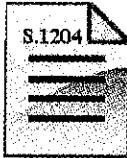

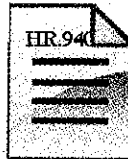
"Health Care Conscience Rights Act" S.1204/H.R.940 stalled as of October 2013.

This federal legislation is vital to protect all health care service providers as existing laws have serious limitations. Contact your representatives, (see Page 3), urging a vote.



S.1204 – A bill to amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to protect rights of conscience with regard to requirements for coverage of specific items and services,

to amend the Public Health Service Act to prohibit certain abortion-related discrimination in government activities and for other purposes.



Companion bill:

H.R.940 – Amends the Public Health Service Act to codify the prohibition against any action by the federal government and any state or local government receiving

federal financial assistance to subject a health professional, a hospital, a provider-sponsored organization, a health maintenance organization, an accountable care organization, a health insurance plan, or any other kind of health care facility, organization, or plan to discriminate on the basis that the entity refuses to participate in abortion-related activities.

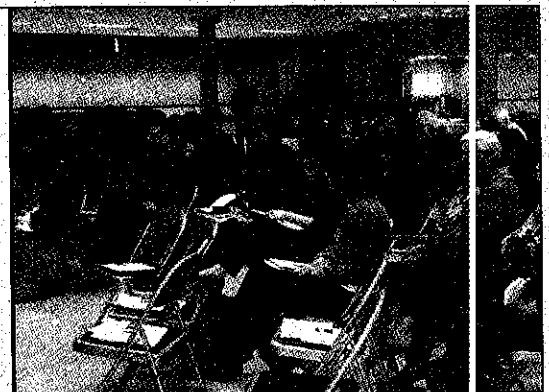
California expands abortion laws - Nurses practitioners, certified nurse midwives and physician assistants in California will be allowed [beginning 1/1/2014] to perform a type of early abortion under legislation signed on 10/9/2013 by Gov. Jerry Brown. The bill would let those professionals perform what are known as aspiration abortions during the first trimester. The method involves inserting a tube and using suction to terminate a pregnancy. Oregon, Montana, Vermont and New Hampshire already allow those medical professionals to perform such abortions. His signature came as other states have been restricting access to abortions.

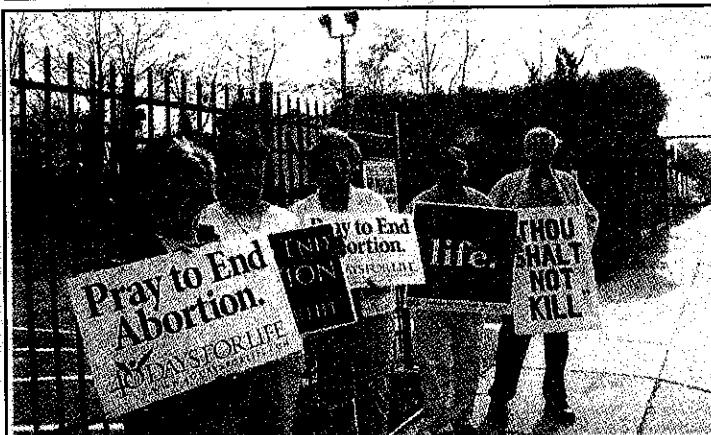
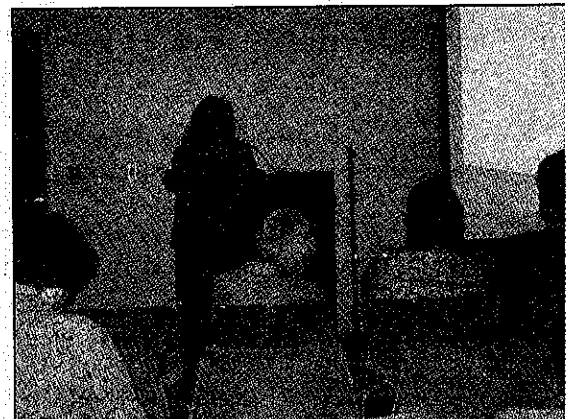

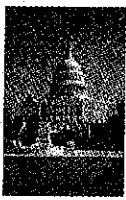

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The HHS contraception/sterilization abortifacient mandate moves closer to U.S. Supreme Court review. On Sept. 19 Alliance Defending Freedom filed a petition for review, in the *Conestoga Wood Specialties v. Sebelius* case. The Administration has until Oct. 19 to tell the Court why it should *not* take the case. And the same day, the Administration filed papers in the Supreme Court to force *Hobby Lobby* stores to obey the HHS Mandate. The Court should decide if it will take this case by early November. (See *Life News*, Oct. 2013, pg. 3, for more info on these cases.)

Supreme Court: The only 'life issues' case the Court has taken thus far is *McCullen vs. Coakley*, opposing a 35 ft. 'buffer-zone' around Massachusetts abortion mills.

On Oct. 5, at Good Samaritan Hospital, W. Islip, NY, Richard JJ Sullivan, Chm. B.O.D., Catholic Health Services, said two additional motions had recently been filed in the HHS Mandate case that includes Rockville Centre.

