losquado has been vacant since March. Election for 2nd AD on 11/5.

6/21/13 - **The NYS Senate** passed the nine non-abortion related planks of WEA as separate bills.

Final outcome: The 2013 Session ended without any portion of the WEA becoming law.

Sex Selection Abortion



Evan Grae Davis produced a documentary titled **"It's a girl: The three deadliest words in the world."** The United Nations estimates that 200 million girls are 'missing' today, most of them from India and China. Davis' documentary examines the cultural patterns and the personal stories behind this disturbing statistic. In an interview with Mercatornet.com posted July 30, 2013, Davis said, "After hearing the UN statistic of as many as 200 million girls 'missing' in the world today as a result of 'gendercide' we researched the issue in China, as well, and were completely astonished by how few people seemed to be aware of what appeared to be the greatest human rights issue of our time, and certainly the greatest form of violence against women in the world today. There seemed to be very little out there on the topic. It was then that we determined to dedicate the film project to exposing this untold story and educating and mobilizing a movement to end gendercide in India and China." Davis explains how cultures like India and China are based upon traditions that go back centuries which value boys over girls. Sons carry on the family name, inherit wealth, and perform last rites for parents. Daughters join the husband's family and are no longer considered part of their birth family. The dowry system in India further strengthens the desire for boys. Fathers often must pay large sums of money or other assets for a daughter's dowry. The cost is so expensive that very often families avoid having more than one girl. The One Child Policy in China has led to the elimination of girls over the past few decades. Sons care for parents in old age and daughters leave the family to join their husband's family. The result of the One-Child Policy is that families routinely abort when a female is identified in pre-natal testing until they bear a son.

One of the most shocking confessions in the film is when Davis is in a field in southern India with a mother who admits that she strangled eight of her newborn daughters in her 'quest for a son'. The woman stated, "Women have the power to give life and the power to take it away." This woman was given to her sister's husband as a second wife because her sister was unable to have children. Her purpose was to bear a son. Davis states, "She was programmed from birth to accept certain traditional views about her value and roles as a woman. These deeply engrained cultural beliefs drive the entire system, and women often find themselves as the perpetrators, visiting the same violence they experienced upon their daughters and daughters-in-law...To our surprise, in India, many of the women

and families were open to sharing their stories without shame or embarrassment. This seemed to indicate to us how deeply engrained some of these cultural beliefs were."

When Davis was asked how the situation in China differed from India, he stated, "...the coercive and oppressive nature of the One Child Policy makes it extremely unpopular among Chinese women. However, they have very little choice but to silently endure the government's intrusion into their private lives and have little recourse against the Family Planning officials' dominance of their reproductive rights. Those who voice dissension or refuse to submit to the policy suffer harsh punishment, along with their family members. When asked if India had a better chance of breaking this 'horrendous war on girls' since it is a democratic and religious country, Davis said, "Religion in India impacts gendercide only in as much as some religious communities like Muslims and Christians do not practice female feticide and infanticide on the same level as Buddhists, Hindus and Sikhs. However the deeply engrained patriarchal son preference culture permeates India and the devaluation of women remains widespread regardless of religious persuasion...despite a significant number of women in upper level government positions as well as 1/3 of local government seats being filled by women, violence against women in India is worse than ever...Both nations need government action, but in different ways. China must end its coercive family planning policy, whereas India's government must be pressured to enforce its existing laws against dowry, sex selection and abortion."

But Western governments have to accept some of the responsibility for this imbalance. As Davis noted, "the gender imbalance in India, China and other nations in Asia was fuelled by pressure from Western governments and NGOs for population control, which in many cases exploited existing cultural preference for sons for the 'greater good' of population control. And although the sex ratios in Western nations are not as extreme as in India or China, gendercide does take place in all countries in the West to a varying degree...Canada, New Zealand, Australia and most countries in Western Europe prohibit abortion on the basis of a fetus' gender - the one notable exception being the United States."

Davis hopes that his film will inspire a world movement to end gendercide. The first goal is to raise awareness of the issue. He encourages those "who desire to see value and dignity restored to girls in India and China to spread the word about the issue...with friends and family through Facebook and Twitter, and by bringing the film to your community through hosting a screening." 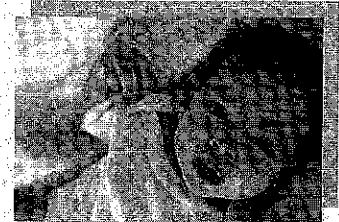