On Oct. 1 the Federal Government partially 'shut down' in a fight that began over whether to fund ObamaCare. Days before, House GOP members added conscience protection language (taken from the proposed **H.R. 940**), and a one year delay of both the HHS Mandate and the 'Individual Mandate' (everyone must have medical) insurance to their Continuing Resolution. The language was withdrawn days later, when Democrats said it was so vague, cervical cancer testing could be banned. Source: *Washington Times* Oct. 3, 2013

The LICL is opposed to the many anti-life parts of ObamaCare, i.e., people who enroll in federally-subsidized health care plans will pay a separate \$1 per month into an abortion "slush-fund". A "Secrecy Clause" - says people can only be told of the "slush-fund" when they first enroll. A study by the Lozier Institute says ObamaCare "Multi-State Plans," and expanded Medicaid payments, will fund up to 111,500 abortions per year.

HEALTH & SCIENCE

Three-Parent Embryos



Dr. Peter Saunders, former general surgeon and CEO of Christian Medical Fellowship, reported that Britain is “planning to become the first country in the world to offer controversial ‘three-parent’ fertility treatments to families who want to avoid passing on mitochondrial diseases to their children.” (www.MercatorNet.com, 7/1/13)

Margaret Somerville, director of the McGill Centre for Medicine, Ethics and Law, explains, “An embryo has two types of DNA: central nucleus DNA inherited from both its mother and father, and mitochondrial DNA (mDNA) only inherited from its mother. This mDNA can be defective in that it carries genes for serious diseases...or it cannot sustain the life of the cells it powers. The three-genetic-parent embryos would have a central nucleus with DNA from its intended mother’s ovum and father’s sperm, and mDNA from another woman’s ovum. The procedure involves creating an embryo from the intended mother’s ovum and father’s sperm, removing the nuclear DNA from the second woman’s ovum leaving behind the mDNA, and transferring the embryo’s central nuclear DNA to the enucleated ovum. The goal is to allow a woman with defective mDNA to have a baby who will inherit most of her genes, but not the defective mDNA.” (www.MercatorNet.com, 7/23/13)

Dr. Saunders noted, “It is likely that thousands of embryos will need to be produced and experimented upon in developing these techniques. Many...who believe that human embryos are worthy of the utmost respect and protection as early individual human lives, will argue that the end of producing an unaffected baby does not justify these means.” Since ‘leftover’ eggs from IVF treatments will not be enough, “egg harvesting from paid donors will be necessary leading to the exploitation of vulnerable women and exposure to at times high-risk egg-harvesting procedures. If successful, this research will cross an ethical and safety Rubicon by allowing human germline genetic therapy for the first time in human history. The genes from the third parent will be passed on down the generations...babies resulting from this therapy will have a third genetic parent whose details will not be on the birth certificate. This raises issues of personal and family identity for children born as a result of the technique and will inevitably lead to litigation involving parents wanting to assert maternity rights and children wanting information about all their genetic parents. Behind these cases will be the hugely emotive issues of custody and inheritance.” Saunders also notes that if we allow this technique for mitochondrial disease, it is only a matter of time before it is proposed that the technique be used for other diseases. He also states that support and treatment for mitochondrial disease is not mentioned. The techniques “are aimed at identifying these individuals at the embryo stage and

genetically engineering them. There is more than an element of eugenic thinking here. Is it right for us to decide that lives with serious disability are not worth living to the extent that such people must be prevented being born or genetically altered to make them acceptable? This is a very dangerous slippery slope indeed...Hard cases do not necessarily make good law or policy...I suspect there are much bigger agendas here that are not yet being fully disclosed. Are we, for example, seeing reproductive cloning and germline therapy being deliberately smuggled in...under the guise of compassion?”

Marcy Darnovsky, executive director of the Center for Genetics and Society in Berkeley, California, wrote in *Nature* (7/9/13), “Mitochondrial-replacement procedures would constitute germline modification. Were the UK to grant a regulatory go-ahead, it would unilaterally cross a legal and ethical line on this issue that has been observed by the entire international community. This consensus holds that genetic-engineering tools may be applied, with appropriate care and safeguards, to treat an individual’s medical condition, but should not be used to modify gametes or early embryos and so manipulate the characteristics of future children.”

Margaret Somerville concluded that this technology would “open up a precedent for constructing ‘designer babies’ and cloning...My use of the word constructing is not accidental: ‘building better babies’ with reproductive technologies is the 21st Century’s eugenics... We should reject ‘genetic reductionism,’ ... our inherited DNA is... an intrinsic part of who we are and requires special respect. There is a difference in kind between designing the essence of a human being and treating a person with a genetic disease... Altering the human germline ... no matter how much good we hope to do is, in my opinion, not ethical.”

Wesley J Smith, bioethics attorney and consultant to the Center for Bioethics and Culture, notes that an article in *Science* states that “the process has not been studied in humans past the 10-cell embryo stage, nor in monkeys into adulthood. But studies with mice and other organisms show significant health problems for males” including “altered respiratory metabolism and reduced performance, learning and exploratory capacity.” Females were not tested in those studies. (www.LifeNews.com, 9/23/13)

Smith suggests that further experimentation would be required, as there “are often significant differences in human application.” Would these experiments lead to “aborting fetuses or euthanizing subjects at different stages of development and then studying their bodies”? “We won’t do that (I would hope!) This means that creating three-parent children will require acting despite our ignorance of potential health outcomes – amounting to blatantly unethical human experimentation... This is the bottom line: Three-parent IVF would further the commodification of reproduction...it would further the radical social engineering of family life.” (www.LifeNews.com, 9/27/13)
